**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners continue a 2-state, 3-city, 10-day, 10-game road trip with the finale (1-1) of 3 games at Texas...will also travel to Houston (4 G) and Oakland (3 G)...went 2-5 on a recently-concluded 2-team, 7-day, 7-game homestand vs. Houston (1-2) and Toronto (1-3)...today's game will be televised exclusively on Facebook Watch and broadcast live on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners are 10-18 (7/4-current) since winning a season-high 8 straight games (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners have won 25 of their last 50 games, 32 of their last 59, 36 of their last 65, 41 of their last 71 and 43 of their last 75...Seattle is 51-38 in its last 89 games, 56-41 over its last 97 games and 61-45 in its last 106 games...Seattle is 21-18 during the day and 44-31 at night...Seattle is 36-24 at Safeco Field, 29-25 on the road.

- **Boomstick Baby!** - since July 27, Nelson Cruz has hit safely in 10 of 12 games, including 5 multi-hit games...he has also homered in 6 of his last 12 games, highlighted by multi-homer games on July 28 at Los Angeles-AL and May 2 vs. Toronto...in his last 12 games, Cruz is batting .319 (15x47) with 9 runs, 1 double, 8 home runs, 15 RBI, 1 HBP, 3 walks, a .373 on-base percentage and an .851 slugging percentage (1.224 OPS).
- **Picking up the Pace** - the Mariners have scored at least 4 runs in 3 consecutive games for the first time since July 3-5.
- **First Things First** - Dee Gordon is batting .358 (34x95) with 22 runs scored, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 walk and 2 HBP when leading off a game this season...his 34 hits to lead off a game are the most in the Majors.
- **Close Games** - the Mariners are 42-17 (.712) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 28-14 (.667) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 14-3 (.824) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 46-14 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 19-35 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (57-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (54-0).
- **Bulpen Bullies** - Edwin Díaz has not allowed an earned run over his last 16.0 innings spanning 15 appearances (6/25-c), while Alex Colomé has an active 15.1 scoreless innings streak over 15 games (6/30-c).

**ON THE MARCO**...since May 23, Marco Gonzales is 9-3 with a 2.81 ERA (27 ER, 86.1 IP) with 75 strikeouts and 16 walks in 13 starts, including 9 quality starts...his 9 wins are tied with Zack Greinke-ARI for the Major League lead over that span...among AL leaders since May 23, he ranks 3rd in ERA, 4th in WHIP (0.98/16 BB, 69 H, 86.1 IP), 5th in walks-per-9.0-innings-pitched (1.67/16 BB, 86.1 IP), 6th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.69/75 K, 16 BB) and 7th in innings pitched (86.1).

**CRUZ CONTROL**...Nelson Cruz belted his 30th home run of the season in the 2nd inning last night...he is the 3rd Mariners player in club history with at least 4 seasons of at least 30 home runs...he joins Ken Griffey Jr. (6s, 1993-94, '96-99) and Alex Rodriguez (4x, 1996, '98-2000)...Cruz joins Griffey as the only Mariners with 4 consecutive seasons of 30+ home runs...overall, Cruz has 6 seasons with at least 30 homers...among active players, his 6 such seasons are T3rd-most (also: Ryan Braun and Edwin Encarnacion), trailing only Albert Pujols (14) and Miguel Cabrera (10).

**NO FREE PASSES**...Marco Gonzales has worked at least 6.0 innings and allowed 2 or fewer walks in 8 consecutive starts, dating back to June 19...it is the longest active streak of such starts in the Majors...overall, Gonzales' current run is tied with Corey Kluber-CLE (5/2 - 6/10) for the 2nd-longest such streak in the Majors this season, trailing only Stephen Strasburg-WAS (9, 3/31 - 5/12)...it is the longest such streak by a Mariners pitcher since Taijuan Walker also had 8 consecutive such starts from May 29 - July 7, 2015...Hisashi Iwakuma is the last Mariners pitcher to record more than 8 straight starts of 6.0+ innings and 2 or fewer walks, recording 10 consecutive such starts from July 1 - Aug. 19, 2014.

