TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland is heading to its fourth Postseason in the past six campaigns...the club's 542-423 (.562) record since the start of 2013 is the best in the American League (2nd-best in MLB - LAD).

» The Indians have gone 46-25 (.657) vs. the A.L. Central, marking the 3rd-best intradivisional record in MLB (BOS - 50-21, .704; ATL - 48-23, .676)...their 2.84 ERA vs. the Central is the lowest by any team against their own division.

» Since August 13, **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** ranks 3rd in the A.L. (min. 100 PA) with a .346 batting average...**YAN GOMES** is 4th with a .340 mark in that span, and owns an active nine-game hit streak.

» **SHANE BIBER** has gone 6-0 with a 3.92 ERA (26ER/59.2IP) on the road...he is tied for the most single-season road wins without a loss by a Tribe pitcher in the *Baseball-Reference* Play Index era (1908-) with **Joe Heving** (1944) and **George Culver** (1967).

MODEL OF CONSISTENCY

» The Indians are headed to their fourth Postseason in their past six campaigns, all under the management of **Terry Francona**.

» Cleveland has posted a record above .500 in each of the past six seasons, marking the club's longest such streak since doing so in eight straight campaigns from 1994-2001...also represents the 2nd-longest streak in the American League (NYY - 26 straight seasons) and the 5th-longest in MLB.

» Since Francona's tenure began in 2013, the Indians hold the best record in the American League (2nd-best in MLB).

PLAYOFF PRIMER

» The Indians clinched their third consecutive A.L. Central division title on September 15, their earliest clinch date since doing so on September 8, 1999.

» Boston's victory vs. Baltimore on Monday ensured that they will hold home-field advantage throughout the Postseason...since Houston won and Oakland lost last night, the Astros have officially clinched the A.L. West and the #2 seed in the A.L. bracket.

» The Indians and Astros, the American League's last two representatives in the World Series, will officially meet in the ALDS for their first-ever Postseason matchup...Games 1 & 2 will be held in Houston on October 5 & 6, while Cleveland will host Game 3 on October 8 and Game 4 (if necessary) on October 9.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» Cleveland fell in walk-off fashion for the 12th time this season, dropping the second contest of this three-game set, 5-4, at Chicago-AL...matches the franchise record for walk-off losses in a season, done three other times (1967, 2004, 2006).

» All four of Cleveland's runs scored over a seven-batter stretch in the 3rd and 4th innings...**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** put the Tribe on the board with an RBI-single, giving him 104 RBI on the season...**YONDER ALONSO** followed suit with a two-run single, his 80th and 81st RBI...**YAN GOMES** led off the Tribe's half of the 4th with a solo homer, his 16th longball of 2018.

» **TREVOR BAUER** worked 4.0 innings in his second start since returning from the Disabled List on September 21...Bauer allowed two runs on five hits (one home run), walking none and striking out four batters...**CARLOS CARRASCO** worked the final 4.1 innings in his second relief appearance of the season...Carrasco was dominant through his first 4.0 frames, striking out eight batters and allowing just one hit...he was touched for three hits and a walk in the bottom of the 9th and took his 10th loss of the season.

SOUTH SIDE STORY

» The Indians are facing the White Sox this week in the final of six series between the divisional rivals...**Cleveland owns a 13-5 record vs. Chicago-AL in 2018**, going 8-1 at Progressive Field and 5-4 thus far at Guaranteed Rate Field.

» Cleveland has won 25 of its last 34 games overall against Chicago-AL (since April 21, 2017), posting a 2.56 team ERA (86ER/302.2IP)...the Tribe has outscored the White Sox 179-88 in that span, allowing three-or-fewer runs in 25 contests (21-4 record).

DIVISIONAL DOMINANCE

» Cleveland has gone 46-25 vs. A.L. Central opponents this season, with a record of 15-5-2 in series play...the Indians' .648 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB behind Boston (50-21, .704 vs. A.L. East) and Atlanta (48-23, .676 vs. N.L. East).

» Nine of the Tribe's 17 shutouts this season have come against the A.L. Central (three vs. Chicago-AL).

» In 71 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.84 ERA (201ER/637.1IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB...the Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 45 intradivisional games (39-6 in those contests).

BIBER'S A HIT ON THE ROAD

» **SHANE BIBER** is set to make his 19th start (20th appearance) of the season in tonight's series finale at Chicago-AL...he is pitching on regular four days' rest after making his first career relief appearance on September 21 vs. Boston...took the loss after allowing six runs on eight hits over 4.2 innings of work (2BB, 1K).

» Bieber has made one previous career start against the White Sox, which came on August 10 at Guaranteed Rate Field...took a no-decision despite tossing 6.2 shutout innings, allowing just three hits with two walks and eight strikeouts.

» Leads all MLB rookie pitchers this season (min. 70.0IP) with a 5.19 K/BB ratio (109K/21BB), the highest single-season mark by an Indians rookie (min. 70.0IP)...also leads all MLB rookie pitchers with a 1.74 BB/9 ratio (21BB/108.2IP), the 2nd-lowest single-season mark by an Indians rookie (**Tom Brennan**, 0.97 in 1982).

» Bieber has gone 6-0 with a 3.92 ERA (26ER/59.2IP) in 10 road starts this season...he is currently tied with **Joe Heving** (6-0 in 1944) and **George Culver** (6-0 in 1967) for the most road wins without a loss by an Indians pitcher in the *Baseball-Reference* Play Index era (1908-).

