HERE'S THE STORY

- ♦ The D-backs, who have won 5 of their last 7 games, are 18-7 on the road since June 8.
- ♦ With a win today, Arizona will earn its second 3-game sweep @ Petco Park in club history (also: April 24-26, 2006).
- ♦ **Clay Buchholz** is 2-0 with a 1.04 ERA (2 ER in 17.1 IP) and 0.92 WHIP over his last 3 starts.
- ♦ **Jon Jay** is hitting .438 (7-for-16) with 5 RBI and a 1.037 OPS in his last 4 games.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- ♦ The D-backs won @ Padres, 9-4.
- ♦ **Eduardo Escobar** reached base 3 times and went 2-for-4 with a double in his first game with Arizona.
- ♦ **Jon Jay** was 3-for-6 with a double and 3 RBI...**Paul Goldschmidt** went 2-for-6 with 2 RBI.
- ♦ **Patrick Corbin** struck out 8 and allowed 4 runs in 6.0 innings... he also went 2-for-3 with a RBI.
- ♦ **Archie Bradley**, **Yoshihisa Hirano** and **Andrew Chafin** each threw 1.0 scoreless frame.

CONGRATS TO TREVOR HOFFMAN!

- ♦ The D-backs would like to congratulate **Trevor Hoffman** on his induction into the National Baseball Hall of Fame today.
- ♦ Hoffman, who attended the University of Arizona, made 68 appearances vs. D-backs, going 2-4 with a 2.51 ERA and 46 saves in 51 opportunities.
- ♦ Luis Gonzalez, D-backs senior advisor to the president & CEO, had the most at-bats (31) all-time vs. Hoffman.

ROAD REPORT

- ♦ The D-backs' 18-7 (.720) road record since June 8 is third in the Majors behind the Astros (15-5; .750) and A's (19-7; .731).

- ♦ The D-backs lead the NL with a .366 on-base pct. after the All-Star Break, rank second with a .285 average and 55 runs and third with 40 walks:

- ♦ The D-backs are hitting .429 (30-for-70) with runners in scoring position in their last 8 games.
- ♦ Since June 7, Arizona leads the NL and ranks third overall with a .293 average with RISP (132-for-451).
 - ❑ **BEST AVG WITH RISP IN MLB SINCE JUNE 7:** .298 – Houston; .295 – Minnesota; **.293 – Arizona;** .291 – Colorado; .288 – Oakland.

GETTING A JUMP ON THEIR OPPONENTS

- ♦ Arizona is second in the Majors with 78 first-inning runs, behind Colorado (82) and ahead of the Indians (74).
- ♦ The D-backs also rank fourth overall in runs scored in the first 2 innings (128), behind the Rockies (147), Indians (130) and Red Sox (129).

GOLDSCHMIDT'S FRIAR FACTS

- ♦ Paul Goldschmidt ranks among the all-time leaders (min. 300 PA) in OPS (2nd, .960) and slugging pct. (4th, .538).
