TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Nationals continue a four-game set today with the ninth meeting between the clubs this season...The Braves won last night, 4-0, for their fourth win in Atlanta against the Nationals this season and their first home shutout of their N.L. East rivals since September 30, 2015...They won three games total at SunTrust Park against Washington last season.

A The Braves are in the midst of their longest homestand so far this season, as they are set for eight total games before leaving on Sunday for San Diego...They will not have a longer stretch of home games until August 10-19, when they play 10 games against Milwaukee, Miami and Colorado.

A RHP Brandon McCarthy owns a 2.00 ERA (6 ER/27.0 IP) in four career starts against the Nationals, but is 0-2 over that stretch...Tossed 5.0 innings and allowed one run in a 5-3, 12-inning win on April 11 in his only start against Washington this season.

A LHP Gio Gonzalez is 1-3 with a 7.12 ERA (29 ER/36.2 IP) over his last seven starts against the Braves...Also lost seven consecutive decisions against Atlanta over an eight-start stretch, September 16, 2012-August 10, 2014.

STRONG START: RHP Mike Foltynewicz threw a two-hitter last night and fanned a career high-tying 11 for his first career complete game in a 4-0 win over Washington.

A Foltynewicz became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on May 2, 2001 at Turner Field...Foltynewicz also became the first Braves starter to record an out in the eighth inning this season.

A Foltynewicz's fanned 11 last night, marking his fifth career double-digit strikeout game and second this season...He also struck out 10 on May 15 vs. Chicago (NL)...His other 11-strikeout game came on August 5, 2017 vs. Miami.

A Over his last five games, Foltynewicz owns a 0.56 ERA (2 ER/32.0 IP) with 37 strikeouts... He became the third consecutive Braves starter to complete 7.0 innings...Prior to this stretch, a Braves starter went 7.0 innings five total times.

A Foltynewicz's 2.22 ERA ranks sixth best in the N.L., while his 80 strikeouts are fifth best...His .200 average against is tied for third lowest in the league among qualifying pitchers.

A Foltynewicz became the first Braves pitcher to throw a complete game since June 19, 2016, when RHP Julio Teheran one-hit the New York Mets at Citi Field...The Braves played 310 games between Teheran and Foltynewicz going the distance, with their starts averaging 5.1 innings per start.

FREEMAN: 1B Freddie Freeman extended his hitting streak to 14 games yesterday with a fourth-inning single...Freeman's run is the longest by a Braves player this season, surpassing a 12-game streak by Nick Markakis from April 23-May 5...After going 2-for-4 yesterday, Freeman is hitting .393 (22-for-56) over the streak, which dates to May 19.

A Freeman's streak is the longest active run in baseball...He is one ahead of Washington's Trea Turner.

A Freeman has also reached base safely in 22 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the National League...Only Detroit's Jeimer Candelario has a longer run (26).

VS. THE N.L. EAST: The Braves improved to 24-13 (.649) against the N.L. East this season with last night's 4-0 win...Atlanta's winning percentage against a divisional opponent is the second best in the N.L.; only Arizona is better at 16-8 (.667) against the N.L. West.

A No team has played inside their division more than the Braves (37 total games)...The next closest teams are the Dodgers (35 games against the N.L. West) and the Red Sox (35 games against the A.L. East).

LATE GAME BRAVES: The Braves scored all four of their runs in the seventh inning last night and now have 106 runs after the seventh inning, the third most in baseball.

A Only Houston (111) and the Chicago Cubs (108) have more.

VS. LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face their 19th left-handed starter today in Washington's Gio Gonzalez... The Braves are 11-7 in the previous 18 games started by a lefty.

A The Braves have a .812 OPS against those 18 left-handed starters, the fourth-best mark in baseball.

A Overall, the Braves are hitting .286 against lefties, the highest average in the majors, while their OPS of .828 against lefties is the only mark in baseball above .800.

A 1B Freddie Freeman (1.107) and 2B Ozzie Albies (1.050) are each one of 23 qualifying players in the majors with a OPS over 1.000 against lefties.

THE OFFENSE: The Braves offense ranks first in the National League with 286 runs, 525 hits, and 109 doubles, while ranking second with a .264 batting average, a .336 on-base percentage and a .427 slugging percentage...They have struck out 445 times, the third fewest in the league.

A The Braves own a +62 run differential, the second best in the N.L. and the fifth best in the baseball... The only National League club with a better mark is Chicago at +85.

Today's Game

- A* Set for his 12th start of the season and the 194th (252nd appearance) of his career.
- A* Has never defeated Washington, going 0-2 against them despite a 2.00 ERA (6 ER/27.0 IP) in four career starts...Limited Nationals batters to a .157 average (14-for-89) in his career.
- A* The Nationals are one of just four major league franchises against which he is winless...Has also never defeated Atlanta (0-2), Milwaukee (0-0) or St. Louis (0-1)...Entered 2018 winless against Philadelphia, but is 4-0 against the Phillies this season.
- A* Faced Washington once this season, 4/11 at Nationals Park...Allowed four hits and one run over 5.0 innings before leaving with a left shoulder subluxation (partial dislocation)...The Braves won 5-3 in 12 innings.
- A* Has a ground ball percentage of 51.1%, and his rate of 2.26 ground balls per fly balls is fourth highest in the National League.
- A* Opponents are batting .313 (72-for-230) against him, highest in the majors, but he has induced 10 double plays on the season...McCarthy's 1.57 double plays per 9.0 innings are second most in the N.L.
- A* Makes his fourth start during the day...Is 2-0 with a 2.76 ERA (5 ER/16.1 IP) during daytime starts, compared to a 3-2 record and a 5.93 ERA in eight starts at night.

