#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost five straight games and seven of their last eight as they conclude their first homestand of the season today vs. Tampa Bay ... RHP James Shields takes the mound for the White Sox, who are off to their worst 10-game start since 1997 (also 3-7).
- The Sox are 0-5 on the homestand, losing the first two games of this series by one run apiece after being swept by Detroit in a three-game set over the weekend.
- Following today's game, the White Sox take a seven-game trip to Minnesota (4/12-15) and Oakland (4/16-18).
- The Sox went 3-2 on their first trip of the season to Kansas City (2-0) and Toronto (1-2).

#### TODAY'S STORYLINES

- James Shields, who pitched for Tampa Bay from 2006-12, is 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA (3 ER/20.0 IP) and 23 strikeouts in three career starts against his former team.
- The White Sox have never been swept at home by the Rays.
- The Sox are 0-5 at home for the first time since 1975 and are looking to avoid their first 0-6 start since 1948 (0-8).
- The White Sox are 3-37 (.081) with RISP over the last four games and have left 36 runners on base in that span.
- José Abreu has seven home runs and 26 RBI in 26 career games vs. Tampa Bay.

#### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- A ninth-inning rally came up just short as the White Sox lost their fifth consecutive game, 6-5, to Tampa Bay.
- Trailing, 6-1, entering the ninth, Yolmer Sánchez hit a sacrifice fly and José Abreu hit a three-run homer off Alex Colomé to close the gap to 6-5 ... after Matt Davidson walked, Omar Narváez lined out to right field to end the game.
- Tyler Saladino collected two of Chicago's six hits, and Davidson drew a career-high three walks, upping his season total to nine (19 all of 2017).
- Carson Fulmer suffered the loss, allowing four runs (three earned) on five hits, six walks and two hit batters over 4.2 IP.
- Wellington Castillo left the game in the sixth inning with right knee soreness.

#### NOT SO FRIENDLY COMFINES

- The White Sox are 0-5 at home this season, including three straight one-run losses, and are looking to avoid their first winless homestand of at least six games since May 1989 (0-6) ... source: STATS LLC.
- The Sox average time of game on the homestand is 3:34, and the average temperature at game time has been 37.8 degrees.

#### VETERAN PRESENCE

- James Shields ranks among the major-league leaders since 2007 in games started (2nd, 353), IP (2nd, 2,297.2), pitches thrown (2nd, 36,141), quality starts (6th, 216), complete games (T6th, 22) and strikeouts (8th, 1,977).
- Shields is Tampa Bay's all-time leader with 83 wins, 1,250 strikeouts, 217 starts and 19 complete games and eight shutouts.

#### ABREU IN ELITE COMPANY

- José Abreu is one of three players in major-league history to begin his career with at least four consecutive seasons of 25-plus homers and 100-plus RBI, joining Hall-of-Famer Joe DiMaggio (1936-41) and Albert Pujols.
- Abreu also has joined Al Simmons (11, 1924-34), Pujols (10, 2001-10), Ted Williams (1939-42, '46-49) and DiMaggio (1936-42) as the only players in history to record 100 or more RBI in each of his first four seasons.
- He led the American League with 343 total bases in 2017, joining Albert Belle (399 in 1998), Minnie Miñoso (304 in 1951) and Joe Jackson (293 in 1916) as the only players in Sox history to accomplish that feat.

#### TOUGH LUCK LOSER

- RHP Reynaldo López matched his career high with 7.0 IP on Sunday vs. Tampa Bay, allowing one unearned run to lower his season ERA to 0.69 (1 ER/13.0 IP).
- López became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he threw 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC).
- López, who was acquired from Washington on 12/7/16 with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito, has thrown at least 6.0 IP in each of his last eight starts dating back to last season ... despite a 1-3 record, he owns a 2.89 ERA (12 ER/37.1 IP) in six career starts at Guaranteed Rate Field.

#### WHITE SOX VS. TAMPA BAY

- The Rays lead the season series, 2-0.
- The White Sox are hitting .221/.337/.382 (15-68) with a 5.00 ERA (10 ER/18.0 IP) and have been outscored, 11-9.
- Six of the last seven games between the teams in Chicago have been decided by two runs or less.
- The teams split the 2017 season series, 3-3, with each winning two of three games at home ... five of the six games were decided by two runs or less.
- The Sox lead the all-time series, 82-69 ... they are 44-31 in Chicago and 38-38 in Tampa Bay.

#### LOOKING FOR AN EDGE VS. THE EAST

- The White Sox are 180-223 vs. the American League East since 2007, with their only winning record during that span coming in 2016 (19-14).
- The Sox are 1-4 vs. the AL East this season after going 13-20 in 2017 (9-8 at home).

