RAY MATTER—The Rays 5-game losing streak is their longest since July 19-24, 2017 at OAK, vs. TEX, vs. BAL (5) and is tied for the longest active streak in the majors with the Orioles...the Rays are 1-5 or worse through 6 games for the third time in club history (1-5 in 2001, 0-6 in 2011).

- + Rays pitchers have reached double-digit strikeouts in consecutive games, recording 25 SO in 16 IP over that span but have yielded 18 H, 18 R, 17 ER, 9 BB and 5 HR, and all 5 HR came with runners on.
- + The Rays pitched to a 9.56 ERA (16-IP, 17-ER) in the 2-game series at Yankee Stadium...in comparison, they pitched to a 2.25 ERA (36-IP, 9-ER) in the season-opening 4-game series against the Red Sox.
- + Today the Rays are attempting to avoid their first 6-game losing streak since Sep 23-28, 2016 vs. BOS, at CWS and their third 1-6 start in club history (1-6 in 2011 and 2001).

EARLY TEST—Today is the third game of an 8-game, 10-day trip to New York (0-2), Boston and Chicago...this is the third straight year the Rays have had an April trip to New York and Boston...they went 1-6 last year from April 10-17 (0-3 at New York, 1-3 at Boston) and 3-3 in 2016 (2-1 at Boston, 1-2 at New York)...this series continues a stretch of 9 games to start the season against the Red Sox (7) and Yankees (2), the AL East's two postseason teams in 2017...from April 9-June 13, only four of the club's 19 series are against teams that finished last season at .500 or better.

POMP & CIRCUMSTANCE—Today is the third and final home opener involving the Rays this season...they won at home on Opening Day, 6-4, and lost, 11-4, in the Bronx...the Rays were part of three home openers once previously: in 1999, they opened against the Orioles at Camden Yards on Opening Day (lost 10-7), April 9 at home (lost 4-1) and the Blue Jays at the SkyDome on April 12 (lost 7-1)...this will be the fourth time the Rays have played in the Red Sox home opener (0-3 in previous games).

RAYS vs. RED SOX—This is the fifth of 19 meetings between the Rays and Red Sox this season (10 in St. Petersburg, 9 in Boston)...the two clubs will meet 10 times before the end of April, but do not face each other in June, July or September...the Rays are 1-3 so far, and all three defeats have been by 1-run margins...21 of the last 32 games between the teams have been decided by 2 runs or fewer, with the Rays going 8-13 in those 21 games...the Rays went 8-11 against the Red Sox last season (4-5 at home, 4-6 on the road)...after going 7-12 in 2016, they have lost consecutive season series to the Red Sox for the first time since 2006-07.

COLD SNAP—According to weather.com, the remaining highs forecasted for this road trip are 44°, 43°, 42° and 44° in Boston and 41°, 42° and 53° in Chicago...first-pitch temperature was 40° and 53° for the games in the Bronx, and Tuesday's game was the coldest first pitch for a Rays game since April 26, 2014 at CWS (39°)...the Rays are 24-34 all-time in games with a first pitch at 50°F or colder and 6-4 at 40°F or colder.

OFF DAY ODDITY—The Rays have seven remaining off days scheduled through May 10...the Rays are off tomorrow Friday in Boston, which will be the second scheduled Friday off day in club history following April 2, 2004...that season, the Rays played 2 games in Tokyo against the Yankees to open the regular season (Tues.-Wed.), were off Thurs.-Fri., played a spring game on Sat., April 3 and resumed regular season play on Tues., April 6 at home against the Yankees.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE—The Rays offense has totaled 15 runs, 2nd-fewest in club history through 6 games to 2011 (8)...the offense has been held scoreless in 45 of their 53 trips to the plate this season, and have scored multiple runs in an inning only twice...in fact, 40 pct. of the team's runs this season came in the 6-run 8th inning on Opening Day vs. BOS.

- + Their 37 hits, .196 avg., .263 OBP, .270 SLG and .533 OPS are all the 2nd-worst marks in club history through 6 games...the 2 HR are their fewest and 6 2B are tied for the fewest through 6 games.
- + Through the first 6 games of the season, opposing starting pitchers have a 1.24 ERA (36.1-IP, 5-ER) against the Rays...the Rays haven't

scored more than 2 runs against an opposing starter...this includes 5 games of 1 run or fewer and 2 games without a run.

- + **Denard Span** has 6 RBI to account for 40.0 pct. of the team's total...only two players have a higher pct. of their team's RBI: KC **Lucas Duda** (5 of 11, 45.5 pct.) and CIN **Adam Duvall** (5 of 12, 41.7 pct.).