**WHAT CHANNEL IS THE GAME ON?**...today's game will be televised exclusively on Facebook Watch, as chosen by Major League Baseball...as such, it's available exclusively on Facebook Watch, 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network (it is NOT available on ROOT SPORTS)...it is one of 25 MLB games this season to be distributed exclusively on Facebook Watch...the game will be produced by the MLB Network, featuring Rich Waltz on the call with former Mariners left-hander Ryan Rowland-Smith and former Rangers outfielder David Hulse providing color commentary...Stephen Nelson will be the field reporter...fans can watch the game on their desktop, mobile device or by streaming it to their TV.

**HISTORICALLY GOOD**...Edwin Díaz is 42-for-45 (93.3%) in save opportunities with a 1.96 ERA (12 ER, 55.0 IP) with 91 strikeouts and 15 walks in 55 appearances this season...Díaz is currently only the 5th pitcher in American League history (done 6x) to record at least 40 saves and 90 strikeouts with an ERA under 2.00...he joins Bryan Harvey-CAL (1991), Dennis Eckersley-OAK (1992), Francisco Rodriguez-LAA (2006), Greg Holland-KC (2x, 2013 and 2014).

**HOMER HAPPY**...this series features the top-2 home run leaders in the Majors since July 27...during that span, Nelson Cruz leads all of baseball with 8 home runs, while the Rangers Rougned Odor ranks 2nd with 7...since July 27, Cruz is 2nd in the Majors with 15 RBI, trailing only Odor (16) while ranking ahead of Javier Báez-CHC (14), J.D. Martinez-BOS (12), Jurickson Profar-TEX (12) and Mark Trumbo-BAL (12).

**STREAKING**...Alex Colomé has an active 15.1 scoreless innings streak, dating back to June 30...during this span, he is 1-0 with 10 holds with 18 strikeouts and 5 walks in 15 games...his 15.1 scoreless innings streak is tied for the 5th-longest active streak in the Majors, while ranking 2nd among Mariners pitchers this season...his active scoreless inning streak is the 3rd-longest in his career, trailing only a 21.2 innings streak (16 G, 8/4-9/5/15) and a 21.0 innings streak (19 G, 5/4-6/15/16).

**AS YOU KNOW**...Nelson Cruz has 6 seasons with at least 30 home runs: 2009 (33), 2014 (40), 2015 (44), 2016 (43), 2017 (39) and 2018 (30 and counting)...AND AS YOU MAY KNOW...five of those 30-homer seasons have come in his age-33 season and older (2014-c)...BUT DID YOU KNOW?...that Cruz is one of eight players in Major League history with at least 5 seasons of 30+ home runs in his age-33 season and older?...he joins Barry Bonds (7), Henry Aaron-HOF (6), Rafael Palmeiro (6), Babe Ruth-HOF (6), Andres Galarraga (5), David Ortiz (5) and Mike Schmidt-HOF (5).

**ABOUT GONZALES...**

- 26-year-old left-hander is making his 23rd start of season, 45th career appearance (37th start) and 3rd career start vs. the Rangers.
- Acquired by Seattle from St. Louis in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill on July 21, 2017.
- Native of Fort Collins, CO...attended Gonzaga University for 3 seasons (2011-13).
- Originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program.
- Made his MLB debut with Cardinals June 25, 2014 at Colorado.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (3 ER, 6.0 IP) with 4 strikeouts and 2 walks with St. Louis in the 2014 postseason...earned 2 wins in the NLDS vs. Los Angeles, becoming the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002).

**LAST START...**snapped a 5-game win streak with L#6 as the Mariners were defeated 7-2 by the Blue Jays on Aug. 3...allowed 4 runs on 7 hits with 0 walks and 7 strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched...3 of the 4 runs were driven in by home runs, a solo homer in the 4th and a 2-run homer in the 5th...marked just the 3rd time this season that Gonzales has allowed multiple home runs (3, 6/9 at NYY; 2, 4/3 at SF).

**WHIP IT GOOD...**since June 1, has posted a 1.00 WHIP (10 BB, 63 H, 72.2 IP), the 6th-best mark in the Majors, trailing only Chris Sale-BOS (0.77/13 BB, 38 H, 66.0 IP), Jacob deGrom-NYM (0.94/14 BB, 62 H, 81.0 IP), Nathan Eovaldi-TB/BOS (0.95/8 BB, 55 H, 66.0 IP), Max Scherzer-WAS (0.96/19 BB, 53 H, 75.0 IP) and Anibal Sánchez-ATL (0.98/18 BB, 47 H, 66.0 IP).

