RAY MATTER—The Rays have won consecutive games following a 1-8 start to the season...the Rays have scored at least 5 runs and recorded double-digit hits in each their last 3 games, their longest such streak since June 8-10, 2017 vs. CWS/OAK...in the first 7 games of the 8-game losing streak, the Rays never scored more than 4 runs and never recorded more than 8 hits...in yesterday's game, the Rays offense recorded 11 hits and drew 10 BB...it was the first time they recorded double-digit hits and walks in a game since April 25, 2014 at CWS, when the Rays suffered a dramatic 9-6 loss on a walk-off grand slam in the 9th inning by rookie **José Abreu** (off **Grant Balfour**)...yesterday, Abreu tagged **Alex Colomé** for a 3-run homer in the 9th inning before Colomé closed it out.

ON THE LINE—The Rays arrived in Chicago with an 8-game losing streak, but today they have a chance to complete a 3-game sweep...never in franchise history have they swept an opponent after entering that series with a losing streak of 8 games or longer, and it's been two years since any other club has turned this trick: in April 2016, the Twins and Braves swept the Angels and Marlins, respectively, both after opening the season 0-9...only twice previously have the Rays won 3 straight games on the heels of an 8-game skid (or longer): May 3-5, 2005 at NYY (won 3 after losing 8) and Sep 11-14, 2004 at KC/BOS (won 3 after losing 12).

+ Today the Rays are attempting to complete their first sweep of 3 games or more on the road since May 16-18, 2016 at TOR...both sweeps of 3 games or more last season came at home, from April 18-20 vs. DET and Sep 29-Oct 1 vs. BAL.

RAYS vs. WHITE SOX—This is the third of 6 games with the White Sox this season...today the Rays are attempting their first-ever sweep in the Windy City, and their third sweep all-time against the White Sox...they swept 3-game series at Tropicana Field, June 12-14, 2015 and July 5-7, 2013...the White Sox visit St. Petersburg for a 3-game series from Aug 3-5...the clubs split the season series last year, with the Rays going 2-1 at Tropicana Field and 1-2 on the road...the Rays are 69-82 (.457) all-time, 38-38 at home and 31-44 on the road...they are 39-36 in the Rays era (since 2008) and 13-8 (.619) under Manager **Kevin Cash** (since 2015).

+ Today is the last game of an 8-game, 10-day trip to New York (0-2), Boston (0-3) and Chicago (2-0)...the Rays have seen snow in all three cities of this road trip and have played 4 games with a first pitch at 40°F or colder.

FAMILIAR FACE—Today is the fourth time the Rays will face **James Shields**, who remains the club's all-time leader with 217 starts, 1,454.2 IP, 87 wins, 1,250 SO, 19 CG, 8 CG SHO and four Opening Day starts (tied with **Chris Archer**)...Shields is 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA (20-IP, 3-ER) in his previous 3 starts against the Rays, most recently Sep 26, 2016 here in Chicago.

+ Tonight will be the 35th time a pitcher from the Rays 2008 AL Championship team will start vs. TB...Rays are 18-16 so far in those games: vs. Shields (0-3), **David Price** (5-5), **Jason Hammel** (4-3), **Edwin Jackson** (3-3), **Scott Kazmir** (4-2) and **Matt Garza** (2-0)...the Rays defeated the White Sox, 3-1, in the ALDS that season.

ZILLA ZONE—Yesterday's starter **Blake Snell** totaled 6 IP, 1 H, 1 R/ER, 5 BB, 10 SO and threw a career-high 114 pitches...in so doing, he became:

- + the fifth pitcher (sixth occurrence) in Rays history to yield 1 hit or fewer while recording at least 10 SO...the last before Snell was **Drew Smyly** on April 19, 2016 at BOS (8-IP, 1-H, 11-SO).
- + the first Ray to earn the win despite at least 5 BB since **Chris Archer** on May 16, 2014 at LAA (5-BB, won 3-0).
- + the fourth pitcher in Rays history to issue 5 BB or more while reaching double-digit strikeouts...also **Matt Moore** (June 25, 2013 vs. TOR; 6-BB, 11-SO), **James Shields** (July 26, 2012 at BAL; 5-BB, 10-SO) and **Matt Garza** (Sep 19, 2009 vs. TOR; 6-BB, 10-SO).

ROTATION TRANSLATION—Prior to the injury to **Nathan Eovaldi**, the Rays planned to open the season with four regular members of the starting rotation and a bullpen day as needed in place of a fifth starter...the Rays pitching staff currently has three starters and a 10-man bullpen, which includes today's starter **Yonny Chirinos** and five other long relievers.

SEEKING LENGTH—Yesterday's start by **Blake Snell** was only the second time this season a Rays starter went at least 6 IP, following **Chris Archer**

on Opening Day vs. BOS (6 IP plus 2 BF in the 7th inning)...it was also the first "quality start" by a Rays pitcher this season (6 IP or more, 3 ER or fewer) and snapped a 10-game streak without one, tied for the longest single-season streak in club history (4th time, last April 10-20, 2005).