ROTATION TRANSLATION—Prior to the injury to **Nathan Eovaldi**, the Rays planned to open the season with four regular members of the starting rotation and a bullpen day as needed in place of a fifth starter...the Rays pitching staff currently has three starters and a nine-man bullpen, which includes today's starter **Yonny Chirinos** and four other long relievers.

- + Chirinos will be making his first career start today...it will be the first time that a Rays pitcher makes his first career start at Fenway Park...he will become the third Ray all-time to start a game at Fenway Park within the first 2 games of his career, joining **Wade Davis** in his second career app/start on Sep 12, 2009 and **Luis de los Santos** in his second career app/start on July 25, 2002.
- + In the team's first bullpen day of the season, four pitchers—**Andrew Kittredge** (3.1 IP), **Ryan Yarbrough** (4 IP), **Sergio Romo** (0.2 IP) and **Chaz Roe** (1 IP)—allowed 3 R/2 ER in a 3-2 loss vs. BOS.

REDEFINING RELIEF—Through 6 games, a Rays reliever has thrown at least 50 pitches four times...no other team has done that more than once, and the 29 other teams have combined to do it eight times...the Rays had 6 relief apps of this type of all last season...Rays relievers have totaled 6 apps of at least 2 IP and 2 apps of at least 4 IP, both most in the majors.

- + **Alex Colomé** and who has not pitched since Opening Day, is 1 save shy of tying **Fernando Rodney** (86) for 2nd in franchise history...the club's all-time leader is **Roberto Hernández** (101).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays, Indians and Dodgers are the only teams in the majors with three 1-run losses...since 2016, the Rays are 34-54 (.386) in 1-run games, 2nd-worst winning pct. in the majors to Minnesota (30-49, .380)...the Rays are 0-3 when yielding 3 runs or fewer this season and are one of two teams in the majors with 3 losses when doing so (Dodgers).

LA PANTERA—Shortstop **Adeiny Hechavarria** has not committed an error since last July 30 at NYY, a streak of 57 games and 196 chances without an error...it is the longest streak by games and 3rd-longest by chances for a shortstop in club history...since last Aug 1, he is the only shortstop in the majors to appear in at least 20 games without committing an error...since being acquired by the Rays on June 26, 2017, he has a .987 fielding pct. in 83 games (80 starts)...prior to his arrival last season, Rays shortstops ranked 14th of 15 AL teams with a .959 fielding pct.

MINOR LEAGUE REPORT—Today is Opening Day for the Rays full-season affiliates...**Chih-Wei Hu** will start for defending Triple-A champion Durham, while **Genesis Cabrera** will start for Double-A Montgomery, **Brock Burke** for Class-A Charlotte and **Drew Strotman** for Class-A Bowling Green.

- + In January, *Baseball America* listed the Rays at No. 5 in its Organizational Talent rankings of minor league prospects, their highest position since 2013 (No. 4)...the publication's Top 100 Prospects included six Rays, a figure topped only by the Braves (eight)...in addition to *Baseball America's* rating, the Rays were ranked by MLB.com as the No. 4 farm system in baseball (No. 1 based just on position players), and by ESPN.com at No. 7.

LAST APP—In his major league debut on Sun vs. BOS, his only hit allowed in 4 IP was the game-winning single by **Rafael Devers** in the 6th inning (run charged to **José Alvarado**)...his line: ND, 4 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 SO, 2 HBP, 56 pit, 38 str. ...became the third pitcher in club history with a scoreless app/start of at least 4 IP in his major league debut, following **Enny Romero** (4.2 IP, start) on Sep 22, 2013 vs. BAL and **Scott Kazmir** (5 IP, start) on Aug 23, 2004 at SEA...it was the longest scoreless **relief** outing ever for a Rays pitcher making his major league debut...the 24-year-old became the sixth pitcher in his lifetime to debut in relief, go 4 IP or more and allow 1 hit or fewer and no runs, joining HOU **Joe Musgrove** in 2016, CLE **Ryan Merritt** in 2016, CWS **José Quintana** in 2012, KC **Dusty Hughes** in 2009 and ARI **Max Scherzer** in 2008.

ROTATION TRANSLATION—Will be making his first career start today in a scheduled bullpen day...prior to the injury to **Nathan Eovaldi**, the Rays planned to open the season with four regular members of the starting rotation and a bullpen day as needed in place of a fifth starter...the Rays pitching staff currently has three starters and a nine-man bullpen, which includes Chirinos and four other long relievers.

PITCHER OF THE YEAR—Named the 2017 Minor League Pitcher of the Year by the Rays Baseball Operations department...spent the majority of the season with Triple-A Durham, earning a May 2 promotion from Double-A Montgomery...went 13-5 with a 2.73 ERA (168.1-IP, 51-ER) in 27 apps (26 starts) between the two levels.

