WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers lost last night to the O's, 10-2, and have a 2-4 record to begin the 2nd 'half' on this 10-day, 10-game road trip to KC (2-1), BAL (0-3), and TB (3 G)...team has dropped 4 in a row after winning 1st 2 G after the break, T2nd-longest losing streak by TEX in '17, one shy of season high (5, 5/23-27)...club has a 6-8 record in July and has dropped 11 of 17, 12 of 19, and 16 of last 27...have gone 5-5 in last 10 G and 18-17 since 6/9, winning 19 of 37 and 32 of 61...club has 40-39 (.513) record beginning 4/20, 7th-best in the A.L.

• At 45-49 (.479), Rangers are T10th in A.L. in winning pct. w/ BAL...club reached .500 mark with Saturday's win for 1st time since 6/28 (39-39), but have not had a winning mark since 6/27 (39-38)...Texas has had a winning record on just 3 occasions in the last 56 days...club was 55-39/55-40 thru 94/95 G in '16, and was also 45-49 thru 94 G in 2015.

• Club has been season-high 3 G above .500 twice, last on 5/21 (24-21), and was a 2017 high 7 games under .500 (13-20) on 5/8...season best 10-G win streak 5/9-19 was 4th-longest in franchise history...Rangers are 6-4-2 in their last 12 overall series after taking a series loss here in BAL.

THE FINALE: Rangers enter tonight with a 15-15 record in series finales, losing 2 straight and 4 of 5...Rangers last went 0-4 in a 4-G series from 7/10-13/14 vs. LAA, with last road instance coming just 3 series before that here at Camden Yards, 0-4 from 6/30-7/3/14 at BAL...club has had 4 winless series in '17, last 6/2-4 vs. HOU (0-3).

IN THE STANDINGS: The Rangers are in 4th place in the A.L. West, a season-high 17.5 games back in the division for a 2nd straight day...had not been in 4th since loss on 7/4...current deficit matches team's greatest at any point since the end of the 2014 season (-31.0 GB)...held at least a share of 2nd place for 10 straight days (incl. AS break) until Monday's loss...days in each position in 2017 (alone or tied): 1st-0 days, 2nd-36, 3rd-27, 4th-32, 5th-13...Saturday was just 4th time in past 32 days to gain ground in the West...still just 3.5 GB of a wild card spot in the A.L.

VS. BALTIMORE: Rangers are 0-3 vs. Orioles to begin 2017, losing 5 of 6 dating to '16...club is 4-6 vs. O's since start of '16 and Rangers have a 10-7 advantage since 2015...Texas has gone 11-18 since 7/10/13, but leads 23-21 since start of 2011...club is 4-6 at Camden Yards since 2015, 4-12 at this park since 7/10/13...both series in '17 take place this month, also 7/28-30 in Arlington...O's have leads in all-time series (254-204-1), in BAL (130-102-1), and at Camden Yards (63-56-1).

ON THE ROAD: The Rangers have dropped 3 straight, 4 of 6, 5 of 8, 9 of 13, and 11 of last 17 away games since a season-best 6-G road win streak from 5/28-6/13...club is still 12-11 in road contests since 5/28...prior to this 12-11 span, the club had won just 6 of its previous 17 away contests...the Rangers' .408 (20-29) road winning percentage is 11th in the A.L...the 20 wins are 2nd-fewest thru 49 road games for TEX since 2004, as club was 19-30 at this point in 2007...lowest away win totals thru 50 G since '04: 19-31 in '07, 21-29 in '14.

LARGE IN THE MARGIN: Texas has dropped the 1st 2 G of this series, 12-1 and 10-2...it marks the 4th time since 2004 for TEX to lost consecutive games by 8+ runs, with 2 of the 4 instances here at Camden Yards...the other 3: 6/14-15/11 at NYY, 8/8-9/08 at BAL, and 4/22-23/08 at DET.

NEED THE BATS: Texas has the lowest batting avg. (.189) OBP (.252), and OPS (.563) in MLB since the All-Star break, and .311 SLG is 2nd-lowest (BOS-.295)...offense has 13 R in 6 G, 2nd-fewest in majors (CWS-12 in 5 G), with MLB-low 2.17 R/G...9 of the club's 13 R in 2nd 'half' have come via the HR, as club is 4-for-19 (.211) with RISP...club has scored 3-or-fewer runs in 5 straight for 1st time since 2014.

HAMELS STREAKING: Cole Hamels enters tonight's series finale with 21.0 consecutive scoreless innings, and just 2.0 innings shy of matching 2017 A.L.-best 23.0-inning scoreless streak by SEA's James Paxton...it matches the 4th-longest scoreless streak of Hamels' career, just 4.0 innings shy of matching his career best (see chart).

