### TRIBE TOP THREE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** was named the American League Player of the Week yesterday after hitting .425 (17-40) in eight games last week with four homers, four doubles and 10 RBI.

» **COREY KLUBER** enters his start tonight riding a five-start winning streak...he currently ranks T1st in the American League in wins (5) and complete games (1), while he also appears in the league's Top 10 in ERA (2.41, 8th), strikeouts (53, T6th) and opponent batting average (.174, 5th).

» The Indians begin this mid-week series with a 1-1 record in Interleague play this season...the Tribe is playing its first regular-season games against Milwaukee since the 2015 campaign.

### STRANGE BREW

» The Indians and Brewers face off tonight in their first regular-season matchup since the 2015 season...following the two contests at Miller Park tonight and tomorrow afternoon, the Tribe will host Milwaukee at Progressive Field for a similar two-game set on June 5 & 6.

» Cleveland posted a 3-1 record against Milwaukee in their 2015 season series, taking both contests at Progressive Field and splitting a pair of games at Miller Park.

» Since the Brewers left the American League in 1998, the Indians have gone 10-12 (.455) in 22 Interleague matchups between the clubs...in a series that dates back to 1969, the Tribe is 204-206 (.498) all-time against their former divisional rival.

### INTERLEAGUE INTERFACE

» This mid-week series marks the Tribe's second set of Interleague contests this season...Cleveland previously hosted the Cubs and split two games at Progressive Field on April 24 & 25.

» The Indians' 20 Interleague matchups this season will all come against the teams of the N.L. Central division...in addition to "home-and-home" series with Milwaukee, Chicago-NL and Cincinnati, Cleveland will host Pittsburgh for three games (July 23-25) and travel to St. Louis for another three (June 25-27).

» Cleveland posted a 6-14 (.300) record in Interleague play last season against Cincinnati and the N.L. West, who were responsible for three of the National League's five playoff teams...despite last season's mark, the Indians have posted a 53-49 (.520) Interleague record under **Terry Francona** (2013-).

### SUNDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians used a four-run 8th inning to build a 4-0 lead, but the Yankees stormed back to claim a 7-4 walk-off win and a three-game sweep in New York.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** was outstanding in his third road start of the season, striking out a career-high 10 batters while allowing just one hit in 7.1 innings of work...Clevinger held the Yankees scoreless through his first 7.0 innings, but departed after walking two batters in the 8th...both of those inherited runners scored, and **CODY ALLEN** suffered his first loss of the season (0.2IP, 4H, 3R/ER).

» After being held hitless through 7.0 innings, the Indians offense erupted for four runs in the 8th inning to take the lead...**TYLER NAQUIN** opened the scoring and extended his hit streak to six games with an RBI single...**FRANCISCO LINDOR** tacked on an RBI double to bolster his own hit streak to nine straight games... after Naquin scored on a passed ball, **JASON KIPNIS** drove in the fourth run with a sacrifice fly.

### TRANSACTIONS

» The Indians announced today that recently-acquired **RHP OLIVER DRAKE** has been added to the Major League roster...in a corresponding move, **ALEXI OGANDO** has been optioned to Triple-A Columbus.

» Drake, 31, who was traded by Milwaukee on May 5 for cash considerations, has appeared in 11 games for the Brewers in 2018, posting a mark of 1-0 with a 6.39 ERA (9ER/12.2IP).

» Ogando has appeared in one game for the Tribe, taking the loss in his Indians debut on Friday at New York-AL (1.0IP, 2H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 1K).

» **MATT BELISLE**, who was designated for assignment on May 2, has elected free agency...**JEFF BELIVEAU**, designated on May 4, has accepted his assignment to Triple-A Columbus.

### FRANKIE'S WEEK TO REMEMBER

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** was named American League Player of the Week yesterday, for the period of April 30 - May 6...marked Lindor's first MLB weekly honor, as well as the first by an Indians player in 2018.

» In eight games for the Tribe last week, Lindor batted .425 (17-40), hitting safely in all eight contests with four homers, four doubles and 10 RBI...he led MLB over the span in hits (17), runs scored (11) and total bases (33).

» Lindor enters play tonight on a nine-game hitting streak overall (.419, 18-43), the longest by an Indians batter this season...he is batting .337 (34-101) since April 11, leading the team in home runs (8), doubles (9, T1st), RBI (20) and runs scored (22) in that span.

### KLUBER DAY

» **COREY KLUBER** is set to take the hill tonight in his 8th start of the season...he enters play tonight with victories in each of his last five starts, tied for the longest win streak in MLB this year.

» Last started for the Tribe on May 2 vs. Texas, picking up the win after allowing three runs on six hits over 7.0 innings of work (0BB, 6K)...Kluber has posted a quality start in all seven of his starts in 2018, the longest such streak by an Indians pitcher to open a season since Josh Tomlin (9 starts) and Justin Masterson (7 starts) both did so in 2011.

