RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals improved their home stand mark to a perfect 5-0 last night (earlier today) with a 4-3 win in 14 innings, sweeping their week-end series from the Chicago Cubs...the Cardinals began the day in 1st place in the N.L. Central, 1.5-games in front of 2nd place Milwaukee...the Cardinals +31 run differential is 3rd best in the Senior Circuit.

THE MIDDLE MEN: Shortstop **Paul DeJong**, who had three of the Cardinals four hits last night, has hit 32 home runs since making his ML debut (5/28/17), matching the Twins **Brian Dozier** and the Yankees **Didi Gregorius** for most HR's among MLB middle infielders (SS/2B) since that time.

Tsunami Waves of Success: **Carlos Martínez** is aiming to make a 7th straight start, allowing one run or fewer, today...there have only been two other Cardinals to have compiled such a streak - **Bob Gibson** (11 straight) during his historic 1968 NL MVP & Cy Young season, and **Chris Carpenter** (7 straight) during his 2005 NL Cy Young Award season...Martinez has allowed just 3 earned runs during his current streak over 40.2 IP for a 0.66 ERA...he's currently leading the NL with his 1.40 ERA, 2nd only in the majors to the Houston Astros **Justin Verlander** (1.17).

WALK-OFFS: The Cardinals staged back-to-back walk off wins on Sat. & Sun., as **Kolten Wong** delivered a 2-run blow in the 10th on Saturday and **Dexter Fowler** did the same with a 2-run, 2-out blast to win Sun. night's game in the 14th inning...it was the first time the Cardinals had won via walk-off HR's in consecutive games since **Matt Adams & Wong** did on July 7-8, 2014 vs. PIT and it was the first time they'd done so in consecutive extra inning wins since June 4-5, 2011 vs. CHI when **Albert Pujols** hit walk-offs in the 12th and 10th innings...the Cardinals have five walk-off wins this season, already surpassing their total for all of 2017 (4).

FOWLER'S WAS A FIRST: Prior to Sun. night's **Dexter Fowler** 2-run blast in the 14th when trailing 3-2, the Cardinals had never won a game via a walk-off HR when trailing in the 14th inning or later (in data dating to 1930; *Tom Orr*).

BETTER AT BUSCH: After going 44-37 (.543) at home last season and 38-43 (.469) in 2016, the Cardinals are off to a 12-6 (.667) start at Busch this season and have won 10 of their last 12 at home, including a seven-game win streak that was snapped last night.

PITCHER'S HOME WORK: The Cardinals pitching staff is 2nd in the majors with their 2.86 ERA (176.0 IP/56 ER) at home in 18 games, 2nd only to the Arizona Diamondbacks (2.83)..

BOMBIN' BIRDIES: The Cardinals rank 3rd in the N.L. (Washington 47, Colorado 46) with their 41 home runs...through 33 games, the Cardinals have homered in 24 games and are 18-6 in games when they do homer.

MILESTONE MANAGER: Cardinals Manager **Mike Matheny** managed his 1,000th regular season game with the Cardinals last Tue., becoming only the 4th Cardinals manager (**Tony La Russa**, **Red Schoendienst**, **Whitey Herzog**) to pilot the club in 1,000 or more regular season games...Matheny is 564-440 (.562 win pct.) at the helm, taking the Cardinals to the postseason in 4 of his 6 seasons.

MINNESOTA CONNECTIONS

The Twins defeated the Cardinals, four games to three, in the 1987 World Series...marked the first World Series in history in which the home team won every game...notable Cardinals to appear in the series included coaches **Willie McGee** and **José Oquendo**, Cardinals Hall of Famers **Ozzie Smith** and **Vince Coleman**, broadcaster **Ricky Horton**, and **Tony Peña**.

The Cardinals and Twins played a two-game exhibition series (April 2-3) at Target Field prior to the 2010 season.

Cardinals second baseman **Kolten Wong** was selected by the Twins in the 16th round of the 2008 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Cardinals outfielder **Dexter Fowler** was Astros teammates with Twins catcher **Jason Castro** and outfielder **Robbie Grossman** (2014).

Cardinals pitcher **Greg Holland** was teammates with Twins pitcher **Ervin Santana** in Kansas City in 2013.

Cardinals catcher **Francisco Peña** recorded his first MLB hit at Minnesota (October 4, 2015) with a pinch-hit single off **Ryan O'Rourke**...his father, **Tony**, was the Cardinals starting catcher against the Twins in the 1987 World Series.

Cardinals Scouting Director **Randy Flores** pitched in 11 games for the Twins in 2010.

Twins pitcher **Lance Lynn** pitched parts of six seasons in a Cardinals uniform (2011-15, '17)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Series team...selected by St. Louis in the first round (39th overall) in the 2008 MLB Draft.

Twins pitcher **Kyle Gibson** pitched three seasons at the University of Missouri (2007-09)

Cardinals Senior Special Assistant to the General Manager **Bob Gebhart** was born in Lambertton, Minn. and graduated from Lambertton High School...received physical education teaching certificate from Minnesota State Mankato in 1969...selected by the Twins in the 44th round of the 1965 MLB Draft...pitched parts of two seasons in a Twins uniform (1971-72)...served as Twins Director of Major League Personnel (1987) and Vice President of Player Personnel (1988-91), where he won two World Series rings (1987 & 1991).