ADRIAN BELTRE hit career double no. 602 last night, breaking a tie with Barry Bonds for sole possession of 16th place on that all-time list, one behind Cal Ripken (603)...of the 15 players ahead of Beltre on the doubles list, 12 are in the HOF, and the others are Pete Rose, David Ortiz, and Albert Pujols. • Beltre's 2983 career hits are just 2 shy of matching HOFer Sam Rice (2985) and 17 short of becoming 31st player in MLB history to reach 3000 hits.

BELTRE AT THIRD: Last night was Adrian Beltre's 54th consecutive errorless game at 3rd base dating back to 8/29/16, the longest error-free spans of both his career (prev. 53 G, 7/3-9/5/06) and in Rangers history...previous team marks at 3B had been set by both Buddy Bell (53 G, 6/13-8/19/79) and Hank Blalock (53 G, 9/25/04-5/25/05).

GALLO LONG BALL: Joey Gallo's solo HR in the 5th last night accounted for the Rangers' only run through 8 innings...it was his 1st HR in July and team-high 22nd HR in '17, 8th-most in A.L...Gallo now has HR in 11 different parks in '17 (incl. GLP/A). T3rd-most in MLB...the 4 to HR in 11+ parks in '17, according to STATS LLC: 12-L. Morrison/M. Moustakas, 11-J. Gallo/B. Harper.

• 2 of the 6 TEX HR since the break have come from the 9-slot (also Robinson on Sun. at KC), as 13 HR from last spot in order are tied for most in MLB (also TB).

WEEKEND AT THE TROP: The Rangers are scheduled to fly to the Tampa/St. Pete area after tonight's game for a 3-game weekend set against the Rays at Tropicana Field...TEX dropped 2 of 3 during previous series 5/29-31 in Arlington despite scoring 22 runs...that series finale included a Matt Bush blown save in the 9th and Sam Dyson loss in the 10th...Rangers are 3-6 vs. TB since start of '16, 8-8 since start of '15, and 18-22 since 2012, winning season series just once in last 5 seasons (5-2 in '15)...club last had a winning record in a season at The Trop in 2004 (2-1) - excluding postseason.

REHAB FRONT: A.J. Griffin made his 2nd rehab start last night, 1st w/ Round Rock, pitching vs. New Orleans: 3.1 IP, 6 H, 4 R-ER, 0 BB, 4 SO, 2 HR, 59 pitches/43 strikes.

SHORTS: Jeremy Jeffress whiffed Caleb Joseph to end the 7th last night, ending a span in which TEX relievers had permitted 5 straight 1st batters faced to reach...last night was 4th time in 6 G post-break to play in under 3 hours, equaling the total for the final 21 G pre-break...during 4-G losing streak, TEX has held lead at end of 4 total innings (all on Monday).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

**#35 Cole Hamels, LHP
(4-0, 3.05)**

TONIGHT: The 33-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 10th start of the season tonight in the finale of this 4-game series in Baltimore...has compiled a 21.0-inning scoreless streak over his last 3 starts, the longest active streak in MLB...will be working on regular 4 days' rest after taking ND in Texas' 1-0 victory on Sat. at KC (7.2 SHO IP), his only outing since the All-Star break...in his last 3 starts: 2-0, 0.82 ERA (2 ER/22.0 IP), 2 BB, 17 SO, .125 opp. avg (9-72)...has gone 2-0, 3.08 (9 ER/26.1 IP) in 4 G/GS since his return from the DL...is 4-0, the 2nd longest season-opening win streak of his career (5-0 in 2016), and he also has a team-high 3 wins lost - games in which he exited in position to win before the bullpen gave up the lead...received zero run support in last start for 1st time this season, but is still averaging 8.08 RS per 9...is 26-6 (.813) in his 53 reg. season starts with Texas, and team is 39-14 (.731) in those games...combined to post at least 200.0 innings and 200 strikeouts in a season for the 5th time in his career in 2016...has earned the win in each of the Rangers' division-clinching games over the past 2 seasons...Texas is 5-4 in his 9 starts, winning 3 straight.

ENJOYING JULY: Has gone 2-0, 0.82 ERA (2 ER/22.0 IP) in 3 starts this month...ERA is 2nd lowest in A.L. among pitchers w/ 3+ GS (CLE's Mike Clevinger-0.50)...opp. batting .125 (9-72) this month, lowest in MLB (min 20.0 IP).

• **Current 21.0-inning scoreless streak is longest active streak in MLB, 8th longest this season...**stands 2.0 innings shy of SEA's James Paxton (23.0) for longest streak in A.L. and 6.2 innings short of ARI's Robbie Ray (27.2) for longest in MLB this season...scoreless streak is the longest for TEX since Yovani Gallardo (33.1 IP, 6/10-7/7/15)...Hamels' run is T4th longest scoreless streak in his career, 4.0 innings shy of career long 25.0-inning streak from 8/24-9/8/10 w/ PHI.

