The Offense

The Braves offense scored 14 runs and collected 18 hits last night, while going 9-for-19 (.474) with runners in scoring position.

The Braves offense leads the National League in runs (311), hits (564), and doubles (123), while ranking second in average (.263), on-base percentage (.334) and slugging percentage (.429).

They have 72 home runs, tied for the third most in the league and four off the lead of the Washington Nationals.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Padres finish a three-game set today with the second meeting between the clubs this season...San Diego will visit SunTrust Park, June 14-17 for a four-game set to conclude the teams' season series.

A The Braves collected 18 hits, the club's most ever at Petco Park, in a 14-1 win last night...Entering the game the Braves had lost 15 of their last 17 games at Petco Park, getting outscored 94-44 over the stretch that dated to August 29, 2012...They won consecutive games, June 8, 2016 and June 27, 2017 for their only victories in this span.

A The Braves hit three home runs last night after they hit six total home runs over that 17 game stretch, including none in their previous nine games here.

A RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set for his first start against the Padres since 2016...The right-hander is 1-0 with a 6.17 ERA (8 ER/11.2 IP) in two career starts against San Diego.

A LHP Matt Strahm is set for his second appearance against the Braves today...He tossed a perfect inning in relief on Monday in the series opener.

FOLTYNEWICZ: RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set for his first start since throwing a two-hitter with a career high-tying 11 strikeouts for his first career complete game in a 4-0 win over Washington on June 1.

A Foltynewicz became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on May 2, 2001 at Turner Field...Foltynewicz also became the first Braves starter to record an out in the eighth inning this season.

A Over his last five games, Foltynewicz owns a 0.56 ERA (2 ER/32.0 IP) with 37 strikeouts...He ranks fourth in the N.L. with a 2.22 season ERA.

NEWCOMB: LHP Sean Newcomb won his seventh consecutive decision last night, throwing 6.0 more scoreless innings...The lefty ran his homerless streak to 42.0 innings, the fourth longest active streak in the majors and the longest by a starter...His run dates to the bottom of the sixth inning on April 26.

A Newcomb's seven-game winning streak is the longest by a Braves pitcher since 2012-13, when LHP Mike Minor also won seven consecutive decisions from August 25, 2012-April 10, 2013.

A The last Braves pitcher to win seven consecutive decisions in the same season was Tim Hudson, who did it 2012...Hudson went 7-0 from July 6-August 26 of that season.

A Newcomb ranks ninth in ERA with a 2.49 mark... He has allowed more than four hits in a start once since the end of April.

DRAFT: The Braves yesterday concluded day two of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, using all seven of their picks on collegiate players...The Braves landed RHP Carter Stewart out of Eau Gallie High School in Melbourne, Fla., and Wichita State OF Greyson Jenista with their first two picks yesterday.

A The Braves made their first day-two selection in round four, drafting Stanford University RHP Tristan Beck with the 112th overall pick...Beck, 21, was named a Perfect Game 2018 third-team preseason All-American and went 8-4 with a 2.98 ERA (30 ER/90.2 IP) in 15 starts for the Cardinal this season...The 6-foot-4, 190-pound native of Corona, Calif., was ranked as the 35th best prospect in the draft by MLB.com.

A The Braves will pick eighth in each round through the draft's conclusion.

FREEMAN ON BASE: 1B Freddie Freeman went 4-for-4 with a walk yesterday, his second game this season of reaching base five times without making an out...He went 5-for-5 on May 10 at Miami.

A Freeman is one of five players in the majors this season to have two games in which he reached at least five times without making an out...Chicago's Addison Russell and St. Louis' Tommy Pham are the only other two National League players with multiple such games.

A Dale Murphy (1987), Bob Horner (1982) and Fred McGriff (1996) hold the Atlanta franchise record for the most such games in a single season with four... Ender Inciarte had three such games last season.

A Freeman leads the National League with a .435 on-base percentage.

DAY GAME: The Braves are 15-4 (.789) in day games this season, tied for the second-best winning percentage in the majors with Boston...Only the New York Yankees (16-4, .800) are better.

A The Braves are averaging a MLB-high 6.37 runs per day game, while their 1.74 homers per day game is also tops.

