YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Cleveland Indians mustered just one hit off Angels pitching as they fell, 13-2, in the middle contest of this three-game series.

» After **FRANCISCO LINDOR** walked to lead off the game, **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** clubbed a two-run homer to give the Tribe an early 2-0 lead...however, the Tribe would not record another hit the rest of the evening, as they were held to just three walks and a hit-by-pitch over the final 8.0 innings.

» **JOSH TOMLIN** was touched for a career-high four homers in his first start of the season, taking the loss after allowing eight runs (all earned) over 3.0 innings of work...**DAN OTERO** (3R) and **ZACH McALLISTER** (2R) each gave up multiple runs in relief, while **MATT BELISLE** posted 2.0 hitless innings.

» The loss snapped a 12-game winning streak by the Tribe over the Halos which dated back to June 12, 2016...the run was tied for the longest active streak by any MLB team against a single opponent...despite last night's loss, the Indians still hold a 13-2 (.867) record against Los Angeles-AL since the beginning of the 2016 season.

J-RAM: BACK IN ACTION

» After starting his year on an 0-for-15 slide (two walks), **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** broke out of his season-opening slump with a two-run homer in the top of the 1st inning.

» Ramírez endured separate 0-for-17, 0-for-13, 0-for-11 (2x) and 0-for-10 stretches in 2017 en route to a .318 batting average (186-585) with 29 homers, 56 doubles and 83 RBI.

KLUBER'S SECOND START

» The Tribe will conclude this road trip with **COREY KLUBER** on the hill to make his second start of the season.

» Kluber started on Opening Day for the Tribe and took a hard-luck loss, allowing two runs on six hits over 8.0 innings in a **complete-game effort at Seattle**...Kluber became the **first Indians pitcher to hurl a complete game on Opening Day since Jake Westbrook dropped a 1-0 contest on April 4, 2005 at Chicago-AL**...it also marked the first Opening Day complete game in MLB since Clayton Kershaw spun a shutout on April 1, 2013 vs. San Francisco.

» Kluber has made five career starts against the Angels, going 2-2 with a 4.31 ERA (15ER/31.1IP)...today will be his first appearance against Los Angeles-AL since August 11, 2016 at Progressive Field.

CAN'T BUY A THRILL | ONE HIT

» The Indians were held to just one hit last night, their lowest output in a game since another one-hit performance on August 22, 2017 vs. Boston (Doug Fister CG)...the Tribe's 22-game winning streak began two days after that loss to the Red Sox.

» Cleveland has been held to one hit or fewer on seven occasions since 2010, three of which have come at the hands of the Angels...most notably, the Indians were no-hit by Los Angeles-AL's Ervin Santana on July 27, 2011 at Progressive Field...earlier that season, the Angels' Dan Haren threw a complete-game one-hitter on April 12, 2011 at Angel Stadium.

» Last night marked the third time in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-) that the Indians homered for their only hit of the ballgame...they previously did so in the aforementioned game on August 22, 2017 vs. Boston (**Francisco Lindor** HR in 1st inning) and on August 21, 2007 at Detroit (**Jhonny Peralta** HR in 6th inning)...last night and the August 22 game vs. Boston are the only games in MLB since 2009 in which a first-inning homer served as a team's only hit.

END OF THE ROAD (TRIP)

» The Indians close out their season-opening six-game road trip this afternoon (currently 2-3).

» With a win in today's rubber match, the Tribe would break even on the trip and extend its mark to four consecutive road trips at .500-or-better...since August 11, 2017, the Indians hold a 26-6 record (.813) on the road.

» After dropping their first series finale on Sunday, the Indians turn to **COREY KLUBER** this afternoon to salvage a series win...Kluber made 10 starts in finales last season, going 8-1 in those starts with a 1.73 ERA (13ER/67.2IP)...six of those came in series-deciding games, where he posted a 6-0 mark with a 1.50 ERA (7ER/42.0IP).

STRANGE ALTERNATION

» The Indians have alternated wins and losses thus far in 2018 and have not posted a two-game winning or losing streak.