Twins pitcher **Zach Duke** pitched parts of two seasons in St. Louis... July 31, 2016...originally traded by the White Sox to the Cardinals for outfielder **Charlie Tilson**.

Twins first baseman **Joe Mauer** and Special Assistant **Justin Morneau** represented the Twins in the 2009 All-Star Game at Busch Stadium...Twins pitcher **Zach Duke** represented the Pirates in the game.

Twins pitcher **Jake Odorizzi** was born in nearby Highland, Ill and graduated from Highland High School in 2008...led the Bulldogs to the Class 3A state title...named 2008 Illinois Gatorade Player of the Year...named a Louisville Slugger Pre-season All-American, a Rawlings/Perfect Game All American and a member of USA Today's All USA Team...had seats in right field to witness the Cardinals win Game 7 of the 2011 World Series.

Twins first baseman **Logan Morrison** played college baseball at Maple Woods Community College in Kansas City, Mo...was teammates with Cardinals outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** (2013) and pitcher **Dominic Leone** in Seattle (2014-15).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Lou Brock** was a baserunning consultant for the Twins in 1987.

Cardinals manager **Mike Matheny** managed the National League in the 2014 All-Star Game at Target Field...Cardinals pitcher **Adam Wainwright** was selected as the starting pitcher, while catcher **Yadier Molina** and infielder **Matt Carpenter** were selected as reserves.

Twins Special Assistant **Jim Kaat** was purchased by the Cardinals from the Yankees (April 30, 1980)...pitched parts of four seasons with St. Louis (1980-83)...was a member of the 1982 World Series Champions.

Twins Minor League Hitting Coordinator **Rick Eckstein** previously served as Hitting Coach for the 2007 Memphis Redbirds (AAA)...his brother, **David**, was an All-Star shortstop for St. Louis for three seasons (2005-07) and won the 2006 World Series.

Current Fox Sports Director of Cardinals telecasts for over 30 years, **Tom Mee's** father, **Tom**, was the first employee hired by the Twins in the fall of 1960...later served as the Twins director of media relations until 1991, then he became the team's official scorer.

Cardinals broadcaster **John Rooney** was the voice of the Minnesota Twins in 1987 and has been the play-by-play voice for three World Series championship teams: 1987 Twins, 2005 White Sox and 2006 Cardinals.

Twins Communications Assistant and Translator **Elvis Martinez** spent 2017 in the Cardinals organization as a Baseball Operations Fellowship and GCL Cardinals Coordinator in Jupiter, Fla.

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his team-leading 8th start of the season and the 108th of his career (180th appearance). It's his 12th career Interleague start (16th app.).
- Has allowed three runs over his last six combined starts since Opening Day (3/29 vs. NYM) (0.66 ERA/40.2 IP)...St. Louis is 6-0 in those starts.
- His next win will be the 50th of his career. Is attempting to become the 10th-youngest Cardinals pitcher to reach the 50-win milestone (since 1900).
- Makes his second career start vs. the Twins today (also 2015). Is lifetime 4-3 with a 1.86 ERA (77.1 IP) in 15 career Interleague games (12 starts). His 1.86 ERA is the 2nd-lowest Interleague mark among active pitchers (min. 77.0 IP).
- Needs five strikeouts today to reach 357 and pass Chris Carpenter (2006-12) for 4th all-time in Busch Stadium III history.
- Ranks among N.L. pitching leaders in ERA (1.40, 1st), HR/9 IP (0.20, 1st), opponent SLG (.237, 1st), strikeouts (45, T10th), innings pitched (45.0, T7th), opponent BA (.179, 4th), H/9 IP (5.60, 4th), WHIP (1.04, T9th), opponent GDP (7, T1st), and opponent GDP/9 IP (1.40, 2nd).
- Owns MLB's 2nd-longest (Bumgarner, 81) active streak among starters (64 starts) of working into the 5th inning or later (13 outs or more) dating back to May 14, 2016.

- Backed himself in 3-2 win by hitting his first career home run, a solo shot to break a scoreless tie in the 6th inning.

- Is one of 14 MLB pitchers with multiple double-digit strikeout games this season, fanning 10 at Milwaukee (4/4) and 11 at Cincinnati (4/15).
- Leads the Majors with eight hit batsmen including a career-high 3 vs. NYM (4/26).
- Leads MLB pitchers holding opponents to an .026 average (1-38) batting average with runners in scoring-position.
- Has a 3.54 run support average, 14th-lowest among National League starting pitchers.
- Led all of MLB with an 0.54 ERA in the month of April, his lowest career ERA in a single month and lowest April ERA in STL recorded history (since 1900; min. 30 IP).
- Logged an 18.0-scoreless innings streak (4/10-4/21), the 2nd-longest in the National League behind Jacob deGrom's 18.1 IP (4/21-present).
- Pitched his second consecutive no-decision on 4/26 vs. NYM in 4-3 win (13 inn.), tossing 6.0 IP allowing his first run since 4/10.
- Hit career-high three batters in the game, becoming the first Cardinals pitcher with 3 HBP in a game since Jake Westbrook (7/29/13 vs. PIT).
- Allowed a one-out solo HR in opening inning on 4/10 vs. MIL, then blanked the Brewers over his final 5.2 IP, taking ND in Cardinals' 5-3, 11-inning win that featured comebacks in the 6th, 9th, & 10th before Matt Carpenter's 2-run walk-off HR in the 11th.
