#### **CARDINALS NOTES (10,000th Win in Team History)**

**John Gant** made his fourth start (9th app.) of the season, first against the Indians in 2018 (1-0) and second in his career (1-0)...threw a career-high 7.0 innings and issued a career-high five walks...joins **Jack Flaherty** (6/22 at MIL - 7.0 IP) and **Michael Wacha** (6/3 vs. PIT - 8.0 IP) as Cardinals pitchers to throw 7.0 innings and allow one hit or less this season...made his the fourth start of his MLB career vs. CLE at Turner Field on June 27, 2016...had not pitched more than 5.1 innings in an MLB start this season....longest scoreless outing of his career.

**Matt Carpenter** matched his season-high with three hits for the 5th game...has three three-hit games against American League clubs this season (5/16 at MIN & 5/21 vs. KC).

**Kolten Wong** recorded his first extra base hit with runners in scoring position this season by doubling home **Dexter Fowler** in the 6th inning.

**Marcell Ozuna** collected his 25th multi-hit game of the season and 11th multi-RBI game...3rd straight multi-hit game in Interleague play...has a double in back-to-back games for the first time this season. (7th game-winning RBI in the month of June).

**Greg Garcia** has scored in consecutive games for the first time since scoring in four straight (4/11-15).

**Yadier Molina** collected his 486th career extra base hit with a double in the 8th inning, tying **Jim Edmonds** for 11th place all-time in Cardinals history.

**Harrison Bader** tallied back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time in his MLB career...now leads all MLB rookies with his 7th stolen base...tallied his 11th RBI of the season, surpassing the 10 he had in 2017.

**Austin Gomber** surrendered his first hit to a right-handed batter this season (**Rajai Davis**), was 0-for-14 vs. RHB entering.





**Bud Norris** is a career 5-for-5 in save opportunities in Interleague games.

*The Cardinals challenged the out call on Harrison Bader at second base in the 8th inning. Call overturned (Time: 1:32).*

The **Cardinals** won by shutout for the 5th time this season (4th at home)...was their 17th all-time shutout in Interleague play (last: 5/21/18 vs. KC)...2nd shutout vs. Cleveland (6/9/12 - start by **Kyle Lohse**)...won consecutive games vs. Cleveland for the first time in club history...won their 3rd straight game (last 3 game win streak 6/7-9)... have pitched 19 consecutive scoreless innings at home dating back to the 9th inning of June 16 vs. CHI...pitched consecutive home shutouts for the first time since May 10-11, 2013 vs. COL in starts by **Shelby Miller** and **Adam Wainwright**... received 7.0 or more innings from a starting pitcher for the 4th time in the month of June (**Michael Wacha** 6/3 vs. PIT - 8 IP; **Miles Mikolas** 6/7 vs. MIA - 7 IP; **Jack Flaherty** 6/22 at MIL - 7 IP)...recorded their 4th win this season without hitting a home run (last: 5/27 at PIT).

## INDIANS NOTES

-  **Mike Clevinger** made his 16th start of the season, first against the Cardinals in 2018 and in his career (0-1)...has yet to earn a win in an Interleague game (0-2) over four career starts...eclipsed 100.0 innings for the second consecutive season...had pitched 6.0 or more inning in five straight starts ending tonight (5.0 IP).
-  **José Ramírez** has reached base safely in his last 32 straight games (5/22-6/25), began today with the 2nd-longest active streak behind **Shin-soo Choo's** 37-game streak...has hit safely in his last seven straight road games (8-29, .276).
-  **Michael Brantley** walked twice in a game for the 3rd time this season with all three coming on the road.
-  **The Indians** were shutout for only the 2nd time this season (4/7 vs. KC; **Ian Kennedy, Blaine Boyer, Justin Grimm & Kelvin Herrera**)...were shutout by a National League team for the 21st time since Interleague play began (15th on the road; 2nd by St. Louis)...last time shutout in an Interleague game was 7/4/2017 vs. SD (1-0)...had their 7-game win streak snapped and their 5-game win streak against National League opponents... bullpen allowed a run for the first time in five games (last: 6/19 vs. CWS - 9.2 IP span).