**LEADERBOARD...**among American League leaders, ranks 11th in ERA (3.46), 16th in WHIP (1.15/25 BB, 128 H, 132.2 IP) and 17th in innings pitched (132.2).

**NO FREE PASSES...**has issued just 25 walks compared to 118 strikeouts across 132.2 innings pitched this season...ranks 5th in the AL (7th in MLB) with a 1.70 walks-per-9.0-innings ratio...is 6th in the AL (9th in MLB) with a 4.72 strikeout-to-walk ratio...has issued 1 or fewer walks in 15 of his 22 starts; his 14 such starts are T5th-most in the AL.

**THAT'S QUALITY...**has 7 starts of at least 6.0 innings pitched and 1 or fewer runs allowed...his 7 such starts are tied for 10th-most in the American League (also: Gerrit Cole-HOU, Mike Fiers-DET, Dallas Keuchel-HOU, Sean Manaea-OAK, James Paxton-SEA, David Price-BOS and Tyler Skaggs-LAA).

**IT JUST TAKES ONE...**four of his 12 wins have come in one-run games...his 4 wins in one-run decisions are tied for 3rd-most by a starter in the Major Leagues (also: Andrew Heaney-LAA and David Price-BOS), behind James Paxton (5) and Blake Snell-TB (5).

**PICK YOUR POISON...**ranks 1st in the American League/T2nd in the Major Leagues with 6 pickoffs...tied with Julio Tehran-ATL, while trailing only Eric Lauer-SD (10) for the Major League lead.

**GAS IN THE TANK...**has pitched 6.0-or-more innings in 16 of his last 18 starts and 17 of his 22 starts overall this season...is 11-4 with a 2.87 ERA (37 ER, 116.0 IP) with 22 walks and 99 strikeouts in his last 18 outings, including 11 quality starts...prior to 2018, Gonzales had only reached the 6.0 inning mark in 1 start, on Aug. 30, 2014 vs. Chicago-NL with St. Louis (6.0,3,1,1,2,5).

**GOING THE DISTANCE...**tossed 1st career complete game on June 29 vs. Kansas City, allowing just 1 run on 6 hits and 0 walks while striking out 7 batters across 9.0 innings...became the 2nd Mariners pitcher to throw a complete game this season (James Paxton, 2x)...held the Royals scoreless until the 9th inning.

**2017 SEASON RECAP...**went 1-1 with a 6.08 ERA (27 ER, 40.0 IP) with 32 strikeouts and 11 walks in 11 G (8 GS)...was acquired from STL on 7/21/17 in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill...posted a 5.40 ERA (22 ER, 36.2 IP) with 30 strikeouts and 11 walks in 10 G (7 GS) with Seattle.

**BULLDOG ROOTS...**played 3 seasons (2011-13) with the Gonzaga Bulldogs, compiling a career record of 26-7 with a 2.34 ERA while recording 9 complete games and 4 shutouts...tallied 278 strikeouts over 303.2 innings of work...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program when he was selected 19th overall by St. Louis in 2013...shared West Coast Conference Player of the Year honors with the Cubs' Kris Bryant (University of San Diego) as a freshman in 2011 and as a junior in 2013...in 2013, earned John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year honors as well as WCC Co-Player of the Year for the 2nd time in his career.

**POSTSEASON GLORY...**added to the Cardinals roster for the 2014 National League Division Series vs. Los Angeles-NL...made 3 appearances in the NLDS, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk...picked up the wins in Game 1 and Game 4 vs. the Dodgers...became the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002)...in the 2014 NLCS vs. San Francisco, went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (3 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk in 3 appearances.

**CAREER...**in parts of 4 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c), is 17-9 with a 4.20 ERA (98 ER, 210.0 IP) with 182 strikeouts and 58 walks in 44 games (36 starts)...originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University.

Gonzales is making his 3rd career start vs. the Rangers...is 2-0 with a 2.31 ERA (3 ER, 11.2 IP) in 2 career starts against Texas...won his sole start of 2018 vs. Texas on May 28 (6.2,4,1,0,4,4)...here is how Gonzales has fared vs. current Rangers batters:
