## Rockies Notes

🔗 **RHP Antonio Senzatela** made his first career postseason appearance, becoming the second-youngest Rockies pitcher to start a postseason game.....the only younger pitcher to start a postseason game for Colorado was Franklin Morales, who started a game in each the NLDS and NLCS in 2007 at 21 years of age.....made 13 starts in 23 appearances during the regular season.....including the regular season, has allowed 2 runs or fewer in each of his last 4 starts, during which time he has posted a 2.08 ERA (21.2ip, 5er).....was his first appearance against the Brewers since making his Major League debut against them on 4/6/17 at Miller Park.

🔗 **RF Carlos González** tripled in the fifth inning, the Rockies' first hit of the game.....snapped a streak of 12 straight retired by Brandon Woodruff and Corbin Burnes dating back to DJ LeMahieu's one-out walk in the first inning.....was the fifth postseason triple by a Rockies player, first since Brad Hawpe in Game 3 of the 2007 World Series vs. Boston.

🔗 **González** has reached base in each of his last 9 games dating back to 9/21, batting .310 (9-for-29) during this span.....is a career .500 hitter (14-for-28) in the postseason, tying Kazuo Matsui for third on the team's all-time postseason hits list.

🔗 **PH Matt Holliday's** single in the ninth inning was his 15th career postseason hit with the Rockies, tying Yorvit Torrealba atop the team's all-time postseason hits list.....his 71 career postseason hits rank third among active players behind only Albert Pujols and Yadier Molina, who each have 90.

🔗 **The Rockies** are now 3-1 all-time in extra-innings postseason games, including 1-1 this postseason.....were held to the fewest hits in a postseason game in franchise history.....prior to today, the team's previous mark for fewest hits in a postseason game was 5 in Game 2 of the 2007 World Series at Boston.

## Brewers Notes

🔗 **RHP Brandon Woodruff** made his first career postseason appearance, becoming the fourth-youngest Brewer to start a postseason game....the only pitchers to start a postseason game for the Crew at a younger age were Yovani Gallardo (2008, '11), Carlos Villanueva (2008) and Moose Haas (1981).....made 4 starts in 19 appearances in the regular season, but none since 6/10 at Philadelphia.....including the regular season, has not allowed a run over his last 5 appearances, spanning 10 innings (4h, 3bb, 11k), and has allowed just 1 run in 15.1 innings (0.59 ERA) with 10 hits, 4 walks and 19 strikeouts across 8 appearances since being recalled from Triple-A on 9/2.

🔗 **Woodruff** started today's game at 25 years, 236 days of age, while Antonio Senzatela started the contest at 23 years, 256 days old.....according to Baseball Reference, this was the first time two pitchers this young started opposite one another in a postseason game since Kansas City's Yordano Ventura (24 years, 149 days) and New York-NL's Noah Syndergaard (23 years, 62 days) in Game 3 of the 2015 World Series.

🔗 **RF Christian Yelich** is just the fifth Brewers player to reach base at least 4 times in a postseason game, first since Mike Cameron in Game 3 of the 2008 NLDS vs. Philadelphia.....hit a 2-run home run in the first inning, his first career postseason homer.....led the Brewers with 36 home runs during the regular season, including 25 homers in 65 games after the All-Star break - the second-highest total in franchise history (Richie Sexson, 27 in 2001).....including the regular season, has hit 6 home runs in his last 9 games and 9 in his last 17 contests.....has reached base in 13 straight contests dating back to 9/17, batting .500 (23-for-46) with 17 runs, 5 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs and 23 RBI during this span.

🔗 **LF Ryan Braun** recorded his ninth career multi-hit game in the postseason, extending his franchise record to three more than Paul Molitor's 6 such contests.....has hit safely in 13 of his 16 career postseason games, batting .381 (24-for-63).....his first-inning single was his 23rd career postseason hit, passing Robin Yount and Paul Molitor, who each had 22, for the Brewers' all-time lead.

🔗 **RHP Corbin Burnes** made his first career postseason appearance, tossing 2 scoreless frames in relief of Woodruff.....this marked the first time the Brewers have had multiple pitchers toss multiple scoreless innings in a postseason game.....in appearances of at least 2 innings this season (regular or postseason), Burnes has allowed just 2 runs with 8 hits, 4 walks and 20 strikeouts in 17.2 innings of work (1.02 ERA).

🔗 **RHP Corey Knebel** has not allowed a run in his 17 appearances (regular or postseason) since being recalled from Triple-A on 9/2.....has allowed 5 hits, 4 walks and struck out 34 during this span, holding opposing hitters to a .089 batting average (5-for-56).

🔗 **The Crew** tied their postseason record by having at least 4 pitchers record at least 4 outs.....this was also accomplished in Game 4 of the 2008 NLDS vs. Philadelphia and Game I of the 1981 ALDS vs. New York-AL.

🔗 **The Brewers** recorded their first postseason win since Game 4 of the 2011 National League Championship Series at St. Louis.....recorded their second postseason walk-off win, also Game 5 of the 2011 NLDS vs. Arizona, improving to 2-0 in extra-inning postseason games.....had 10 walk-off wins during the regular season, tied with Oakland and San Francisco for second in the majors, behind only St. Louis (11), and the Club's most since 2010 (10).....have won 6 of their 8 matchups against the Rockies this season (regular or postseason) and 8 of their last 10 overall (regular or postseason) against Colorado dating back to 8/19/17.