» Tonight will mark Kluber's first regular-season start and appearance against the Milwaukee Brewers, as well as his 20th career Interleague start...owns a lifetime mark of 12-4 with a 2.19 ERA (33ER/135.2IP) against the National League, marking the 2nd-lowest Interleague ERA (min. 100.0IP) since making his debut in 2011 (**Clayton Kershaw** - 1.85).

» Kluber's 12 career Interleague wins are also tied for the most in Indians franchise history with **Cliff Lee**, **CC Sabathia** and **Bartolo Colón**...in 23 career plate appearances, Kluber has batted .158 (3-19) with a double and two runs scored.

» He currently ranks T1st in the American League in wins (5) and complete games (1), while he also appears in the league's Top 10 in ERA (2.41, 8th), strikeouts (53, T6th) and opponent batting average (.174, 5th).

### NAQ ME PROUD

» **TYLER NAQUIN** extended his season-long hit streak to six games on Sunday afternoon with an RBI single in the 8th inning.

» Over the streak, Naquin is batting .389 (7-18) with a double, and RBI and four runs scored.

» His .319 (22-69) average this season ranks 2nd among qualified Indians batters (**Michael Brantley** - .333) and 15th in the American League (min. 70 PA).

### A MUCH-NEEDED BREAK

» Following a stretch of 18 games in 17 days (8-10), the Indians enjoyed an off-day yesterday, their first since April 19...after these two contests in Milwaukee, the Tribe will be off again on Thursday before hosting Kansas City at home this weekend.

» The Tribe has gone 3-1 this season in games after off-days...dating back to July 21, 2017, the Indians have gone 12-3 the day following either an off-day or a postponement.

### CENTRAL STANDINGS CHECK

» The Indians enter today with a .500 record for the first time since sitting 5-5 on April 9...despite this, the Tribe maintains a 1.5-game lead in the A.L. Central over second-place Minnesota (14-17).

» In 2017, the Indians held a .500 record as late as June 14 (31-31) en route to a final mark of 102-60 (.630).

» Cleveland has spent each of the last 17 days in first place.

### FOUR HITS, DOCTOR'S ORDERS

» Per an MLB scoring change today, **MICHAEL BRANTLEY'S** game-tying at-bat on May 3 (Game 1) vs. Toronto in the 8th inning (initially ruled an error) has been updated to an RBI double...with the change, Brantley's line for that game now includes four hits and three doubles, both of which are club highs this season.

» The change also increases Brantley's batting average to .333 (32-96), as he now ranks 8th in the American League.

**1955: Al Smith** goes 4-for-4 with two homers, a double and four RBI as he leads the Indians to a 9-6 victory over the Kansas City Athletics at Cleveland Municipal Stadium...Smith went on to hit .306 for the year with 22 homers, 77 RBI and 123 runs scored, and finished 3rd in A.L. MVP voting...**Bob Feller** started and lasted just 1.2 innings (5H, 5R/4ER), but **Art Houtteman** earned the win after holding the A's to just one run over 7.1 innings of relief.

**TONIGHT'S START at MILWAUKEE**

» Reigning American League Cy Young award winner Kluber is scheduled to make his eighth start of the season tonight in the series opener against the Milwaukee Brewers... will mark his 176th career appearance and 171st career start.

» Will be pitching tonight on extended five days' rest after his last start on May 2 vs. Texas...won his fifth consecutive decision, tossing 7.0 innings and allowing three runs on six hits (three home runs), with six strikeouts.

» **His current streak of seven Quality Starts to begin the season is the longest such streak by a Tribe starting pitcher since Josh Tomlin (9) and Justin Masterson (11) each did so in 2011.**

» Kluber has never faced the Brewers...Milwaukee is one of five teams, including the Indians, that he has never faced in his career (also Miami, Pittsburgh & San Francisco).

» In 2017, went 1-2 with a 1.80 ERA (6ER/30.0IP) in four Interleague starts vs. Arizona, Colorado, Los Angeles-NL and San Diego...owns a career 12-4 record and 2.19 ERA (33ER/135.2IP) in 19 Interleague starts.

» **Kluber's 12 wins in Interleague play are tied with CC Sabathia, Cliff Lee and Bartolo Colón for the most by a Tribe pitcher since 1997.**

» Entering tonight's game ranks among the American League leaders in wins (5, T1st), innings pitched (52.1, 2nd), opponent batting average (.174, 5th), strikeouts (53, 16th), ERA (2.41, 8th) and night ERA (1.72, 8th).

» Holding opponents to a .201 batting average (343-1704) since the start of the 2016 season, which ranks 2nd among Major League starting pitchers (min. 40GS) in that span.

**LAST TIME OUT**

» Kluber won his fifth consecutive start in his last outing on May 2 vs. Texas (7.0IP, 6H, 3R/ER, 3HR, 0BB, 6K).

» **His win streak, which dates back to April 9, is tied with BOS's Rick Porcello and WAS's Max Scherzer for the longest by a starting pitcher this season...**streak is two shy of his career-long run of seven, done in 2016 (see **Career Highs** box at the right).