LAST START: Took ND in Texas' 1-0 victory on Sat. at KC (7.2 IP, 4 H, 0 R-ER, 1 BB, 5 SO, 99 pitches/69 strikes), his only outing since the All-Star break...Shin-Soo Choo's RBI single broke a scoreless tie in the 9th, and Alex Claudio converted his 3rd save...posted 7.2 SHO IP for a 2nd consecutive start, joining Martin Perez (3 straight in April 2014) as only Rangers w/ back-to-back scoreless starts that long since 2012...was just 3rd start by a Ranger in last 12 seasons (2005-17) to pitch at least 7.2 SHO innings and not earn a win, the others by Yu Darvish on 4/11/14 vs. HOU and Colby Lewis on 4/30/10 at SEA.

VS. THE ORIOLES: Is 1-3 with a 4.32 ERA (16 ER/33.1 IP) over 5 career starts vs. Baltimore, including 1-1, 3.10 (7 ER/20.1 IP) in 3 starts with Texas...has lost both career starts at Camden Yards, going 0-2 with a 7.50 ERA (10 ER/12.0 IP)...last pitched against O's on 8/3/16 at BAL (7.0 IP, 3 R-ER), taking the loss in a matchup against Kevin Gausman...only other start in Baltimore was on 6/28/06 (L, 5.0 IP, 7 R-ER) in rookie season w/ PHI.

ON THE ROAD: Has gone 1-0 with a 3.82 ERA (13 ER/30.2 IP) in 5 road starts this season...7 of 14 runs allowed on the road came in one start on 6/26 at CLE...has gone 2-0 with a 3.09 ERA (15 ER/43.2 IP) in last 7 road starts dating back to 9/10/16...opponents are batting .212/.299/.319 on the road compared to .191/.260/.298 in Arlington.

2017: Lucroy (3.35 ERA) has caught 6 of 9 starts and Chirinos (2.53 ERA) has caught 3 outings...through 9 starts, his swing and miss percentage (17.2%), SO/9 (5.03), and SO% (14.3) are all career lows...has never finished a season with a SO% lower than his 20.6 figure in 2009...has held LHB 6-for-43 (.140)...batters leading off an inning have reached in 21 of 61 frames (10-for-50 with 9 BB and 2 HBP), and are 0-for-21 with 2 BB in last 3 starts...opposition is batting .205 (8-39) with RISP, including 2-for-5 over last 3 outings...opponents by time through order: 1st PA-.203 (14-69); 2nd PA-.195 (15-77); 3rd PA-.196 (11-56); 4th PA-.400 (2-5)...received zero run support in last start for 1st time this season, but is still averaging 8.08 RS per 9...has team-high 3 wins lost - games in which he exited in position to win before the bullpen gave up the lead...his 2 errors are T6th-most among A.L. pitchers...in ND on 6/26 at CLE, had leads of 7-1 and 9-3 but could not escape the 5th inn. in eventual 15-9 TEX loss.

DISABLED LIST: Was on the disabled list, 4/30-6/25, with a right oblique strain, an injury he suffered while warming up prior to a scheduled start on 5/2 at HOU...was the longest DL stint of his career, as he had never missed more than 29 days (3/26-4/23/14)...was placed on the disabled list on 5/3 and threw for the 1st time on 5/24...was 1-0 with a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) in a pair of rehab starts with Double-A Frisco...made his 1st rehab start on 6/16 vs. San Antonio (3.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R-ER, 0 BB, 3 SO, 35 pitches/25 strikes)...following his outing, Hamels threw an additional 22 pitches in the bullpen...last outing was on 6/21 vs. Midland (5.2 IP, 2 H, 1 R-ER, 2 BB, 5 SO, 1 HR, 81 pitches/56 strikes).

ALL I DO IS WIN: His 15 wins in 2016 were T2nd-most in his career (17 in 2012, 15 in 2007)...has gone 26-6 (.813) over 53 starts since the 7/31/15 trade to the Rangers, best win pct. in A.L. (min. 25 decisions) in that span and 2nd-best in MLB (Kershaw-.833, 35-7)...according to STATS LLC, he was one of just 5 pitchers since 1913 to win at least 19 of his 1st 22 decisions with a single club, joining Vida Blue as only pitchers to do it for an A.L. club...won a career-high 12 consecutive decisions from 8/23/15-5/22/16 before loss on 5/27/16 vs. PIT...it matched the longest win streak by a starter in Rangers history (Bobby Witt - 12 G in 1990) and was the longest by a left-hander.
