OF Nick Markakis collected his 19th double of the season last night, moving into a tie for the most two-base hits in the league with teammates Ozzie Albies and Freddie Freeman (also, SD's Eric Hosmer)

Since the franchise moved to Atlanta in 1966, no Braves player has ever led the league in doubles.

Coincidentally, however, a Braves player led the N.L. in doubles in each of the club's final two years in Milwaukee. Lee Maye had 44 in 1964 and Hank Aaron had 40 in 1965.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Dodgers finish a three-game set today with the third meeting between the clubs this season...Los Angeles will visit SunTrust Park, July 26-29, for four games to complete the teams' season series.

A The Braves had lost 11 of their last 14 games here, dating to the start of the 2014 season, before last night's 5-3 victory...With a win today, the Braves will take a series at Dodger Stadium for the first time since April 23-25, 2012, when Atlanta won two-of-three games.

A LHP Sean Newcomb is set to face the Dodgers for the third time in his career...He walked 12 over 10.2 total innings, including a career-most seven on August 3 of last season at SunTrust Park...Newcomb went 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA (6 ER/10.2 IP) in those two starts.

A RHP Ross Stripling is set for his fifth appearance against the Braves, second start...He has no decisions against Atlanta...The righty has won four consecutive starts, allowing just two runs, earned (0.73 ERA) over this stretch that dates to May 19.

NEWCOMB: LHP Sean Newcomb has won a career-best seven consecutive decisions, compiling a 1.96 ERA (14 ER/64.1 IP) over the 11-game streak that dates to April 8...The left-hander dropped his season debut before starting his hot stretch.

A Newcomb's streak is the longest by a Braves starter since Mike Minor also won seven straight from August 25, 2012 through April 10, 2013.

A The last Braves starter with as long a streak in a single season was Tim Hudson, who also won seven straight, July 6-August 26, 2012.

A The last Braves starter to win eight consecutive decisions was Kris Medlen, who won an Atlanta franchise-record 15 from May 31, 2009-September 30, 2012.

NEWCOMB HOMERLESS: LHP Sean Newcomb has not allowed a home run in his last 42.0 innings, dating to the bottom of the sixth in his start on April 26 at Cincinnati...His 42.0-inning run is the longest active streak by a starter in the majors, and the second longest overall (Washington's Ryan Madson - 57.1 IP).

A Newcomb's homerless run is the longest by a Braves starter in consecutive turns since Kris Medlen tossed 43.0 consecutive homerless innings over his final six starts in 2013.

A Newcomb has allowed just 13 home runs over 168.2 innings since his debut last season, and his 0.69 homers per 9.0 innings in that span are fewest in the majors among qualified starters.

RISP: The Braves went 7-for-15 (.467) with runners in scoring position last night, and lead MLB with a .288 (155-for-539) average in such situations this season.

DAY GAME: The Braves are 15-5 (.750) in day games this season, the best record in the National League... They have compiled a 3.26 team ERA (67 ER/185.0) while holding the opposition to a .205 batting average in daylight this season.

A On a per day game basis, the Braves lead the major leagues in home runs (1.70/34 total) and are tops in the National League in runs (6.10/122 total).

A The Braves have hit 34 home runs in 20 day games, compared to 40 home runs in 44 night games.

RUBBER GAME: With last night's win, the Braves set up today's rubber game...Atlanta is 7-2 in rubber games this season.

A The Braves are looking to win their 13th series of the year...The club did not collect that number last season until a sweep of Arizona, July 14-July 16 in the team's first series out of the All-Star break.

TWO-OUT RUNS: The Braves scored three of their five runs with two outs last night, giving them a MLB-most 136 this season.

A They also lead the majors with a .285 batting average and a .370 on-base percentage with two outs, while their .472 slugging percentage ranks second behind only Milwaukee.

