AT HOME: The Brewers are 48-30 at home, going 15-7-3 in series play....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 4/17-4/22 and a season-high 3-game home losing streak from 4/7-4/16....the team went 46-38 at home last season, going 14-9-4 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 43-37 on the road, going 14-8-4 in series play, including this series....the team has won its last 5 road series....had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11 and a season-high 6-game road losing streak from 7/11-7/15....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (311-308) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 33 replay challenges, going 7-26....their last challenge (lost) came on 9/24 at St. Louis as a Matt Carpenter hit by pitch stood....went 17-27 in 44 replay challenges last season.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #45 - RHP JHOULYS CHACÍN (33gs, 14-8, 3.61)

CHACÍN AT A GLANCE: Jhoulys Chacin, 30, will make his team-leading and career-high 34th start of the season and fifth against the Cardinals....Chacin last started last Friday at Pittsburgh and had no decision in the Brewers' 8-3 win (4ip, 4h, 3r, 3er, 1bb, 1k, 2hr)....his 14 wins tie a career high (2013 with Colorado)....the team is 21-12 in his starts....he has made 12 quality starts....opponents are batting .227 (151-for-666, 17hr)....he has produced 30+ starts for the fourth time (2011, 2013 and 2017-18)....Chacin was named Brewers Pitcher of the Month for both July (5gs, 4-0, 2.64) and August (6gs, 4-2, 3.79)....he signed as a free agent on 12/21/17....he is signed through 2019....his name is pronounced "yo-LEASE sha-SEEN"....bio is on p. 81 of the media guide.

LAST SEASON: Chacin went 13-10 with a 3.89 ERA in 32 starts with San Diego....his 13 wins and career-high 153 strikeouts led the team....he held opponents to a .235 batting average (157-for-667, 19hr), which ranked ninth in the National League....the Padres went 18-14 in his starts....he had 16 quality starts, tying Luis Perdomo for the team lead....Chacin went 9-5 with a 2.93 ERA over his last 20 starts (116.2ip, 38er).

CAREER: Is 73-75 with a 3.88 ERA in 228 games / 200 starts (1205ip, 520er)....is in his 10th Major League season....has pitched for Colorado (2009-14), Arizona (2015), Atlanta (2016), LA of Anaheim (2016), San Diego (2017) and Milwaukee (2018).

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 5-6 with a 4.06 ERA in 16 starts (93ip, 42er)....prior to this season had not pitched at Miller Park since 2014....is 5-5 with a 3.79 ERA in 13 starts this season (73.2ip, 31er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 32-41 with a 4.12 ERA in 115 games / 98 starts (574.1ip, 263er)....is 9-3 with a 3.49 ERA in 20 starts this season (108.1ip, 42er).

CAREER vs. CARDINALS: Is 1-7 with a 6.10 ERA in 10 games / 9 starts (51.2ip, 35er), including 1-2 with a 6.10 ERA in 4 starts this season....he beat the Cardinals for the first time in his career in their last meeting on 8/19 at Busch Stadium (6ip, 4h, 0r, 0bb, 3k, 1hbp)....has gone 1-2 with a 3.98 ERA in 4 career starts at Busch Stadium (20.1ip, 9er).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .188 (62-for-329) hitter with 1 HR....homered on 9/20/13 vs. Arizona (2-run off Randall Delgado)....has 10 walks and 75 strikeouts....**THIS SEASON:** Is batting .167 (9-for-54) with 1 RBI....has 3 walks and 16 strikeouts....has 7 sacrifice bunts.