» Also recorded his seventh Quality Start, which is tied with **Scherzer**, HOU's **Justin Verlander** and **Gerrit Cole** for the MLB lead.

**VS. MILWAUKEE | INTERLEAGUE PLAY**

» Kluber has never faced the Milwaukee Brewers...owns a career 4-0 record and 1.40 ERA (6ER/38.2IP) in five regular season starts against the National League Central division...this includes one start each vs. Chicago-NL and St. Louis, and three starts against Cincinnati.

» In 2017, made four Interleague starts vs. Arizona, Colorado, Los Angeles-NL and San Diego...went 1-2 with a 1.80 ERA (6ER/30.0IP), with 35 strikeouts and three walks. » Took the loss on April 9 at Arizona (6.0IP, 6H, 3R, 2ER, 1HR, 1BB, 4K)...settled for a no-decision on June 14 vs. Los Angeles-NL (7.0IP, 4H, 2R/ER, 1BB, 10K)...lost again on July 4 vs. San Diego (8.0IP, 5H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 10K)...**tossed a complete game in his last Interleague start of the year on August 8 vs. Colorado (9.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 11K).**

» Struck out 10-plus batters in three of his four Interleague starts last year...recorded 35 total strikeouts compared to just three walks...his **SO/BB ratio of 11.67 led American League starting pitchers and ranked 2nd in MLB (min. 2GS in Interleague Play).**

» Owns a 12-4 record and 2.19 ERA in 19 career Interleague starts...Kluber's 12 Interleague wins are tied with **CC Sabathia, Cliff Lee and Bartolo Colón** for the most by a Cleveland starter since the beginning of regular season Interleague play in 1997.

» **Since Kluber made his MLB debut in 2011, his 2.19 ERA in Interleague outings ranks 2nd in MLB (min. 100IP), behind LAD's Clayton Kershaw (1.85).**

**COREY AT THE BAT**

» Kluber is a career .158 (3-19) hitter in 11 regular season games played in National League ballparks.

» In 2017, his lone road Interleague start came on April 9 at Arizona...went 1-for-2 in the game, with a fifth-inning single off of **Patrick Corbin**.

» Recorded his lone career extra-base hit on April 29, 2016 at Philadelphia, in the Indians 4-3 loss in extra innings...doubled to left field off of Adam Morgan in the top of the 5th inning and later scored on **Rajai Davis's** single.

**ON THE ROAD**

» Makes his fifth road start of the year tonight...four of his seven outings have come on the road (March 29 at SEA, April 4 at Los Angeles-AL, April 17 at MIN & April 22 at Baltimore)...**won his last road start on April 22, holding the Orioles to three runs in six hits (two home runs) over 7.0 innings, with four strikeouts).**

» Is 2-1 with a 2.51 ERA (8ER/28.2IP) overall on the road this season...in 2017, went 8-2 with a 2.83 ERA (28ER/89.0IP) in 13 road starts.

» Since the beginning of 2016, Kluber is 18-7 with a 2.88 ERA (71ER/221.2IP) in 33 road starts...among MLB pitchers with at least 25 road starts in that timeframe, his 18 wins are 3rd in the American League and 15th in MLB, while his ERA is 6th in the A.L. and 12th in MLB...also ranks 4th in the A.L. and 6th in MLB with 242 strikeouts.

**CAREER SNAPSHOT & 2017 HIGHLIGHTS**

» **Won his second career American League Cy Young Award in 2017, becoming the first pitcher in club history to win the award multiple times, and the 19th multiple winner in MLB since 1956.**

» Became the first Indians pitcher since Mike Garcia in 1949 to lead MLB in ERA (2.25), and ranked near the top of the A.L. leaderboard in virtually every other pitching category (see chart), including wins (18, T1st), pitcher bWAR (8.2), strikeouts (265, 2nd) and opponent batting average (.193, 141-732).

» Won the A.L. Pitcher of the Month award three times, June (4-0, 1.26ERA), August (5-1, 1.96 ERA) and September (5-0, 0.84 ERA), **becoming the first triple winner since Houston's Dallas Keuchel in 2015.**

» Kluber is in his ninth season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from the San Diego Padres on July 31, 2010 in a three-team trade that sent RHP Jake Westbrook (from Cleveland) & LHP Nicholas Greenwood (from San Diego) to the St. Louis Cardinals and moved OF Ryan Ludwick from St. Louis to San Diego.

» Signed a five-year contract extension with the Indians through 2019 on April 5, 2015...the deal includes club options for 2020 & 2021.

» Made his MLB debut on September 1, 2011 in relief against the Oakland Athletics...made three relief appearances as a September call-up with Cleveland in 2011...has five career relief appearances, last on April 20, 2013 at Houston.

» Kluber was originally selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 2007 June draft out of Stetson (FL) University, where he played three seasons...the Birmingham, Alabama native attended Coppell (TX) High School, located in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex.
