ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 29-26 on the road, going 9-6-2 in series play....had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11 and a season-high 6-game road losing streak from 7/11-7/15....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (282-288) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 18 replay challenges, going 4-14....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/15 at Pittsburgh as an out call at third base involving Lorenzo Cain stood....went 17-27 in 44 replay challenges last season.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #20 - LHP WADE MILEY (5gs, 1-1, 2.01)

MILEY AT A GLANCE: Wade Miley, 31, will be making his sixth start of the season and second against the Dodgers....Miley last started last Thursday at San Francisco and received no decision in the Brewers' 7-5 win (5ip, 6h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 1k)....the team is 3-2 in his starts.... he has 2 quality starts....opponents are batting .225 (18-for-80, 0hr)....Miley was placed on the 10-day disabled list on 5/9 with a right oblique strain and transferred to the 60-day DL on 5/12....he was reinstated on 7/12....he was signed to a minor-league contract on 2/16 and invited to Major League camp....he suffered a groin strain while fielding a bunt on 3/21 vs. Oakland and was reassigned to minor-league camp on 3/28....Miley began a rehab assignment on 4/17 at Double-A Biloxi and joined the Brewers on 5/2....he returned to Biloxi for a second rehab stint on 6/22....bio is available in the press box.

LAST SEASON: Miley went 8-15 with a 5.61 ERA in 32 starts with Baltimore....he made 30+ starts for the fifth consecutive season....the team went 15-17 in his starts....he made 8 quality starts....opponents batted .287 (179-for-624, 25hr).

CAREER: Is 67-75 with a 4.33 ERA in 205 games / 201 starts (1178ip, 567er)....he has pitched for Arizona (2011-14), Boston (2015), Seattle (2016), Baltimore (2016-17) and Milwaukee (2018)....Miley was a 2012 National League All-Star while pitching for the Diamondbacks.

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 1-2 with an 8.15 ERA in 5 starts (17.2ip, 16er)....is 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 2 starts this season (6.1ip, 0er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 34-40 with a 4.21 ERA in 110 games / 109 starts (628.1ip, 294er)....is 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA in 3 starts this season (16ip, 5er).
