THINK NAVY BLUE: Last night, the Padres toppled the Los Angeles Dodgers 4-1 behind starter **Eric Lauer's** 8.2 inning performance...the rookie southpaw allowed four hits and just a single run on a career-high eight strikeouts and a career-high 115 pitches...Lauer is now 2-0 vs. LAD with a 0.61 ERA (1 er, 14.2 ip), and he has worked 5.0-or-more innings in eight consecutive starts.

- **Wil Myers** homered, again...it marked his fourth-consecutive game with a homer (a career high), and in that time, he's amassed six in total...in the eight games since the start of the last roadtrip, Myers is slugging 1.107 with a double, triple, six homers and 10 RBI.
- **Austin Hedges** went 2-for-3 with three RBI and belted his second homer in his last four starts.

MAKING QUICK WORK: Last night's game lasted 2 hours and 18 minutes, the shortest game of the year for both the Padres and the Dodgers...it was the Padres quickest game since May 21, 2017 vs. ARI (2 hours and 16 minutes), and it was the Friars' 18th game this year that lasted 2 hours and 30 minutes or less.

LUCCHESI THE LUCHADOR: Among rookies who have made at least 13 starts this season, 24-year-old **Joey Lucchesi** ranks first in ERA (3.27) and third in SO/9 IP (9.24)...in his last three starts he's owned a 0.84 WHIP, a 1.26 ERA (2 er, 14.1 ip), a .106 opponent average (5-for-47), and 3.14 H/9 IP.

YOU SHALL NOT REACH: Among left-handers this season who have made at least 13 starts, **Joey Lucchesi** has allowed just 78 base runners...only SEA's Wade LeBlanc has allowed fewer runners among southpaw starters.

WHEN THE CAT IS AWAY, THE MYERS WIL PLAY: **Wil Myers** has homered in four consecutive games, the longest homer streak of his career...he's combined for six home runs in the past four games, becoming the third Padre to ever hit six-or-more homers in a four-game span, joining Nate Colbert (1972) and Ken Caminiti (1995)...if he hits another today, only Colbert has hit seven homers in a five-game span (July 30-Aug. 2, 1972).

GRAB SOME PINE: In the month of July, Padres relievers have fostered 11.01 strikeouts per nine innings pitched, the fourth-best mark in the majors...the Dodgers' 'pen ranks third in that time with 11.16, trailing just CWS's 11.57 and PIT's 12.19.

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME: The Padres have allowed 21 unearned runs this season at home (second-most in the majors) and the Dodgers have allowed 23 unearned runs at Dodger stadium (most in the majors)...despairingly, SD has allowed 210 earned runs at home (tied for fifth-most in the ML) and the Dodgers have allowed 161 earned runs at home (tied for fourth-fewest in the ML).

PADRES ON DECK: Tonight, 2B **Luis Urias** (.278) and RHP **Brett Kennedy** (7-0, 2.58 ERA) will represent the Padres and El Paso (AAA) on the Pacific Coast League team in the Triple-A All-Star Game in Columbus, Ohio...on Tuesday night, RHP **Ronald Bolanos**, 21, allowed two runs (one earned) on two hits and four walks with five strikeouts over 6.0 innings Lake Elsinore (A)...LHP **Joey Cantillo**, 18, allowed one run on seven hits and no walks with six strikeouts in 4.1 innings in the Arizona Rookie League.

DATE IN PADRES HISTORY: On July 11, 1978, the Padres hosted their first All-Star Game at San Diego Stadium...the National League won 7-3, and Dodgers' 1B Steve Garvey was crowned MVP...Padres **Dave Winfield** went 1-for-2 with one run scored, and RHP **Rollie Fingers** allowed one hit in 2.0 scoreless innings.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#37 LHP JOEY LUCCHESI (4-3, 3.27)

LET'S GO FUEGO: 24-year-old **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make his fifth start since being reinstated from the 10-day disabled list on 6/20 with a right hip strain, which forced him to miss the club's previous 32 games.

- Tonight will mark his 14th career start and second against the Dodgers...tossed 5.0 IP of three-run ball on 5/4 vs. LAD in SD's 4-0 defeat...the Dodgers will be the second team for Lucchesi to face multiple times (other: Rockies, three times).
- Among rookies who have made at least 13 starts this season, he ranks first in ERA (3.27) and third in SO/9 IP (9.24).