» This season-opening stretch marks the longest the Tribe has gone without consecutive wins or losses since 1991, when Cleveland also began its season LWLWL...the '91 Indians proceeded to win Game 6 before also winning Game 7 to break the pattern.

» In 2017, the Indians posted a record of 34-26 (.567) in games following a loss...the Tribe is 2-0 in such games this season.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

» **1994:** The Indians opened Jacobs Field with a dramatic 4-3 extra-inning win over Seattle in the stadium's inaugural regular season game...Dennis Martinez and Hall of Famer Randy Johnson squared off, as both pitchers allowed a pair of runs...a two-run double by Manny Ramirez in the 8th inning erased a 2-0 deficit and forced extra innings...after both teams scored in the 10th, the Tribe walked off for the first victory in their new ballpark when Wayne Kirby drove in Eddie Murray with a single in the bottom of the 11th.

SAVED BY THE BELISLE

» **MATT BELISLE** posted 2.0 perfect innings in relief last night, retiring all six batters he faced with one strikeouts...he has now thrown 3.0 scoreless frames for Cleveland this season.

» With Minnesota in 2017, Belisle made five appearances of 2.0-or-more innings, allowing four unearned runs over those outings (0ER/10.2IP)...prior to last night, his last perfect appearance of 2.0-or-more innings came with Colorado on September 27, 2014 at Los Angeles-NL.

» Belisle's 72 career relief appearances of at least 2.0 innings rank 7th-most among all active pitchers (1st: Craig Stammen - 90).

LIVE AND DIE BY THE SWORD | HOME RUNS

» Throughout the season's first five games, home runs have proven dominant in the offenses of both Cleveland and its opponents.

» 15 of the Tribe's 19 runs this season have scored via the long-ball, including a grand slam and four two-run homers.

» Conversely, 16 of the 25 runs scored by Tribe opponents have come via home run.

» The Indians' eight home runs this season rank T4th in the American League (T7th in MLB)...their 10 homers allowed are 3rd-most in both the A.L. and MLB.

» The four home runs surrendered by **JOSH TOMLIN** last night represent a new career-high in a single outing...the five homers allowed overall were the most by Cleveland since allowing five on May 16, 2017 vs. Tampa Bay.

MISC. BATTING NOTES

» Though neither batter recorded a hit last night, **LONNIE CHISEN-HALL** (walk) and **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (HBP) reached base safely to extend their on-base streaks to all five games this season.

» Last season, **FRANCISCO LINDOR** reached safely in each of the Tribe's first 16 games, the most by any Cleveland batter since **Ryan Garko** reached in 18 straight to open the 2008 season.

» The furthest into a season two Cleveland batters have maintained on-base streaks is 18 games, done by **Ken Keltner** and **Odell Hale** in 1938.

MISC. PITCHING NOTES

» Since **COREY KLUBER** threw a complete game on Opening Day, no Tribe starter has completed 6.0 innings of work (four consecutive games).

» That streak of four starts of less than 6.0 innings matches the club's longest stretch in 2017 (done three times, most recently June 3-7)...in two of those three instances (April 9 & June 9), a start by Kluber broke the streak.

» The Tribe has not posted five consecutive starts under 6.0 innings pitched since August 1-5, 2016 (vs. MIN, at NYY).

HEADING HOME

» Following a scheduled off day tomorrow, the Tribe will return to Progressive Field for their 2018 home opener on Friday vs. Kansas City...will mark the third time in franchise history to face the Royals for the home opener (also 1978 and 1999).

» The Indians will trot out **CARLOS CARRASCO**, who also earned the starting nod for the Tribe's 2017 home opener vs. Chicago-AL...Carrasco is set to become the first Tribe hurler to start consecutive home openers since **Roberto Hernandez** (then Fausto Carmona) in 2010 and 2011.

» The Tribe won a memorable 10-inning contest vs. the White Sox in the 2017 home opener, earning a 2-1 victory via a **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** walk-off double in the bottom of the 10th inning.

» Friday's game will kick off a 10-game homestand, with Detroit (April 9-12) and Toronto (April 13-15) also scheduled to visit Progressive Field.