SLUGGING SWANSON: SS Dansby Swanson hit his third June home run last night, which is tied for the most in the N.L. so far this month...Over his last 14 games, dating to May 23, he is slugging .617, tops on the team.

A Swanson slugged .324 last season, the lowest mark in the National League among qualifying hitters.

RISP: The Braves went 9-for-19 (.474) with runners in scoring position last night, and currently lead the National League with a .288 (147-for-511) batting average in such situations...They also are tops with a .380 on-base percentage and a .513 slugging percentage.

A They also lead with 5.45 plate appearances per strikeout with runners in scoring position.

Today's Game

- A* Set to make his 13th start of the season and the 78th of his career...Is his 98th career appearance.
- A* Has allowed one earned run or less in each of his past five starts, the second longest such active stretch in the majors...Only NYM's Jacob deGrom (8 starts) has a longer active streak.
 - A* Foltyniewicz has pitched to a 0.56 ERA (2 ER/32.0 IP) and allowed a .155 opponents' average during the run.
- A* Has eight total starts on the season in which he's allowed one earned run or less, tied for third most in the majors...Only deGrom and HOU's Justin Verlander have more (10 each).
- A* Tossed a two-hit shutout on 106 pitches in his last start, 6/1 vs. WSH...Struck out a career high-tying 11.
 - A* Threw just 11.8 pitches per inning in the start, his fewest on the season... Tossed 18 pitches in the first inning, before needing no more than 14 pitches in any other frame.
 - A* Did not throw more than six pitches to any batter, and retired 15 hitters on three pitches or less.
 - A* Entered the start averaging 18.3 pitches per inning, most in the N.L.
- A* Has made two career starts against San Diego, going 1-0 with a 6.17 ERA (8 ER/11.1 IP)...Has not pitched against them since 2016.
 - A* Allowed four hits and three runs over 6.0 innings in his last start against them, 9/1/16 at Turner Field...Has never pitched at Petco Park.

2018 Recap

- A* Threw the first shutout of his major league career in his last appearance, 6/1 vs. WSH...Allowed just two hits and struck out 11.
 - A* Became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on May 2, 2001 at Turner Field.
- A* Was saddled with the loss, 5/21 at PHI, despite allowing one run over 6.0 innings of work...The start was his fourth against Philadelphia this season and the fourth time in which he faced Phillies starter RHP Nick Pivetta.
 - A* According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last time two pitchers faced off for a fourth time in a team's 46th game or earlier was on 5/31/59, when Lew Burdette faced Robin Roberts in the Braves' 44th game and the Phillies' 45th game.
- A* Went 5.0 innings and allowed three hits and one unearned run, 5/15 vs. CHI... Walked a season-most five, and struck out a season-most 10.
 - A* Was the fourth double-digit strikeout game of his career, and has since tossed one more...Since he joined Atlanta in 2015, his five 10+ strikeout games are most on the pitching staff.
- A* Earned his third win of the season, 5/10 at MIA, after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing just three hits and one unearned run.
 - A* Received eight runs of support, his most on the season and his most since also getting eight runs on 6/7/17...Entered his start against Miami averaging just 2.83 runs of support per 9.0 innings over his last 14 turns, fewest in the N.L.
- A* Allowed a season-most nine hits and six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/4 vs. SF...All six runs he allowed came in the second inning.
 - A* The outing snapped a 10-start stretch in which he allowed three earned runs or fewer, the longest such stretch of his career...Went 2-5 with a 3.04 ERA during the run, which started 8/27/17...Was one of just five starters in the majors to have as long a streak of three earned runs or fewer in that span, and was the only one with a losing record -- the other four pitchers went a combined 40-5.
- A* Held the Nationals to four hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/4 at SunTrust Park...Walked two and fanned eight to earn his first win of the season and snap a career-worst seven-game losing streak.
 - A* Went 0-7 with a 7.34 ERA (31 ER/38.0 IP) over the spell, the longest losing streak of his career and tied for the second longest active streak in the majors at the time...The run dated to 8/11/17 at STL and spanned eight total starts.
- A* Took a no-decision in his season debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...Allowed five hits and three runs over 5.0 innings, striking out seven.
 - A* The no-decision snapped of streak of seven consecutive losses after he dropped each of his final seven starts of 2017...His skid in consecutive starts was one short of the franchise record, set by Preston Hanna from 1976-1978 and matched by Shelby Miller in 2015.