SINCE BEING BACK: Saddled with the loss his last time out on 7/6 at ARI, tossing 5.1 IP of two-run ball in SD's 3-1 loss...hit two batters in the contest, doubling his total from his previous 12 starts

- In his first start since being reinstated on 6/20 vs. OAK, lasted a career-low 1.2 IP on three hits and four runs.
- In his ensuing three starts since 6/25, he has gone 1-1 with a combined 1.26 ERA (2 ER, 14.1 IP) with a .106 opponent average.
- He has tossed at least 5.0 IP and allowed three runs or less in eight of his 13 starts.

WHILE YOU WERE AWAY: Made one rehab start for Lake Elsinore (A) on 6/14, tossing 4.0-shutout innings against Rancho Cucamonga.

YOUNG AND THE RESTLESS: Lucchesi has been more effective with fewer days off between starts...after his start on Friday in Arizona, tonight's outing comes on four day's rest.

- With four days off, he has a 1.45 ERA with a .211 opponent average in six starts...with five days off, he has a 3.00 ERA with a .176 opponent average in four starts...with six-or-more days off, he has a 8.74 ERA and a .319 opponent average in three starts.

PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME: Lucchesi's three pickoffs led all of MLB before being placed on the DL... fellow rookie lefty **Eric Lauer** now leads the majors with his nine pickoffs...their 12 combined pickoffs are the most by a Padres rookie duo in franchise history.

JOEY LU'KK'HESI: Among all NL starting pitchers who have made at least 13 starts, his 9.24 SO/9.0 IP ratio leads the Padres staff and ranks tied 13th in the NL.

APPRECIATE THE HELP: His 5.83 run support average (runs scored while he's in the game) ranks tied for 15th among all ML pitchers and tied for eighth in the NL (min. 13 games started).

THROUGH 4, UNDER 2.00: Lucchesi logged a 1.66 ERA through his first four starts with a 2-0 record...the last SD pitcher to have a sub-2.00 ERA over his first four MLB starts was Odrisamer Despaigne in 2014 (1.35).

FIRST IN CLASS: Made his Major League debut on 3/30 vs. MIL, becoming the first pitcher of the 2016 draft class to make it to the show...he was the second player overall drafted in 2016 to make it to the majors, following only Orioles **OF Austin Hays**...teammate **Eric Lauer** became the second pitcher of the '16 class to make his MLB debut (April 24 at COL)

- Lucchesi made just 39 minor league starts prior to his big league debut, going 11-9 with a 1.99 ERA (40 ER, 181.0 IP) and 204 SO against 36 BB.

NOT SO ROCKY: Is 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER, 16.0 IP) with 17 strikeouts to five walks in his three career starts against the Rockies...after his start tonight against the Dodgers, the Rockies will be the only other club which he has made more than one start against

- Became one of just five pitchers to not give up a run in either of his first two starts vs. the Rockies (also: Christian Friedrich in 2016, Jacob deGrom in 2014, Matt Harrison in 2012 and Johan Santana in 2009).
- In his second career start on 4/10 at COL, he became just the seventh pitcher in Padres history to not allow a single earned run in at least 6.0 IP at Coors Field (last: Christian Friedrich, 6/12/16)...it has been done eight times, with Oliver Perez twice (7/7/02 and 9/7/02).

LOOK BACK AT IT: The left-hander was named Padres Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017 after pitching to a combined 11-7 record with a 2.20 ERA (34 ER, 139.0 IP), 148 SO against 33 BB and a .200 opponent batting average in 24 appearances (23 starts) between Lake Elsinore (A) and San Antonio (AA).

- Began the season with Lake Elsinore and earned California League Mid-Season All-Star honors, pitching to a 6-4 record with a 2.52 ERA (22 ER, 78.2 IP) and 95 SO against 19 BB.
- Promoted to San Antonio on 7/1 where he lowered his ERA, pitching to a 1.79 mark (12 ER, 60.1 IP) while striking out 53 and walking just 14.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

TYSON'S TURN: RHP **Tyson Ross** is scheduled to make his 18th start of the season tomorrow in Game 2 of this four-game set against the Diamondbacks

- The Padres have won seven of his last 10 starts and are 11-6 overall when he takes the mound.
- Has worked 5.0 IP or more in 15 of his 17 starts, including 10 quality outings.