FAMILIAR FACES

» The Los Angeles Angels coaching staff includes four former members of the Cleveland Indians.

» Pitching coach **Charles Nagy** spent 13 of his 14 MLB seasons in an Indians uniform, going 129-103 with a 4.51 ERA in his time with the Tribe...he ranks among the Indians all-time Top 10 in wins (10th), strikeouts (1,235, 6th) and games started (297, 6th).

» Assistant hitting coach **Paul Sorrento** spent four years with the Tribe from 1992-95, hitting 25 homers in the Tribe's 1995 run to the American League pennant.

» First base coach **Alfredo Griffin** made his Major League debut with the Indians as an 18-year-old in 1976 and played parts of three seasons for the Tribe.

» Bullpen coach **Scott Radinsky** finished his 11-year MLB career with the Indians in 2001...he later spent three seasons on the Tribe's coaching staff under Manny Acta, serving as bullpen coach in 2010 & 2011 and pitching coach for the 2012 season.

TODAY'S START IN ANAHEIM

» Reigning American League Cy Young award winner Kluber will make his second start of the season in today's series finale in Anaheim...marks his 165th career game started and his 170th career appearance...will celebrate his 32nd birthday on April 10, in the middle of the Indians' first homestand of the year.

» Will be pitching on extended five days' rest after starting the Tribe's 2018 season opener on March 29 at Seattle...marks the second time in his career (after 2017) that both of his first two starts of the season occur on the road.

» Became the 4th pitcher in franchise history to make four consecutive Opening Day starts, joining Stan Coveleski (5: 1917-1921), Bob Feller (4: 1946-1949) and Gaylord Perry (4: 1972-1975)...went the distance in Cleveland's 2-1 loss for his 16th career complete game (8.0IP, 6H, 2R-ER, 1HR, 1BB, 8K, 91 pitches).

» Set to make his sixth career start and appearance against Los Angeles-AL, and first since August 11, 2016, when he earned the win (6.0IP, 4H, 3R/ER, 2HR, 2BB, 3K)...overall is 2-2 with a 4.31 ERA (15ER/31.1IP) vs. the Halos.

COMPLETE COREY

» Kluber tossed his 16th career complete game in his first start of the year on March 29...marked the first Opening Day complete-game by a Cleveland pitcher since Jake Westbrook on April 4, 2005 at Chicago-AL (1-0 loss), and the first such complete game in MLB since Clayton Kershaw threw a complete-game shutout on April 1, 2013 vs. San Francisco.

» Struck out eight batters, the 2nd-most by a Tribe starter on Opening Day over the last 14 seasons (2005-18), behind Justin Masterson (10K on April 5, 2012 vs. Toronto).

» Kluber threw just 91 pitches in the game, marking the second-lowest complete-game pitch count of his career...needed just 85 pitches to shut out Seattle on July 30, 2014 (9.0IP, 3H, 8K).

SAVING THE BEST FOR LAST | SERIES FINALE RECORD

» In 2017, Kluber made 10 starts in series finales, posting a 8-1 record and 1.73 ERA (13ER/67.2), with 99 strikeouts in those 67.2 innings.

» Six of the 10 starts came with a series win on the line, either in a three or four-game series...Kluber went 6-0 with a 1.50 ERA (7ER/42.0IP) in series-deciding games last year.

VS. ANAHEIM | A.L. WEST

» Kluber owns a 2-2 record and 4.31 ERA (15ER/31.1IP) in six prior starts against the Halos...three of those four starts came here at Angel Stadium, where he has a lifetime 1-2 record with a 4.66 ERA (10ER/19.1IP)...hasn't faced the Angels since August 11, 2016.

» Has made 38 career appearances and 36 starts against the A.L. West division, compiling a 17-15 record and 3.29 ERA (87ER/237.2IP) and 255 strikeouts in those outings.

ON THE ROAD

» In 80 career road starts (82 appearances), Kluber holds a 35-25 record with a 3.52 ERA (205ER/524.0IP) and held opponents to a .240 average against (474-for-1972)...went 8-2 with a 2.83 ERA (28ER/89.0IP) in 13 road starts last year.

