### Bounce Back

LHP Sean Newcomb took his third loss of the season in his last start, dropping a 8-5 decision to New York after allowing five runs, earned, in 2.2 innings.

In his starts immediately following his first two losses of the season, Newcomb went 6.0 scoreless innings in both turns to earn the win.

He beat Colorado on April 8 after losing to Washington on April 2, before winning 1-0 on June 16 vs. San Diego after his 7-2 loss in Los Angeles (NL) on June 10.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Brewers finish a four-game set today with the fourth meeting between the clubs this season...The Braves took four of six matchups last year to win the season series with Milwaukee for the third time in the last four seasons... The Brewers will travel to Atlanta for a three-game set, August 10-12.

*A* Atlanta has not lost a set in Milwaukee since 2013...They need a win today to earn a split of this series.

*A* LHP Sean Newcomb is set to make his first career start against Milwaukee...The lefty is 5-2 with a 3.21 ERA (19 ER/53.1 IP) in 10 road starts this season after allowing five runs, earned, over 2.2 innings in a 8-5 loss at Yankee Stadium on July 3 his only appearance on this road trip.

*A* RHP Junior Guerra is scheduled to make his second career appearance against Atlanta after he tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision against the club on May 25, 2016 at Turner Field...Guerra owns a 1.65 ERA (5 ER/27.1 IP) over his last five home starts.

**ROAD TRIP:** The Braves beat the Brewers, 5-1, yesterday to improve to 5-4 on this 10-game road trip to St. Louis, New York (AL) and Milwaukee...The club will return home to open a two-game set with Toronto on Tuesday.

*A* The club went 7-3 on their only other road trip of double-digit games this season, an 11-day jaunt through Cincinnati, Philadelphia and New York (NL), April 23-May 3.

*A* A win today would give the Braves a 6-4 trip...The last time the Braves finished above .500 on two different road trips of at least 10 games in the same season was 2014, when they went 8-3 on a swing through Washington, Houston, and Philadelphia, June 19-June 29 and 6-4 on a trip to Pittsburgh, Cincinnati and New York, August 18-August 28, 2014.

*A* The Braves have averaged 5.0 runs per game on this trip, while holding the opposition to a .218 average with 92 strikeouts (10.5 K/9).

**HOME RUNS:** The Braves have yet to homer in this series, and they have never gone an entire series in Milwaukee without going deep at least once.

*A* Their longest streak without a homer in Milwaukee prior to this season was three games, from April 7, 2011-September 11, 2012.

*A* In a three-game set here last season, the Braves hit six home runs on their way to averaging 8.0 runs per game.

*A* The last time the Braves did not hit a home run in a four-game series and earned a split or better was 2015, also against Milwaukee...The Braves took three of four games at Turner Field.

**50 WINS:** Atlanta earned its 50th win of the season yesterday, becoming the 18th Braves team in franchise history to reach that milestone prior to the All-Star break.

*A* The franchise record is 61 by the 2003 team...The last Braves team to reach 50 by the break was the 2014 club, which went 52-43.

*A* The Braves have six games left prior to the break.

**OZZIE:** 2B Ozzie Albies finished 2-for-5 with two runs scored yesterday and the second baseman has now hit safely in 16 of his last 17 games (32-for-78, .410)...Albies' hot streak began with a pinch-hit double on June 17 vs. San Diego, the first game he did not start this season.

*A* Albies extended his National League-leading run total to 69 with his 17th multi-run game of the season yesterday...Albies is looking to become the seventh Braves player in franchise history to reach 70 runs prior to the All-Star break.

*A* The franchise record is 76, first set by Tommy Holmes in 1945 and tied by Dale Murphy in 1983...The last to reach 70 by the break was Gary Sheffield (73) and Rafael Furcal (72) in 2003.

*A* The other two to reach the milestone was Andruw Jones (71 in 2000) and Darrell Evans (70 in 1973)

**ALL STARS:** Major League Baseball will announce the All-Star teams tonight and in the last voting update, three Braves were leading their respective positions: 1B Freddie Freeman, OF Nick Markakis and 2B Ozzie Albies.

*A* The Braves last had three position players in the All-Star game in 2012, when OF Michael Bourn, 3B Chipper Jones and 2B Dan Uggla all made the squad.

*A* The last Braves player to start an All-Star game was Dan Uggla at second base in 2012.

*A* The last time the Braves had three All-Star starters was 1998, when 3B Chipper Jones, SS Walt Weiss and RHP Greg Maddux started in a 13-8 loss to the American League at Coors Field.