#### AT THE HELM

- Rick Renteria is in his second season after being named the 40th manager in White Sox history on 10/3/16.
- Renteria was the only Latino manager in the major leagues in 2017 but has been joined by Boston's Alex Cora and Washington's Dave Martinez in 2018.
- He was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (20th overall) of the 1980 draft ... Cleveland manager Terry Francona (22nd), Oakland executive vice president of baseball operations Billy Beane (23rd) and Toronto manager John Gibbons (24th) were selected in succession later in the first round of that draft.

#### QUALITY IS JOB ONE

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,318 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, four more than the Mets and 47 more than Oakland, the next-closest American League team.

#### ROSTER QUICK FACTS

- The Sox 25-man roster includes 13 pitchers (three LHP), two catchers, six infielders and four outfielders ... LHP Aaron Bummer, OF Nicky Delmonico, OF Adam Engel, RHP Carson Fulmer, RHP Lucas Giolito, RHP Gregory Infante, RHP Reynaldo López, RHP Juan Minaya and Moncada made their first career Opening Day roster.

#### HAWK'S FAREWELL

- Ken "Hawk" Harrelson, who is in his 33rd and final season in the White Sox television booth in 2018, will work primarily Sunday home games this season as well as select other contests.
- Harrelson will serve the organization as a team ambassador throughout the 2019 season, which will mark the beginning of his eighth decade in baseball.

#### CALL TO THE HALL

- Jim Thome, who played for the White Sox from 2006-09 and serves as a special assistant to the general manager, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame on 7/29/18.
- Thome, who ranks eighth in major-league history with 612 home runs, received 89.8 percent of the votes to become the fifth former Sox player inducted on the first ballot.
- He will join Chipper Jones, Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman Jack Morris and Alan Trammell in the Class of 2018.

#### PROSPECT PROWESS

- The White Sox minor-league system is rated by *Baseball America* as the fourth-best in baseball.
- The Sox organization features five of *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects: OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 4), RHP Michael Kopech (No. 11), RHP Alec Hansen (No. 57), OF Luis Robert (No. 58) and RHP Dane Dunning (No. 82) ... Jiménez (No. 4), Kopech (No. 10), Robert (No. 28), Hansen (No. 54), RHP Dylan Cease (No. 71), Dunning (No. 92) and OF Blake Rutherford (No. 99) are ranked in MLB.com's Top 100.

#### ON DECK: AT MINNESOTA TWINS

- The White Sox open a seven-game trip tomorrow night in Minnesota ... RHP Lucas Giolito (0-1, 6.17) is scheduled to start the first of the four-game series.
- The Sox were 7-12 vs. Minnesota in 2017 (3-6 at Target Field) to fall to 3-12-2 in the last 17 season matchups ... Avisail García batted .443 (31-70) in 18 games.
- Chicago is 36-40 all-time at Target Field but has lost 19 of the last 30 games dating back to 9/3/14.
- José Abreu owns a .307 (47-153) average with seven home runs and 30 RBI in 36 career games at Target Field.

SHIELDS AT A GLANCE

- Is scheduled to make his third start of the season, second at Guaranteed Rate Field and first vs. Tampa Bay, his former team ... pitched for the Rays from 2006-12.
Ranks 72nd all-time in major-league history with 2,081 strikeouts, one behind Bobo Newsom for 71st (2,082) ... see chart at right.
Has gone 2-1 with a 3.86 ERA (16 ER/37.1 IP), 33 strikeouts and a .214 opponents average (30-140) over his last six starts at Guaranteed Rate Field ... has allowed three runs or less five times during that span.
Is 10-19 with a 5.98 ERA (161 ER/242.1 IP), 182 strikeouts, 59 home runs allowed and a 1.56 WHIP over 45 outings (17 QS) since being acquired by the White Sox from the Padres in a trade on 6/4/16.
Ranks among the active MLB leaders since 2007 in games started (2nd, 353), IP (2nd, 2,297.2), pitches thrown (2nd, 37,041), opponents GIDP (T3rd, 192), complete games (T4th, 22), quality starts (T5th, 216), shutouts (5th, 9), strikeouts (8th, 1,978) and wins (10th, 132).

LAST START

- Received a no decision on 4/5 vs. Detroit in Chicago's home opener ... allowed three runs on eight hits with one walk and one strikeout.
Allowed single runs in the second, fourth and fifth inning ... surrendered a solo home run to Niko Goodrum, the first of his MLB career.
Departed the game with the Sox leading, 6-3, after throwing 91 pitches (53 strikes) ... the bullpen allowed one run in the eighth, three in the ninth and two in the 10th as the Tigers earned a 9-7, comeback win.
Was the first White Sox to start the season and home opener (on different days) since Mark Buehrle in 2002 ... he earned wins on 4/1 at Seattle (1 ER/6.0 IP) and 4/12 vs. Baltimore (1 ER/7.0 IP).