CULBERSON: UTIL Charlie Culberson went 3-for-4 with a RBI last night and since May 28, when OF Ronald Acuña Jr. went to the 10-day disabled list, Culberson is hitting .378 (14-for-37) with three doubles, two game-ending home runs and 10 RBI.

A Since 2016, when he joined the Dodgers, Culberson has hit .344 (21-for-61) with two home runs and seven RBI in 35 games, including postseason play, at Dodger Stadium.

FREEMAN: 1B Freddie Freeman collected three more hits last night to tie teammate Nick Markakis for the most in the National League at 84...The Braves have not had a player lead the league in hits since 1992, when Terry Pendleton tied for the most with 199.

A Among National Leaguers, Freeman ranks first in on-base percentage (.433) and OPS (.994), tied for first in doubles (19) and hits (84), fourth in slugging percentage (.561) and ninth in runs scored (40).

SWANSON: SS Dansby Swanson scored a career high-tying three runs last night and since the start of this month, the shortstop is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with nine runs scored, three doubles, three home runs and a .710 slugging percentage in eight games.

SAVE: RHP Aroldys Vizcaíno collected his 11th save of the season last night, working around a leadoff single... The Braves bullpen has blown only six saves this season, one off the MLB lead of Boston, Cincinnati, Oakland, and San Diego.

Today's Game

- A* Makes his 13th start of the season and the 32nd of his career.
 - A* Set to celebrate his 25th birthday on Tuesday, June 12.
- A* Last pitched on Tuesday, 6/5, and starts today on four days' rest...Is 3-0 with a 0.95 (2 ER/19.0 IP) in three starts on four days' rest this season, allowing opponents to bat just .136.
 - A* Among pitchers to make at least three starts on four days' rest this season, his 0.95 ERA ranks fourth best in the majors.
- A* Has not allowed a home run in his last 42.0 innings, dating to the bottom of the sixth in his start on 4/26 at CIN...His 42.0-inning run is the longest active streak by a starter in the majors, and the second longest overall (RP Ryan Madson - 57.1 IP).
 - A* Newcomb's homerless run is the longest by a Braves starter in consecutive turns since Kris Medlen tossed 43.0 consecutive homerless innings over his final six starts in 2013.
 - A* Newcomb has allowed just 13 home runs over 168.2 innings since his debut last season, and his 0.69 homers per 9.0 innings in that span are fewest in the majors among qualified starters.
- A* Ran his career-best winning streak to seven games in his last start, 6/5 at SD...The seven-game run dates to his second start of the season, 4/8 at COL, and is tied for the second-longest active streak in the majors.
 - A* Newcomb's streak is the longest by a Braves left-handed starter since Mike Minor also won seven straight from 8/25/12-4/10/13.
 - A* Since that start on 4/8 at COL, ranks fifth in the majors in ERA (1.96), fourth in wins (tied, 7) and eighth in opponents' average (.195).
- A* Set to make his third career start against the Dodgers...Is 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA (6 ER/10.2 IP) in his two starts against them last season, and walked 12 batters in 10.2 innings.