HEERE's YONNY—**Yonny Chirinos** has totaled 9 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 7 SO, 110 pitches and 76 strikes (69 pct.) in 2 apps (1 start)—both against the Red Sox—to begin his major league career, including 5 IP without allowing a run in his first career start on Thurs at BOS...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he was the first pitcher to make the first start of his career at Fenway Park and not allow a run in at least 5 IP since ATL **Kyle Davies** did it in his major league debut on May 21, 2005 (5-IP, 4-H, 0-R, 3-BB, 6-SO).

REDEFINING RELIEF—Through 11 games, a Rays reliever has thrown at least 50 pitches six times...the other 29 teams have combined to do it 13 times, and only the Rangers (2) and Marlins (2) have done it more than once...Rays relievers combined to make 6 apps of 50-plus pitches all of last season...Rays relievers have totaled a 4 apps of at least 4 IP, most in the majors, and 9 apps of at least 2 IP, 3rd-most in the majors.

BATS HEATING UP—Over the last 3 games, the Rays have scored in 15 of their 27 offensive innings (55.6 pct.)...in their 8 games prior to this, they had scored in only 11 of 74 frames (14.9 pct.)...over the last 3 games, the Rays have hit .333 (14-for-42) with RISP and have recorded at least 4 hits with RISP in 3 consecutive games for the first time since July 19-21, 2016 at COL/OAK...a further breakdown:

CLOSE SHAVES—Seven of the Rays 11 games this season have been decided in one-run fashion (2-5)...only the Rays and the Indians (3-4) have played that many 1-run games, while the Rays are the only team in the majors with five 1-run losses...since 2016, the Rays are 36-56 (.391) in 1-run games, 2nd-worst winning pct. in the majors to Minnesota (30-49, .380).

HOME SWEET DOME—Following an off day tomorrow, the Rays host the Phillies on Friday to begin a 3-team, 9-game stretch at Tropicana Field—where it is always 72°F...the Rays haven't played the Phillies since July 20-22, 2015 and haven't hosted them since June 23-25, 2009...they are 15-9 all-time against the Phillies (6-3 at home)...in total, they have won six of the eight regular season series between the clubs...the Rays also played the Phillies in their only World Series appearance, losing 4-1 in 2008.

+ Friday's game will snap a club-record streak of nine consecutive day games, dating back to the final game of the first homestand...the current road trip was the first time in franchise history that every game of a multi-city road trip was played during the day.

HOW THEY STACK UP—The Rays are 1-8 against teams that made the postseason last season, and all these games have come against the Red Sox (1-6) and Yankees (0-2)...they are 2-0 against teams that missed the postseason last year, while this series is the first of three straight against teams that finished last season below .500: White Sox, Phillies, Rangers...this series began a stretch where 15 of 19 series through June 13 are against opponents that finished last season below .500.

ROSTER MOVE—Yesterday the Rays acquired outfielder **Jeremy Hazelbaker** from the Diamondbacks in exchange for cash considerations and optioned him to Triple-A Durham...to make room on the 40-man roster, right-handed pitcher **José De León** (recovery from Tommy John surgery) was transferred to the 60-day DL...over two seasons in the majors with the D-backs (2017) and Cardinals (2016), Hazelbaker has hit .258/.327/.500 (65-for-252) with 9 2B, 5 3B, 14 HR and 38 RBI in 155 games (45 starts)...he was designated for assignment by the D-backs on April 6.

THIS DATE IN RAYS HISTORY—On April 11, 2012, the Rays defeated DET **Justin Verlander** with a 4-run rally in the 9th inning, despite entering the final frame with only 1 hit...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, the Rays became the first team in 22 years to beat a pitcher after he had shut them out on 1 hit or fewer through 8 innings.

LAST START—On Thurs at BOS, became the fifth Ray all-time to go at least 5 IP and not allow a run in his first career start, joining **Matt Moore** (5 IP) in 2011, **Scott Kazmir** (5 IP) in 2004, **Doug Waechter** (9 IP) in 2003 and **Jason Standridge** (6.1 IP) in 2001...also joined **Scott Kazmir** (6 IP) in 2004 and **Steve Trachsel** (9 IP) as the only Rays with a scoreless outing of at least 5 IP in their first career game at Fenway Park...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he was the first pitcher to make the first start of his career at Fenway Park and not allow a run in at least 5 IP since ATL **Kyle Davies** did it in his major league debut on May 21, 2005 (5-IP, 4-H, 0-R, 3-BB, 6-SO).

- + Threw 54 pitches in 5 IP, and his pitch count by inning was 11-9-15-11-8...eight of his 15 outs came on three pitches or fewer...retired his last 7 BF, from the last out of the 3rd inning through the 5th...allowed a leadoff triple to **J.D. Martinez** in the 2nd inning, then got three groundball outs without allowing the run to score...his line: ND, 5 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 4 SO, 54 pit, 38 str.