2018 Recap

- A* Fourteen of the 32 earned runs he has allowed on the season came in a two-start span, 5/5 and 5/11...In his remaining nine starts, is 5-0 with a 3.31 ERA (18 ER/49.0 IP).
- A* Beat the Phillies for the fourth time this season, 5/22 at Citizens Bank Park... Allowed four hits and one run over 5.2 innings.
- A* McCarthy became just the 16th player over the last 110 seasons to beat a single opponent four times in his team's first 47 games...The last to do it was Pittsburgh's Vern Law in 1960, who also beat the Phillies four times.
- A* Rebounded from a two-start losing streak to toss his second "quality" start of the season, 5/16 vs. CHI...Held the Cubs to five hits and one run over 6.0 innings in a no-decision.
- A* Fanned a season-high eight batters, his most in over a calendar year...Last fanned as many when he also struck out eight on 4/17/17 vs. ARI.
- A* Went 5.0 innings, 5/11 at MIA, allowing 11 hits and six runs to take his second consecutive loss.
- A* Allowed 14 earned runs over his last two starts, pitching to a 15.12 ERA (14 ER/8.1 IP) and pushing his season ERA to 5.58...Ended his start on 4/29 with a 3.09 ERA.
- A* Allowed a career-high eight runs over just 3.1 innings, 5/5 vs. SF, to take his first loss of the season...Surrendered 12 hits and one walk while fanning two.
- A* Started the season 4-0 for the first time in his career...Previously opened the season 3-0 in 2009, 2015 and 2017 before dropping his next decision...Became the first Braves starter to open a season 4-0 since Williams Perez, who did so to start his 2015 campaign.
- A* Went 5.1 innings and allowed five hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/29 at PHI, to earn the win...Three of his four wins this season have come against Philadelphia.
- A* Is one of two pitchers in the majors this season to defeat a single opponent three times...KC's Jakob Junis is also 3-0 against Detroit.
- A* Allowed five runs (three earned) over 5.0 innings, 4/24 at CIN...Surrendered a pair of solo home runs.
- A* Moved to 1-2 with a 7.85 ERA (16 ER/18.1 IP) in his career against the Reds.
- A* Earned his second win over Philadelphia after holding the Phillies to five hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/18...Fanned a season best six batters.
- A* Atlanta won the game 7-3, and moved to 4-0 in McCarthy's starts this season... That is the longest run of wins for the Braves to open the season in starts by one pitcher since the club also won each of Shelby Miller's first four starts in 2015.
- A* Went 6.0 innings and allowed five hits and three runs, 4/6 at COL...Walked two and fanned four to earn his second win of the season.
- A* Tossed the first "quality start" by a Braves pitcher and was the first Braves starter to complete 6.0 innings with the outing, Atlanta's seventh game of the season.
- A* Earned the win in his Braves debut, 3/31 vs. PHI...Allowed six hits and two runs over 5.1 innings in a 15-2 Atlanta win...Only one Braves starter last season earned the win his team debut; Max Fried on 9/3 at CHI.
- A* The win was the first of his career against the Phillies, and he is now winless against just four major league franchises...Has never defeated Milwaukee (0-0), St. Louis (0-1) or Washington (0-2), and is also winless in two career starts against Atlanta.

Career Recap

- A* Is in his 13th major league season with his seventh organization...Started with the Chicago White Sox (2005-06), before joining the Texas Rangers (2007-09), the Oakland Athletics (2011-12), the Arizona Diamondbacks (2013-14), the New York Yankees (2014) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (2015-16).

- Right-handed batters have just four hits in 40 at-bats (.100) against him...Lefties are hitting .478/.538/.826 with 11 hits, three walks, two doubles, two home runs and six RBI.
- Tossed a career high-tying 2.0 innings in Game 1 yesterday, 5/28 vs. NYM...Four of his 15 appearances this season have been 2.0-inning efforts, tied with Shane Carle for most among Braves relievers.
- Opponents are hitting just .143 (4-for-28) with runners on base (.200 with RISP), compared to a .314 (11-for-35) average with the bases empty.
- Went 2.0 innings and fanned a career-most five batters, 4/29 at PHI...Became the first Atlanta reliever to strike out at least five batters in 2.0 or fewer innings since Dario Álvarez did so on 6/15/16...Just four Atlanta relievers have had an outing of five strikeouts in 2.0 or fewer innings since 2000.
- Made his major league debut, 4/21 vs. NYM, and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first Atlanta reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley on 9/3/16 at PHI.

- Has allowed runs in four consecutive outings...Prior to these three games, went 14 consecutive outings without allowing an earned run (15.1 innings)...Allowed five earned runs in his last 4.0 innings pitched after yielding just two earned runs in his first 26.0 frames.