2018 Recap

- A* Blanked the Padres over 6.0 innings in his last start, 6/5 at SD...Allowed three hits and three walks in a 14-1 Atlanta win.
 - A* The start was his fifth scoreless turn of the season, tied with Justin Verlander and Jacob deGrom for the most such starts in the majors this season.
- A* Finished the month of May 5-0 with a 1.54 ERA (6 ER/35.0 IP) and no home runs allowed...Atlanta went 5-1 in his six starts.
 - A* His five wins in the month were most in the majors, while his 1.54 ERA ranked sixth best in the N.L...His batting average against of .158 was the lowest in the league among qualifying pitchers.
 - A* Newcomb allowed 19 total hits in 35.0 innings during the month, becoming the first Braves player in the last 110 seasons to make at least six starts in a month and allow 19 hits or less.
- A* Earned his sixth win of the season, 5/31 vs. WSH, after holding the Nationals to four hits and two runs in a career high-tying 7.0 innings...Was his first career victory against the Nationals.
 - A* Retired 14 of the final 15 batters that he faced.
- A* Faced Miami for the second consecutive turn, 5/19, and allowed four hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his fourth consecutive win.
 - A* A run-scoring groundout by Bryan Holaday scored Justin Bour with one out in the second inning to snap Newcomb's scoreless streak at 21 consecutive innings...The run was the longest of his career...Newcomb's run was the longest by a Braves pitcher since Julio Teheran in 2016 (23.0 IP), and the longest by a left-handed starter for Atlanta since Paul Maholm in 2013 (25.1 IP)
- A* Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed a career-low one hit, 5/13 at MIA...The start was his third consecutive scoreless turn.
 - A* Became the first Braves pitcher over the last 110 seasons to allow two hits or fewer and no runs in three consecutive starts.
- A* Allowed two hits and three walks over 6.0 scoreless innings, 5/8 at TB...Turned in consecutive scoreless starts for the first time in his career.
 - A* Tampa Bay logged just two hits, both of which were singles...Newcomb became the first Braves starter since Greg Maddux (6/27 and 7/2/99) to log consecutive scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings with two or fewer hits allowed.
- A* Tossed a career-most 7.0 innings, 5/2 at NYM, and held the Mets to just two hits and one walk while fanning eight.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 4/8 at COL, after allowing just five hits in 6.0+ scoreless innings...Did not walk a batter for the first time in his career...Pitched into the seventh for the third time in his career after facing two batters to open the inning.
 - A* Walked at least one batter in each of his first 20 career games...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only two other pitchers opened their careers with longer streaks of walking at least one batter - Pete Smith (29 games) and Tom Glavine (27 games).

- Has just three hits in his last 36 at-bats...His double in Monday's (6/4) seventh inning at SD snapped a 0-for-16 hitless spell.
- Despite his current offensive slump, still leads the N.L. in extra-base hits (35) and runs (51)...Is tied for the lead in doubles (19), is second in total bases (135), tied for third in home runs (14) and is tied for 10th in hits (70).
- Ranks tied for second in MLB with nine games with multiple extra-base hits...Is over half way to the Atlanta franchise record for most such games in a season, shared by Chipper Jones and Javy Lopez (17).
- Is hitting .349 (22-for-63) in the first inning this season...His 22 hits and 12 extra base-hits in the first inning are the most in the N.L, while his six home runs are tied for the most in the N.L.
- Set the franchise record for most extra-base hits (22) by the end of April and tied for the second most in MLB history...Broke the Atlanta record of 17 held by Dale Murphy, Chipper Jones and Justin Upton...Finished one shy of Jermaine Dye's 2000 record.
- Hit his first career grand slam, 5/10 at MIA, becoming the youngest Braves player (21 years, 123 days) to hit one since fellow Curaçao native Andruw Jones, 8/31/97 at BOS.

- Over his last 14 games, dating to 5/19, has a .364 average with five extra base-hits and 10 RBI...In his 25 games prior to 5/19, hit .191 (9-for-47).
- Homered with a runner aboard for his fourth career game-ending home run last Sunday, 6/3 vs. WSH...Also hit a game-ending pinch-home run on 5/28 vs. NYM (G1) for his first home run with the Braves...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1996, the only other Braves player to hit a game-ending pinch-hit home run for his first homer with the team was Keith Lockhart on 5/21/97.

- All of Culberson's game-ending RBI have come on home runs and four of his eight career home runs have been game-ending shots.
- Has made 18 starts (9 in LF, 7 at 3B, 2 at SS)...The team is 11-6 when he starts.
- Is 4-for-17 (.235) as a pinch hitter with nine strikeouts and two home runs.
- Acquired from LAD along w/three other players, 12/16/17 in exchange for M. Kemp.
- Played in 10 total postseason games in 2017, including five during the NLCS and five WS contests...Hit a combined .500 (8-for-16) with four extra-base hits.