Career Recap

- A* Was diagnosed with costochondritis on 9/2/15 and sidelined for the remainder of the season...Underwent surgery on 9/21/15, to remove the anterior half of his first rib...The procedure was performed by Dr. William Mayfield at Wellstar Kennestone Hospital in Marietta, Ga.
- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Rio Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 16/10 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/3

- Right-handed batters have just five hits in 46 at-bats (.109) against him...Lefties are hitting .407/.484/.704 with 11 hits, three walks, two doubles, two home runs and six RBI.
- Set career highs in innings (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...Milwaukee's Josh Hader struck out eight batters to earn a 2.2-inning save on 4/30 of this season at CIN.
- Five of his 16 appearances this season have been multi-inning efforts, most among Braves relievers.
- Made his MLB debut, 4/21 vs. NYM with 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first ATL reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley, 9/3/16 at PHI.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 26/17 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 12/3

- Tossed 1.0 clean inning with two strikeouts, 6/2 vs. WSH, to snap of streak of four consecutive appearances allowing a run... Allowed five earned runs in 4.0 innings pitched during the skid, after yielding just two earned runs in his first 26.0 frames
- Went 14 consecutive outings without allowing an earned run (15.1 innings), 4/16 to 5/19.
- Holding batters to a .154 (8-for-52) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-31, .097) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .273 (18-for-66) with no one on base.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .235 (16-for-68) average...Lefties are hitting .200 (10-for-50).

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 30/21 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 23/5

- Blew his second save, 6/2 vs. NYM, after allowing a leadoff homer to lefty Juan Soto...Left-handed batters are hitting just 5-for-34 (.147) against him this season.
- Fanned the side in 1.0 perfect inning of relief, 5/28 vs. NYM [1]...Was just the second time in his career he stuck out the side without allowing a baserunner in a 1.0-inning stint (also 6/29/15 at BAL).
- Ranks tied for seventh in the majors with 30 appearances this season...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/30 vs. NYM, and allowed one run to score before stranding the remaining two runners...Has inherited 23 runners on the season, and has stranded 18 (78%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

Luiz Gohara • LHP • 6-3 • 265 • 21 yrs • #53

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 4/3 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/1

- Allowed a career high-matching six runs (all earned) in just 0.2 of an inning on Monday, 6/4 at SD...Prior to Monday's outing, had allowed just one run and four total base runners over 7.0 innings (1.29 ERA) spanning three relief appearances.
- Reinstated from the Restricted List on Sunday, 6/3 vs. WSH...Was originally placed on the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List on 5/25...Last appeared in a game on 5/23 at PHI in a 4.0-inning start.
- Made his season debut and tossed 3.0 innings of one-run relief, 5/10 at MIA, to earn his first professional save.
- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 5/8, for his first appearance on the active roster this season...Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- Made four starts between Mississippi (AA) and Gwinnett (AAA), combining to go 0-3 with a 6.89 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #64

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 3/1 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Had his contract selected from Triple-A Gwinnett yesterday for his third stint with ATL this season...Also selected on 4/4 before being DFA'd on 4/15, selected again on 5/6 before being outrighted to GWN on 5/8.
- Went 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 ER/21.1 IP) in 10 appearances (one start) w/the Stripers...Did not allow an earned run in his last 16.0 innings with GWN, while holding the opposition to a .098 batting average (two strikes to 4/30).
- Made his Atlanta season debut 4/9 at WSH, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning with two walks and two strikeouts.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 2/2 **Holds:** 7 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/16 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 7/2

- Took his first loss of the season after allowing career highs in hits (4) and runs (3), 5/28 at NYM [2]...Has pitched to a 5.65 ERA (9 ER/14.1 IP) over his last 17 games after opening his season with eight scoreless app. (8.1 IP).
- Logged his second save of the season, 5/14 at CHI...Two saves lead all rookie relievers in the majors (tied).
- Has earned the win in three of his last eight appearances after picking up a victory, 5/20 vs. MIA...Three wins are tied for seventh in the majors among relievers.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/9 at TB, and allowed two runs to score...The runs were the first inherited runners he has allowed to score in his career...Has stranded five of seven runners this season and nine of 11 in his career.