THE EARLY GOING—Has totaled 9 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 7 SO, 110 pit. and 76 str. (69 pct.) in 2 apps (1 start)—both against the Red Sox—to begin his major league career.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT—On April 1 vs. BOS, his only hit allowed in 4 IP was the game-winning single by **Rafael Devers** in the 6th inning (run charged to **José Alvarado**)...his line: ND, 4 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 SO, 2 HBP, 56 pit, 38 str. ...became the third pitcher in club history with a scoreless app/start of at least 4 IP in his major league debut, following **Enny Romero** (4.2 IP, start) on Sep 22, 2013 vs. BAL and **Scott Kazmir** (5 IP, start) on Aug 23, 2004 at SEA...it was the longest scoreless relief outing ever for a Rays pitcher making his major league debut...the 24-year-old became the sixth pitcher in his lifetime to debut in relief, go 4 IP or more and allow 1 hit or fewer and no runs, joining HOU **Joe Musgrove** in 2016, CLE **Ryan Merritt** in 2016, CWS **José Quintana** in 2012, KC **Dusty Hughes** in 2009 and ARI **Max Scherzer** in 2008.

ROTATION TRANSLATION—Prior to the injury to **Nathan Eovaldi**, the Rays planned to open the season with four regular members of the starting rotation and a bullpen day as needed in place of a fifth starter...the Rays pitching staff currently has three starters and a 10-man bullpen, which includes Chirinos and five other long relievers.

PITCHER OF THE YEAR—Named the 2017 Minor League Pitcher of the Year by the Rays Baseball Operations department...spent the majority of the season with Triple-A Durham, earning a May 2 promotion from Double-A Montgomery...went 13-5 with a 2.73 ERA (168.1-IP, 51-ER) in 27 apps (26 starts) between the two levels.

- + Was added to the Rays 40-man roster following the season.
- + Led Rays minor leaguers in innings...tied for 2nd in wins, one shy of **José Mujica** (14)...ranked 3rd with 141 SO and 4th in ERA.
- + Despite spending a month at the Double-A level, ranked among International League leaders in ERA (2.74, 4th), wins (12, tied for 4th), innings (141, 5th) and WHIP (0.98, 2nd).

TRIPLE-A CHAMPION—Made 2 starts for the Bulls in the postseason, going 1-1 with a 0.75 ERA (12-IP, 1-ER)...did not allow a run in 7 IP of Game 2 of the IL Semifinals vs. Indianapolis (Pirates), giving Durham a 2-0 series lead...received no run support in a Game 2 loss vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (Yankees) in the Governors' Cup...did not pitch in the Triple-A Championship Game win over Memphis (Cardinals).

X-RAY REPORT—Yonny's favorite player growing up was Yankees closer **Mariano Rivera**...as a child, he and his friends would play a game similar to baseball that replaced the ball and bat with *chapitas*, or bottle caps, and a broomstick...his favorite meals are *arepas*—baked cornmeal patties sometimes stuffed with cheese or meat—and chicken with rice.

FRIDAY'S STARTER: RH JAKE FARIA (0-1, 14.29 ERA)

LAST START—On Sat at BOS, went a career-low 1.2 IP while allowing a career-high 8 runs and career-high-tying 5 BB (also July 30, 2017 at NYY)...was the first Ray to allow 8 ER in a start of 2 IP or fewer since **Jae Weong Seo** on Sep 25, 2006 vs. NYY...he was the first starting pitcher to throw at least 73 pitches without completing the 2nd inning since NYM **Mike Pelfrey** on July 19, 2010 at ARI (74 pitches, 1.1 IP)...yielded 4 runs on 4 hits and 1 BB in the 1st inning, and 4 BB plus a grand slam to **Xander Bogaerts** in the 2nd inning, the first allowed in his career...also marked his first career app in the majors without a strikeout...his line: L, 1.2 IP, 5 H, 8 R, 5 BB, 0 SO, 1 HR, 73 pit, 34 str.

WINLESS STREAK—Is seeking his first win since July 25, 2017 vs. BAL...has gone 0-4 with a 6.43 ERA (35-IP, 25-ER) in his 9 apps (7 starts) since his last win, after going 5-1 with a 2.67 ERA (57.1-IP, 17-ER) in 9 starts to begin his career...this is his second major league season after making his major league debut last June 7 vs. CWS.

vs. PHILADELPHIA—Has never faced the Phillies...in the only inter-league start of his career, last Aug 4 vs. MIL, he took the loss despite allowing only 1 R/ER in 6 IP of a 2-0 Rays loss...his 9 SO that game remain tied for his career high (also June 18, 2017 at DET).

#16 KEVIN CASH, MANAGER

- + Is in his fourth season as Rays manager...at age 40, is the majors' youngest active skipper—5 months younger than SD **Andy Green**.
- + His last ejection was July 18, 2017 at OAK, his seventh ejection as Rays manager...his 7 ejections are tied for 4th in franchise history.
- + Is the sixth Tampa-born manager in major league history, and second to manage the Rays...that list includes Hall of Famers **Al Lopez** and **Tony La Russa**, **Lou Piniella**, **Dave Miley** and **John Hart**.

- + Played 12 professional seasons as a catcher, incl. parts of eight seasons in the majors (2002-10) and two years (2005-06) in the Rays org.
- + Played in the 1989 Little League World Series (Tampa Northside LL), 1999 College World Series (Florida State) and earned World Series rings in 2007 (Red Sox) and 2009 (Yankees).