» Since the beginning of 2016, Kluber is 16-7 with a 2.91 ERA (65ER/201.0IP) in 30 road starts...among MLB pitchers with at least 25 such starts in that timeframe, his 16 wins are tied for 3rd in the American League and tied for 5th in MLB, while his ERA is 4th in the A.L. and 9th in MLB...also ranks 3rd in the A.L. and 5th in MLB with 226 strikeouts.

CLIMBING OVER HUMP DAY

» Kluber made two starts on Wednesday in 2017, compiling a 0-1 record and 2.45 ERA (4ER/14.2IP) in those nearly identical outings, which both came at Progressive Field...did not factor into the decision on June 14 against Los Angeles-NL, fanning 10 Dodgers in 7.0 innings (4H, 2R/ER, 1BB)...the start began a streak of five consecutive starts with 10-plus strikeouts, a new franchise record that he matched from July 15-August 8.

» Took the loss on August 23 against Boston, recording his 13th double-digit strikeout game of the season, punching out 12 Red Sox in the Tribe's 6-1 loss (4H, 2R/ER, 1BB, 1HR)...including his two Wednesday starts, Kluber finished 2017 with 15 starts of 10-plus strikeouts, the second-highest total in franchise history after Sam McDowell in 1965 (17).

SPRING TRAINING SUMMARY

» Kluber made five Cactus League starts, going 4-0 with a 2.25 ERA (5ER/19.2IP)...tied for the MLB lead in wins and tied with teammate RHP Mike Clevinger for 5th in the Cactus League with 25 strikeouts.

» After earning a no-decision in his spring debut on February 27 (2.0IP, 1H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 3K), won his next four starts, all in the month of March, striking out 22 batters across 17.2 innings in those outings while allowing just four earned runs on 10 hits...held Los Angeles-AL to one hit, one walk, and one hit batter on March 14 in 5.0 shutout innings.

2017 AMERICAN LEAGUE RANKINGS

» Kluber became the first Indians pitcher since 1949 (Mike Garcia, 2.36) to lead MLB in ERA, with a 2.25 mark.

» In addition, he ranked near the top of the American League leaderboard in virtually every other pitching category in 2017 (see chart), including wins (18, T1st), pitcher bWAR (8.2) and strikeouts (265, 2nd).

» Kluber also led the A.L. in opponent batting average, holding hitters to a .193 (141-for-732).

CY KLUBER: 2017 REGULAR SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» Became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to win the American League Cy Young award twice (2014/2017) and the 19th multiple-winner in MLB since 1956.

» Won the A.L. Pitcher of the Month award three times, June (4-0, 1.26ERA), August (5-1, 1.96 ERA) and September (5-0, 0.84 ERA), becoming the first triple winner since Houston's Dallas Keuchel in 2015.

» Was on the disabled list from May 3-31 and made one rehab appearance at Double-A Akron on May 26...dominated after his activation from the D.L. on June 1, going 15-2 with a 1.62 ERA in his last 23 starts...led MLB (min. 80.0IP) with a 1.79 ERA in the second half.

» Recorded his 1,000th career strikeout on June 14 at Progressive Field...milestone came in his 148th career appearance, making him the fastest pitcher in Indians history to reach the mark...also struck out 10-plus batters in a franchise-record five consecutive starts from June 14-July 4...tied the record July 15-August 8...recorded eight-plus strikeouts in 14 straight starts from June 1-August 13, the 3rd-longest single-season streak in MLB history.

» Fanned his 200th batter of the season on August 23 vs. Boston, becoming one of three players in club history with 200-plus strikeouts in four consecutive seasons (Bob Feller, 1938-41 and Sam McDowell, 1965-70).

2017 POSTSEASON RECAP

» Started Games 2 and 5 of the 2017 American League Division Series against the New York Yankees...did not factor into the decision in Game 2 (2.2IP, 7H, 6R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 4K) and took the loss in Game 5 (3.2IP, 3H, 3R/ER, 2HR, 2BB, 6K).
