TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Phillies play game two of this three-game series...SF blanked the Phillies 4-0 last night for their fifth shutout of the season and first here at AT&T Park...the Giants will be seeking their third-straight win tonight and their fourth consecutive at AT&T Park.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to tonight's game: **IF Brandon Belt** (Appendicitis) has been placed on the 10-day disabled list... **IF Alen Hanson** (#19) (left hamstring strain) returned from his rehab assignment and has been reinstated from the 10-day DL.

BELT UPDATE: **IF Brandon Belt** left last night's game after having just one at-bat and playing 2.0 innings and was rushed to the hospital to be evaluated for appendicitis...he underwent an appendectomy and is expected to be released from the hospital today.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: **LHP Andrew Suárez** makes his eighth career start tonight...he'll be seeking his first win at AT&T Park as he's 0-2 with a 4.91 ERA (10er, 18.1ip) in three starts...Suárez will attempt to snap a personal three-game losing streak as he's 0-3 with an 8.05 ERA (17er, 19.0ip) in his last four starts.

HOME COOKING: The Giants have posted a 15-10 (.600) record at AT&T Park, winning nine of their last 13 games...San Francisco's .600 home winning percentage ranks as the third-best figure in the National League behind the Phillies (.679) and Brewers (.621).

WELCOME BACK JOE: **IF Joe Panik** reached base safely in four of his five plate appearances last night in his first game back from the disabled list...Panik currently leads all MLB players in lowest miss rate on swings (8%) and in pitches in the strike zone (2%).

FIRST INNING BLUES: San Francisco has struggled in the 1st inning this season, allowing a total of 51 runs over their 57 games...the Giants have trailed after the 1st inning in 22 of their 57 games this season, the most in the Majors.

ON THE MOUND: The Giants will be seeking back-to-back quality starts for the first time since May 4-5 at Atlanta (Chris Stratton & Ty Blach).

CRAWFORD AT THE PLATE: **IF Brandon Crawford** has 44 hits beginning May 1, tied with Cleveland's Francisco Lindor and Minnesota's Eddie Rosario for the most of any Major League player...Crawford leads all MLB with a .415 batting average (44-for-106) beginning May 1 and ranks second in OBP (.448) and seventh in OPS (1.071)...SF is 12-5 this year when Crawford has at least two hits in a game.

STARTING PITCHERS: Giants starting pitchers have logged 6.0-or-more innings just six times in the last 24 games and have just four quality starts in this stretch, posting a 6.05 ERA (78er, 116.0ip)

FEELING THE DRAFT: The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place next Monday, June 4 through Wednesday, June 6...the Giants have the second overall selection on the first day, their highest pick in 33 years since they drafted Will Clark second overall in the 1985 draft...the Giants will be represented at the draft's headquarters - the MLB Network studio in New Jersey - by former pitcher Ryan Vogelsong and senior advisor of the Giants home clubhouse, Mike Murphy...the draft will begin Monday at 4:00 p.m. PT.

This Date in Giants History: June 2, 2011

Aubrey Huff hit three homers and drove in six runs, leading the Giants to a 12-7 win over the Cardinals...his performance made a winner of **Jonathan Sanchez**, despite his walking six batters against only one strikeout in 5.1 innings...Huff's first two long balls came against two pitchers making their Major League debut, loser Lance Lynn and reliever Maikel Cleto.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#59 LHP Andrew Suárez
6-0, 187, 25 years old (September 11, 1992)
1-4 Record, 5.65 ERA

- The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his eighth career Major League start...has gone 1-4 with a 5.65 ERA (23er, 36.2ip) in seven outings, with the Giants going 1-6 in those games.
- Received a no decision in the Giants' 10-inning, 6-5 loss at Colorado on Memorial Day...allowed four runs (three earned) on five hits and matched his career-high with seven strikeouts.
- Has been recalled twice from triple-A Sacramento, first on April 11 to make a spot start and again on May 1 as the Giants needed an extra starter due to a doubleheader April 28...with **RHP Johnny Cueto** being placed on the disabled list May 1, Suárez slid into the Giants' starting rotation.
- Opponents have 11 hits in 29 at-bats (.379) off him with runners in scoring position...is holding opponents to a .091 average (1-for-11) with RISP and two outs.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .209 clip (9-for-43) with 13 strikeouts...righties are hitting .333 (33-for-99) with seven home runs off him.
- Opponents are hitting just .213 (10-for-47) off his slider this year compared to a .357 average (15-for-42) off his fastball.
- Opponents are batting .353 (12-for-34) with six extra-base hits and 11 RBI off him in the first inning, compared to a combined .278 (30-for-108) average and 13 RBI in every other inning.
- Made his Major League debut April 11 against the Diamondbacks...he became the sixth pitcher to make his MLB debut in a start for the Giants over the last 10 seasons (2009-18), which ranks as the fewest among all NL clubs.