RAYS REUNION

- Pitched for Tampa Bay from 2006-12 after being selected by the club in the 16th round of the June 2000 First-Year Player Draft ... went 87-73 with a 3.89 ERA (629 ER/1,454.2 IP), 1,250 strikeouts and 10 complete games over 218 appearances (217 starts) with the Rays ... was a 2011 American League All-Star.
Is the franchise leader in wins, starts, complete games, shutouts (eight), IP, strikeouts and QS (132).
Was a member of three postseason teams (2008, 2010 and 2011), including the 2008 AL pennant-winning club ... started Game 2 of the World Series vs. Philadelphia.

OPENING DAY HONORS

- His season debut marked his eighth career Opening Day start following four with Tampa Bay (2008-10, '12), two with Kansas City (2013-14) and one with San Diego (2015).
Is 2-2 with a 4.98 ERA (26 ER/47.0 IP) and 30 strikeouts in the eight OD outings.
Is tied with the Dodgers' Clayton Kershaw for the fourth-most Opening Day starts among active pitchers ... joined Edinson Volquez as the only active pitchers to start season openers for four different teams (STATS).

2017 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Fell one win shy of his 2016 total despite making 12 fewer starts ... his ERA, WHIP, opponents average, on-base percentage, slugging percentage, OPS and BABIP were lower than his 2016 marks.
Made 20-plus starts for the 12th straight season, joining Cole Hamels and Justin Verlander as the only pitchers since 2006 to accomplish that feat.
Did not pitch from 4/18-6/17 due to a strained right lat.
Recorded his 2,000th career strikeout on 6/24 vs. Oakland, fanning Khris Davis to end the second inning ... became the 81st pitcher (57th right-hander) in MLB history to reach the milestone.
Became the fifth pitcher to record his 2,000th career strikeout in a White Sox uniform, joining Javier Vázquez (2008), Charlie Hough (1991), Jim Kaat (1974) and Early Wynn (1960) ... source: STATS LLC.

APRIL FLOWERS

- Is 23-12 with a 2.94 ERA (123 ER/376.2 IP) and .225 opponents average over 56 career starts in April ... the 2.94 mark is his lowest in any month (3.77 in May ranks second).
Was 1-0 with a 1.62 ERA (3 ER/16.2 IP) and a .153 opp. average (9-59) over three starts in April 2017 ... allowed just one earned run in each April outing last season.
Has gone 2-0 with a 4.19 mark (9 ER/19.1 IP) in three career March starts.

NOT DIGGING THE LONG BALL

- Has given up at least one home run in 28 of his last 34 starts (48 total), allowed 68 homers since 2016 and 101 since 2015 ... has allowed the most home runs in baseball since 2015.
Allowed 27 home runs last season, his fewest since 2014 (23) ... surrendered a major-league leading 40 home runs in 2016 after leading baseball with 33 in 2015 ... became the first pitcher to lead MLB in homers allowed in consecutive seasons since Tom Browning in 1988-89.
Has allowed 1.78 homers per 9.0 IP since 2015 (512.0 IP), the second-highest mark in the major leagues.

HELP WANTED

- Chicago has scored 17 runs in support of Shields over his first two starts ... by comparison, the club did not reach 17 runs until his sixth outing last season.
Received a 5.46 run support average (71 RS/117.0 IP) over his 21 starts last season, compared to a 3.22 mark (65 RS/181.2 IP) in 2016 ... his 4.69 career RSA is tied for the 12th-lowest among active pitchers.
His 3.22 RSA in 2016 was the lowest in baseball and the lowest of his career.
Owns a 5.04 RSA (133 RS/237.1 IP) since joining the White Sox (44 starts), receiving the following run support marks: zero runs (10x), one (7x), two (7x), three (6x), four (4x), five (3x) and six-plus (8x).

VS. TAMPA BAY RAYS

- Is scheduled to make his fourth career start vs. Tampa Bay ... is 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA (3 ER/20.0 IP), 23 strikeouts, a .205 opponents average (15-73) and 0.95 WHIP lifetime.
His three starts vs. the Rays are his fewest against any American League team.
Earned the win in his last outing on 9/26/16 at Guaranteed Rate Field after allowing one run on seven hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER

- RHP Lucas Giolito (0-1, 6.17 ERA) is scheduled to make his third start of the season, second on the road and first vs. Tampa Bay.
Suffered his first loss of the season on 4/7 vs. Detroit, allowing five runs on four hits with three walks and three HBP over 5.2 IP.
Went 3-3 with a 2.38 ERA (12 ER/45.1 IP), 34 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and .190 (31-163) opponents average in seven starts with the White Sox in 2017 after starting the season with Class AAA Charlotte.
Was acquired by Chicago with RHPs Dane Dunning and Reynaldo López from Washington in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16.
Earned the win in his only career start vs. the Rays on 9/3/17 in Chicago, surrendering just one run on three hits over 7.0 IP.