*A* The last time the Braves had three position players start an All-Star game was 1960, when C Del Crandall, 1B Joe Adcock, 3B Eddie Mathews and RF Hank Aaron started both All-Star games.

**MINTER:** A.J. Minter tossed a scoreless ninth inning yesterday, striking out three of the four batters he faced... Since the start of June, Minter has compiled a 1.17 ERA (2 ER/15.1 IP) with six hits allowed, two walks and 20 strikeouts in 16 games.

*A* In his first 24 games of the season, Minter walked 13 on his way to a 3.74 ERA (9 ER/21.2 IP).

**ASSISTS:** OF Nick Markakis collected his fifth outfield assist of the season yesterday, and he ranks second among all active players with 113 outfield assists...Only Melky Cabrera, who is in Triple-A, has more with 116.

#### Today's Game

- A* Makes his 18th start of the season and the 37th of his career.
- A* Pitched a career-low 2.2 innings and allowed a season high-tying five earned runs in his last start, 7/3 at NYY...The Yankees entered play with a 54-28 (.659) record.
- A* The start was Newcomb's eighth this season against teams that entered play with a .500 record or better...He is 3-3 with a 4.79 ERA (22 ER/41.1 IP) in those starts.
- A* Has made nine starts on the year against teams that entered play .500 or worse, and is 5-0 with a 1.82 ERA (11 ER/54.1 IP) in those turns.
- A* Milwaukee is 53-36 (.596) entering today's game.
- A* Issued a season-most five walks in his last start, 7/3 at NYY...Walked four of the final six batters he faced, two of which came around to score.
- A* In his 36 career starts, has walked three or more batters 20 times...Is 4-8 with a 4.49 ERA (51 ER/102.1 IP) and a .241 opponents' average in those starts.
- A* Is 8-4 with a 2.89 ERA (30 ER/93.1 IP) and a .233 opponents' average in 16 starts when he walks two or fewer.
- A* Has never faced Milwaukee.
- A* Is 1-2 with a 4.41 ERA (16 ER/32.2 IP) in six career starts against the National League Central Division.

#### 2018 Recap

- A* Set career lows in innings pitched (2.2) and pitches (70) in his last turn, 7/3 at NYY...Allowed a season high-tying five earned runs.
- A* Yielded just three hits, two of which were home runs...Has allowed six home runs over his last five starts after allowing just three homers in his first 12 turns
- A* Allowed seven hits and three runs, 6/27 vs. CIN...Allowed three or more earned runs for just the fifth time in his first 16 starts on the season.
- A* Threw a career-most 111 pitches.
- A* Beat the Padres 1-0, 6/16 at SunTrust Park...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with two hits and seven strikeouts.
- A* Is 3-0 with 18 scoreless innings in his three career starts against the Padres... Has thrown 6.0 scoreless frames in each of the three starts...His 18 scoreless innings to open his career are the most against San Diego by a Braves pitcher in franchise history.
- A* Allowed a season high-tying five earned runs, 6/10 at LAD, to suffer his second defeat of the season.
- A* Snapped his career-best seven-game winning streak, which dated to 4/8 at COL...Went 7-0 with a 1.96 ERA (14 ER/64.1 IP) in 11 total starts during the run.
- A* Finished the month of May 5-0 with a 1.54 ERA (6 ER/35.0 IP) and no home runs allowed...Atlanta went 5-1 in his six starts.
- A* His five wins in the month were most in the majors, while his 1.54 ERA ranked sixth best in the N.L...His batting average against of .158 was the lowest in the league among qualifying pitchers.
- A* Newcomb allowed 19 total hits in 35.0 innings during the month, becoming the first Braves player in the last 110 seasons to make at least six starts in a month and allow 19 hits or less.
- A* Faced Miami for the second consecutive turn, 5/19, and allowed four hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his fourth consecutive win.
- A* A run-scoring groundout by Bryan Holaday scored Justin Bour in the second inning to snap Newcomb's career-long scoreless streak at 21 consecutive innings.
- A* Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed a career-low one hit, 5/13 at MIA...The start was his third consecutive scoreless turn.
- A* Became the first Braves pitcher over the last 110 seasons to allow two hits or fewer and no runs in three consecutive starts.
- A* Allowed two hits and three walks over 6.0 scoreless innings, 5/8 at TB...Turned in consecutive scoreless starts for the first time in his career.
- A* Tampa Bay logged just two hits, both of which were singles...Newcomb became the first Braves starter since Greg Maddux (6/27 and 7/2/99) to log consecutive scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings with two or fewer hits allowed.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 4/8 at COL, after allowing just five hits in 6.0+ scoreless innings...Did not walk a batter for the first time in his career.
- A* Walked at least one batter in each of his first 20 career games...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only two other pitchers opened their careers with longer streaks of walking at least one batter - Pete Smith (29 games) and Tom Glavine (27 games).

