MARINERS NOTES:

- The Mariners fall to 5-1 against the Orioles this season.
- The Mariners have scored 100 runs in the 1st inning this season, their most in any inning...next highest: 72 runs in the 4th inning.
- The Mariners used 20 players in tonight's game...marks the first time the Mariners used 20 players in a 9 inning game since Sept. 6, 2016 vs. TEX.
- **Mitch Haniger** (1x5) extended his career-high hitting streak to 16 games, the longest active streak in the Majors...during that span, he is batting .309 (21x68) with 12 runs scored, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 6 RBI, 2 hit by pitch and 8 walks.
 - Has hit safely in 29 of his last 33 games (7/31-c), batting .331 (46x139) with 21 runs scored, 14 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 16 RBI, 2 HBP and 11 walks.
- **Nelson Cruz** (1x2, R, 2 BB) has reached base safely in 58 of 62 career games (w/AB) against the Orioles, including 55 games with at least 1 hit...overall he is batting .352 (64x182) with 46 runs, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 12 home runs, 51 RBI, 3 HBP, 28 walks and 4 stolen bases.
 - Recorded 2+ walks for the 8th time this season, 75th time in his career.
- **Robinson Canó** (3x3, 2 R, HR, BB, RBI) hit his 3rd home run since being reinstated, his 7th home run of the season.
 - Recorded his 17th multi-hit of the season.
 - Tonight reached base safely via hit or walk in all 4 of his at bats...marks the 3rd time this season he has reached base 4+ times in a game (last: 4/13 vs. OAK).
- **Ben Gamel** (0x2) recorded his 4th outfield assist of the season when he threw out Chris Davis at the plate to end the 2nd inning.
 - Made a diving catch down the right field line to record the 2nd out in the 5th inning.
 - Made a diving catch in shallow right field to record the 1st out of the 7th inning.
- **Wade LeBlanc** has allowed only 1 run over his last 3 starts (0.47 ERA; 1 ER, 19.0 IP).
 - Has tossed 6+ innings and allowed 1 run or less in 4 of his last 6 starts.
 - Used only 68 pitches to get through his 6.0 innings of work, his 3rd fewest amount of pitches thrown in a start this season (fewest: 58, 5/9 vs. OAK).
- **David Freitas** (2x3, 2B) recorded his 4th multi-hit game of the season.
 - Picked up his 5th double of the season, his first since April 19 vs. HOU.
 - Made is 1st start since July 21... was called up from AAA Tacoma on September 1.

ORIOLES NOTES:

- The Orioles recorded their first win on the road since August 18 at Cleveland.
- **Alex Cobb** has pitched 6+ innings and allowed 2 runs or less in 6 of his last 7 starts.
 - Is 3-1 with a 2.51 ERA (13 ER, 46.2 IP) since the beginning of August (7 starts).
 - Recorded his 15th quality start of the year, tied for his 2nd most in any season (most: 17, 2014)... he joins Reynaldo Lopez as the only other player this season to record 15+ quality starts and be credited with 5 wins or less.
- **Renato Núñez** (3x4, R, HR, RBI) tied the game with a solo home run in the top of the 7th inning.
 - Recorded his 9th multi-hit game of the season, his 3rd game with 3 hits.
- **Trey Mancini** (3x5, 2B, RBI) recorded his 3+ hits for the 9th time this season, 19th time in his career.
- **Joey Rickard** (1x4, BB) extended his hitting streak to 5 games (8/19-c), batting .400 (6x15) during that span.
- **Chris Davis** (2x5, RBI) is batting .299 (20x67) with 4 extra-base hits and 10 RBI in his last 18 games.
 - Recorded his 16th multi-hit game of the year.

BALTIMORE MANAGER BUCK SHOWALTER:

On getting the run on the run-down:

"We had been working on that all spring training. First of all, it's kind of a mistake that gets rewarded. Quite frankly, you shouldn't go on that ball, and a lot of people just give up, but he stopped and got the run-down going. That's baseball moxy. How do you draw that up? That's a field play at third base. That's the more impressive part of it. Came out smelling like a rose. Some people call that aggressive, some people call it reckless. We need a little bit of that, quite frankly."

On Cobb settling down after the home run:

"What was good to see is that it was a Split that didn't split. He didn't throw it in his pocket. He knew he was going to need it with those four left-handed hitters, so he found a way. Alex is showing why I keep saying he's going to be a good pitcher. He has got his ERA under 5.00. He has come a long way with a lot of innings."
