During the past seven series (since 5/10), the Brewers are a Major League-best 16-6 (.727).....the team is outscoring its opponents, 116-79, during this stretch.

Winning

At 37-22, the Brewers are a season-high tying 15 games over the .500 mark and are looking to climb 16 games over .500 for the first time since 8/19/14 (71-55).

Ryan Braun is 1 stolen base away from reaching #200 for his career.....he ranks third in franchise history in stolen bases, trailing Paul Molitor (412) and Robin Yount (271).

Hader's Gonna Hater

The Brewers are 20-0 this season in games where Josh Hader pitches.....he has 69 strikeouts in just 34.1 innings, most among Major League relievers, while holding opponents to a .091 batting average (10-for-110).

Feeling a Draft

The Brewers will make the 21st selection in the first round of tomorrow evening's First-Year Player Draft.....the franchise's first-ever selection, Gorman Thomas, was chosen 21st overall in 1969 by the Seattle Pilots (it is the only other time that the franchise owned the 21st selection).

The Brewers are 12-5-1 in series play.....have won 6 straight series. **Game 1:** 11-8, **Game 2:** 14-5, **Game 3:** 9-7, **Game 4:** 3-2

AT HOME: The Brewers are 18-11 at home, going 5-3-1 in series play.....after a 2-6 start, the Brewers have gone 16-5 over their last 21 home games.....the team had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 4/17-4/22.....the team went 46-38 at home last season, going 14-9-4 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 19-11 on the road, going 7-2-0 in series play.....are 11-4 over their last 15 road games.....the Brewers had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11.....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (257-263) and third full season.....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach Darnell Coles (4th season), pitching coach Derek Johnson (3rd season), coach Jason Lane (3rd season), bench coach Pat Murphy (3rd season), third base coach Ed Sedar (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach Carlos Subero (3rd season) and bullpen coach Lee Tunell (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made nine replay challenges, going 3-6.....their last challenge (won) came on 5/26 vs. New York-NL as an out call at first base involving Hernán Pérez was overturned.....team was 17-27 in 44 replay challenges in 2017.

TODAY'S STARTER: #35 - LHP BRENT SUTER (12g, 10gs, 5-3, 4.63)

SUTER AT A GLANCE: Brent Suter, 28, is making his 13th appearance and 11th start....

Suter last started on Monday vs. St. Louis in an 8-3 win (5ip, 5h, 3r, 3er, 0bb, 6k, 2hr)....he has won his last 3 starts, posting a 3.31 ERA (16.1ip, 6er)....the team is 5-5 in his starts.... he has not made a quality start....opponents are batting .270 (63-for-233, 11hr)....Suter, who made his first career Opening Day roster, was selected in the 31st round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft....bio is on p. 135 of the media guide....name is pronounced "soo-ter."

THE STANSBURY OF THE EAST: Like GM David Stearns, Suter is a Harvard graduate....he earned a degree in environmental science and public policy.

LAST SEASON: Suter went 3-2 with a 3.42 ERA in 22 games (14 starts) during six stints with Milwaukee....he was named Brewers Unsung Hero as voted on by members of the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA....he was 3-2 with a 3.45 ERA as a starter (70.1ip, 27er) and 0-0 with a 3.18 ERA in relief (11.1ip, 4er)....the team went 9-5 in his starts....he had 4 quality starts....opponents batted .263 (83-for-315, 8hr)....he was named Brewers Pitcher of the Month for July (5gs, 2-0, 1.50era)....Suter was on the 10-day disabled list from 8/13-8/31 with a left rotator cuff strain....he also went 3-1 with a 4.42 ERA in 10 games / 8 starts at Triple-A Colorado Springs.