- A* Selected by the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim in the first round (15th overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.
- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with SS Erick Aybar, RHP Chris Ellis and cash considerations, from the Los Angeles of Anaheim in exchange for SS Andrelton Simmons and C Jose Briceno on 11/12/15.

### Ronald Acuña Jr. • OF • 6-0 • 205 • 20 yrs • #13

**MIL Series:** .200 (1-5) **Last HR:** 7/2 at NYY (Robertson)  
**Road Trip:** .258 (8-31), 2 HR **Current Streak:** 1 game (1-3, .333)  
**Season Long Streak:** 4 games, 6/30-7/3 (7-18, .389, 2 HR)

- Left Friday's game, 7/6 at MIL, after his infield single in the seventh inning with left groin tightness...Did not play yesterday.
- Has hit in five of his eight games (.258, 8-for-31) since coming off the DL, 6/29 at StL.
- Drove a 1-2, 11th-inning pitch from NYY's David Robertson over the wall in right field on Monday, 7/2 at NYY, giving Atlanta the 5-3 win...With his game-winning homer, he became the only player to ever hit a game-winning extra-inning home run at Yankee Stadium prior to his 21st birthday...Prior to Acuña Jr., the youngest player with a game-winning extra-inning home run at Yankee Stadium was MIN's Kent Hrbek (21 years, 95 days) on 8/24/81.
- At 20 years, 196 days, became the youngest player to hit a game-winning, extra-inning home run for the Braves since Andruw Jones (20 years, 3 days) hit a two-run, game-ending home run in the 10th inning off SD's Trevor Hoffman on 4/26/97...The last younger major leaguer with a game-winning homer in extra innings was FLA's Miguel Cabrera (20 years, 155 days) on 9/20/03 at ATL
- Has five game-winning RBI since his MLB debut on 4/25 at CIN, tied for second most on the team over that time frame.
- Reinstated from the 10-day disabled on 6/28...Went to the DL on 5/28 and missed 28 games with a left knee mild ACL sprain, left knee contusion and lower back contusion.
- Became the youngest player to homer for the Braves since Andruw Jones in 1997, hitting a solo shot off Homer Bailey for his first career homer on 4/26 at CIN.
- Atlanta selected his contract from Triple-A Gwinnett, 4/25,
- Named Minor League Player of the Year by Baseball America and USA Today in 2017.

- N.L. Ranks:** doubles (1st, 29), extra base-hits (1st, 50), runs (1st, 69), total bases (1st, 196), hits (T2nd, 107), home runs (T6th, 18).
- Hit his 29th double of the season, 7/6 at MIL...That total is tied for the most in franchise history prior to an All-Star break with Marcus Giles (2003).
- Three of his last five hits have gone for extra bases, giving him 50 extra-base hits on the season...Has the third most XBH prior to the All-Star break in franchise history...The club record is 53 by Hank Aaron in 1959...Darrell Evans is the only other to reach 50, finishing with 51 in 1973.
- Hitting .410 (32-for-78) with 12 extra base-hits (nine doubles, one triple, two home runs), nine RBI and 16 runs scored in his last 17 games.
- Had two yesterday afternoon, 7/7 at MIL, and has collected two or more hits in 10 of his last 14 games...His overall average in that span is .433 (29-for-67).
- Has 11 games with multiple extra-base hits this season, six away from the Atlanta franchise record held by Chipper Jones (1999) and Javy Lopez (2003).
- Hit his second career grand slam (also 5/10 at MIA), 6/12, vs. NYM to become the first Braves player with multiple grand slams in a season since B. McCann in 2012.
- Set the franchise record for most extra-base hits (22) by the end of April and tied for the second most in MLB history...Finished one shy of Jermaine Dye's 2000 record.

- Snapped his career high hitting streak at 10 games Thursday, 7/5 at MIL, after going 0-for-3...Hit .357 (15-for-42) during the run, which dated to 6/22.
- Leads the team with 24 RBI since the beginning of June...His six game-winning RBI since his season debut on 4/18 are tied for most on the club.
- Has hit in 18 of his last 21 games with an at-bat, going 27-for-82 (.329) with 18 RBI and a .364 on-base percentage in that span, which dates to 6/12.
- Since being named the starting third baseman on 5/20, has hit .268 (40-for-149) with a .341 on-base percentage, 26 RBI and seven home runs in 41 games.

- Since the beginning of May, is hitting .297 (38-for-128) in 44 games.
