THE GIANTS: Will try and snap a four-game losing streak as they host the Cardinals in game two of this four-game series tonight...the Giants lost the opener last night, 11-2, being out-hit by an 18-2 count.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: RHP Dereck Rodriguez will make his seventh career start tonight...the 26-year-old right-hander has allowed three runs or fewer in five of his six starts and has given up just one run in his last 14.1 innings pitched...he's 2-0 with a 2.16 ERA (6er, 25.0ip) in his past four starts, striking out 21 batters while allowing just three walks...Rodriguez has never faced the Cardinals.

TONIGHT'S OPPOSING STARTER: RHP John Gant will make his sixth start of the season...he's 1-3 with a 4.61 ERA (14er, 27.1ip) in five outings (one quality start)...Gant has faced the Giants twice in his career, both times in relief, going 0-0 with a 2.25 ERA (1er, 4.0ip)...**OF Andrew McCutchen** (2-for-3 with a double) and **IF Brandon Belt** (RBI double in only at-bat) are the only Giants with limited success against Gant.

RUNS TOUGH TO COME BY: The Giants have been outscored by a 25-5 margin during this four-game losing streak...the offense has tallied just five hits in the last two games (18.0 innings) and 16 total in the last four contests...overall, Giants batters have combined for a .132 average with four extra base hits in this brief skid.

BETTER AT HOME: Despite last night's loss, the Giants are still 26-15 (.634) here at home this season, the third-best home record in the NL behind Philadelphia (30-16, .652) and Chicago (26-14, .650).

NOT A LOT OF REST: The Giants are currently in a stretch of playing 16-consecutive games before their next off day, which is next Thursday, July 12...beginning June 8 and leading up to the All-Star Break, the Giants will have played 36 games in 38 days.

SAME TIME: Following Wednesday's game at Colorado, the Giants are now in a stretch in which they play 34-straight games in the Pacific Time Zone...August 17 at Cincinnati is their next game in which they'll have to turn their watches ahead.

THE FUTURE: OF Heliot Ramos (World Roster) and **RHP Shaun Anderson** (U.S. Roster) will represent the Giants in the All-Star Futures Game, which will be played at 1:00 p.m. (PT) on Sunday at Nationals Park.

2018 ALL-STARS: The 2018 All-Star selections will be unveiled this Sunday, July 8 at 4:00 p.m. PT on ESPN.

AGAINST RIGHTIES: The Giants are 15-5 in their last 20 games against right-handed starters.

GIANTS PITCHING: Despite posting a 6.43 ERA (30er, 42.0ip) over their last five games, Giants pitchers still own a 3.22 ERA (96er, 289.2ip) since June 1, which ranks as the fourth-lowest ERA in the Majors behind the New York-AL (2.65 ERA), Tampa Bay (2.93 ERA) and Houston (3.18 ERA).

WE'RE ALL BACK: With **RHP Jeff Samardzija** expected to be reinstated from the disabled list tomorrow, it will mark the first time all season that the Giants will have their top three starters in the same rotation...Bumgarner missed 60 games this year, Cueto missed 70 and Samardzija has missed a total of 52 contests.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#57 RHP Dereck Rodriguez
6-1, 215, 26 years old (June 5, 1992)
3-1 Record, 3.16 ERA

- 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make his seventh Major League start (eighth appearance) today...the Giants have won five of his six starts.
- Earned the win in the Giants' 7-0 victory at Arizona on Saturday...allowed zero runs on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 6.1 innings...surpassed the 100-pitch mark for the first time in his career.
- Is 2-0 with a 2.50 ERA (5er, 18.0ip) in his three starts AT&T Park, compared to a 1-1 record with a 4.02 ERA (7er, 15.2ip) in his three starts on the road.
- Opponents are batting .500 (7-for-14) off him on the first pitch of an at-bat.
- Ranks second among NL rookies with a 3.16 ERA (min. five games started).
- Signed a minor league contract with the Giants on November 15, 2017...was invited to Major League camp as a non-roster invitee.
- Became the first Giants pitcher to earn his first win in his first Major League start since **Ryan Sadowski** did it on June 28, 2009 at MIL...prior to Rodriguez, the last Giants pitcher to win his first MLB start was **Joe Martinez** on Aug. 5, 2009 at HOU.
- Made his Major League debut on May 29 at COL when he replaced **RHP Jeff Samardzija**, who left the game after 1.0 inning with a tight right shoulder...pitched 3.1 innings, allowing four runs (one earned) on five hits...was removed from the game after being hit in the shin by a 108-mph comebacker...was diagnosed with a shin contusion.
- Made nine starts for triple-A Sacramento this season, his first at the triple-A level...went 4-1 with a 3.40 ERA (19er, 50.1ip).
- Struck out 53 batters in 50.1 innings of work...his 53 strikeouts led the Rivercats and ranked tied for ninth in the PCL at the time of his call up.
- Was drafted in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins...spent his first three professional seasons as an outfielder before converting into a pitcher in 2014.

NOTES: 33-year-old right-hander will make his ninth start of the season...is 1-4 with a 6.56 ERA in eight starts this year, with the Giants going 2-6 in his outings...will be reinstated from the 10-day disabled list tomorrow...missed 35 games with right shoulder tightness...also started the season on the disabled list and missed San Francisco's first 18 games with a right pectoral strain...made four rehab starts with triple-A Sacramento, going 0-2 with a 5.29 ERA (10er, 17.0ip)...last pitched Monday versus Fresno and logged 6.0 innings, allowing a pair of runs on five hits with three strikeouts...prior to this season he had never been on the disabled list and now this year he's missed a total of 53 games due to injury...his last start big league start came May 29 at Colorado...left the game after the 1st inning due to a tight right shoulder...pitched just 1.0 inning...is 3-3 with a 3.45 ERA in 12 career regular season starts against St. Louis...has an 0.83 ERA (2er, 21.2ip) in his past three outings...his last win over the Red Birds came over five years ago on June 18, 2013.