- + Was added to the Rays 40-man roster following the season.
- + Led Rays minor leaguers in innings...tied for 2nd in wins, one shy of **José Mujica** (14)...ranked 3rd with 141 SO and 4th in ERA.
- + Despite spending a month at the Double-A level, ranked among International League leaders in ERA (2.74, 4th), wins (12, tied for 4th), innings (141, 5th) and WHIP (0.98, 2nd).

TRIPLE-A CHAMPION—Made 2 starts for the Bulls in the postseason, going 1-1 with a 0.75 ERA (12-IP, 1-ER)...did not allow a run in 7 IP of Game 2 of the IL Semifinals vs. Indianapolis (Pirates), giving Durham a 2-0 series lead...received no run support in a Game 2 loss vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (Yankees) in the Governors' Cup...did not pitch in the Triple-A Championship Game win over Memphis (Cardinals).

IN COMMAND—Over five minor league seasons, has issued only 74 BB in 474.1 IP for a 1.40 BB/9 IP ratio.

X-RAY REPORT—Yonny's favorite player growing up was Yankees closer **Mariano Rivera**...as a child, he and his friends would play a game similar to baseball that replaced the ball and bat with *chapitas*, or bottle caps, and a broomstick...his favorite meals are *arepas*—baked cornmeal patties sometimes stuffed with cheese or meat—and chicken with rice.

LAST START—On Sun vs. BOS, went 4 IP, matching the 2nd-shortest start of his career...also failed to record at least one out in the 5th inning on Sep 28, 2017 at NYY (3 IP) and July 30, 2017 at NYY (4 IP)...his last batter faced was a game-tying RBI single by **J.D. Martinez** in the 5th inning...allowed at least one baserunner in every inning, and a baserunner to reach scoring position in every inning except the 3rd...pitch count by inning: 22-22-6-19-14...was the seventh time in 15 career starts he yielded 1 run or fewer...his line: ND, 4 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 3 BB, 2 SO, 1 HBP, 83 pit, 53 str.

WINLESS STREAK—Is seeking his first win since July 25, 2017 vs. BAL...has gone 0-3 with a 4.59 ERA (33.1-IP, 17-ER) in his 8 apps (6 starts) since his last win, after going 5-1 with a 2.67 ERA (57.1-IP, 17-ER) in 9 starts to

begin his career...this is his second major league season after making his major league debut last June 7 vs. CWS.

vs. BOSTON—Is 1-0 with a 1.38 ERA (13-IP, 2-ER) in 3 apps (2 starts) against the Red Sox, all at home...in addition to his first start this season, he started against Boston in his sixth career game and his only run allowed in 6 IP was a sac fly by **Deven Marrero**...after returning from the disabled list, his first app was out of the bullpen on Sep 16 vs. BOS, and he did not allow a baserunner in 3 IP...it was the first perfect app of at least 3 IP by a Rays rookie since **Travis Harper** on June 27, 2002 vs. TOR (3 IP).

- + Is in his fourth season as Rays manager...at age 40, is the majors' youngest active skipper—5 months younger than SD **Andy Green**.
- + His last ejection was July 18, 2017 at OAK, his seventh ejection as Rays manager...his 7 ejections are tied for 4th in franchise history.
- + Is the sixth Tampa-born manager in major league history, and second to manage the Rays...that list includes Hall of Famers **Al Lopez** and **Tony La Russa**, **Lou Piniella**, **Dave Miley** and **John Hart**.

- + Played 12 professional seasons as a catcher, incl. parts of eight seasons in the majors (2002-10) and two years (2005-06) in the Rays org.
- + Played in the 1989 Little League World Series (Tampa Northside LL), 1999 College World Series (Florida State) and earned World Series rings in 2007 (Red Sox) and 2009 (Yankees).

- + On Tues at NYY, robbed Tyler Wade of a go-ahead homer in the 6th inning...is tied with STL Tommy Pham and SD José Pirela for the major league lead with 2 outfield assists...has appeared in 5 games, all starts in right field, after entering the season with 30 career games (20 starts) there.
- + Both hits this year have gone for extra bases, coming in the same game on Sat vs. BOS...homered as a right fielder for the third time in his career.
- + Made his 11th Opening Day roster and start, first in right field...signed by the Rays as a free agent on March 3; hit 3 HR during spring training.
- + Since the start of 2013, no other player can match his combination of 90 HR and 122 SB...is one of seven actives with at least 100 HR and 200 SB in his career, according to Baseball Reference, joining Jacoby Ellsbury, Ian Kinsler, Brandon Phillips, Hanley Ramírez, José Reyes and Ichiro Suzuki.