STURDY STARTERS

» Tribe starters have recorded 96 quality starts this season, tops in MLB and Cleveland's most in a single campaign since notching 108 in 1968...overall this season, Indians starters rank 2nd in the A.L. and 3rd in MLB with a 3.43 ERA (HOU - 3.18, LAD - 3.19).

» Cleveland starters rank 2nd in MLB with 1,035 strikeouts (HOU - 1,079), while they have allowed just 238 walks (4th-fewest in MLB)...the Tribe rotation's 4.35 K/BB ratio currently stands as the highest in MLB history.

» Indians pitchers have recorded 30 starts with at least 10 strikeouts, tied with Houston for the most in MLB this season and T3rd-most in MLB history.

YAN THE LOOSE

» **YAN GOMES** went 1-for-4 last night with his 16th home run of the season...extended his hit streak to a season-long nine games, a span over which he is batting .361 (13-36) with three homers, four doubles, six RBI and six runs scored.

» Gomes' 16 longballs this season are his 2nd-most in a single campaign, trailing his 21 homers in 2014 (won Silver Slugger)...he currently ranks 2nd among A.L. catchers (min. 200PA) with his .267 batting average and 5th in home runs.

» Since August 13, Gomes is hitting .340 (35-103) across 27 games with five homers, eight doubles, 12 RBI and 12 runs scored...marks the 4th-highest batting average in the American League in that span (min. 100 PA).

SMOOTH SAILING

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** has hit safely in each of his last five games, as well as 11 of his last 13, batting .370 (20-54) since September 8 with three homers, two doubles, five RBI and nine runs scored in that span.

» Overall in the month of September, Brantley is batting .352 (25-71), the 5th-highest mark in the American League (min. 75PA)...**Brantley is a career .325 (205-630) hitter in September, the highest mark among active MLB players (min. 300PA).**

YONDER APPRECIATED

» **YONDER ALONSO** is batting .387 (12-31) across his last nine contests with a homer, four RBI and five runs scored...he has hit .400 (4-10) vs. LHP in that span with a homer and two RBI.

» Thanks to a two-run single last night, Alonso has now driven in a career-high 81 runs this season...he became the fourth Indians player to reach 80 RBI this season, making Cleveland one of just three teams in MLB (with BOS & OAK) that can claim four such hitters this season...marks the Tribe's most batters with 80+ RBI since also having four in 2004 (**Blake, Broussard, Hafner, Martinez**).

FINISH STRONG

» The Indians enter play tonight with a 35-16 record in series finales...Cleveland's .686 win percentage in finales ranks 2nd in MLB behind Boston (.720, 36-14)...the Tribe has also gone 18-4 this season in intradivisional series finales.

» Cleveland owns a 15-10 record in road finales this season, with wins coming in 10 of their last 14 instances.

» Tribe starting pitchers have excelled in series finales this season, posting a 29-9 record with a 2.80 ERA (103ER/331.1IP), including wins in 21 of their last 28 decisions.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1907: The Naps blank the New York Highlanders, 6-0, thanks to a one-hit shutout by **Heinie Berger**...the 25-year-old rookie followed **Addie Joss'** one-hitter the previous day, marking the only time in franchise history that Cleveland has held opponents to one hit or fewer in consecutive games...the club's namesake **Nap Lajoie** led the 14-hit attack, going 2-for-5 with a triple and two RBI.

TONIGHT'S OUTING

» The 23-year-old rookie is scheduled to make his final regular season start of his rookie campaign in tonight's series finale at Chicago-AL...will mark his 20th career appearance and 19th career start.

» Will be pitching tonight on regular four days' rest after taking the loss in his last outing on September 21 vs. Boston...allowed six runs on eight hits (two home runs), with two walks and one strikeout in 4.2 innings of relief, marking his first career appearance of the bullpen.

» Bieber is due to face the White Sox for the second time in his young career...took a no-decision on August 10 at Guaranteed Rate Field, scattering three hits across 6.2 shutout innings (2BB, 8K).

» Has accrued 10 wins this season, marking the first Indians rookie pitcher with 10-or-more wins in a single season since **Mitch Talbot** won 10 games in 2010...also marks the first Indians rookie hurler with 100-or-more strikeouts in a single season since **TREVOR BAUER** fanned 143 in 2014.

» Bieber's 109 strikeouts this year is tied with **Charles Nagy** (1991) for the 4th-highest single-season total by an Indians rookie pitcher over the last 40 years (1978-), behind **CC Sabathia** (171 in 2001), **BAUER** (143 in 2014) and **Zach McAllister** (110 in 2012).

» **Bieber has also posted a 5.19 K/BB ratio, the top mark among MLB rookie pitchers this season (min. 70.0IP), as well as the best single-season ratio by an Indians rookie hurler (min. 70.0IP).**

» He enters play today averaging 1.74 BB/9 (21BB/108.2IP), the lowest mark among Major League rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP), as well as the 2nd-lowest single-season mark by an Indians rookie pitcher (min. 70.0IP), behind **Tom Brennan** (0.97 in 1982).

» Entering tonight's contest, Bieber ranks among the American League rookie pitching leaders in wins (T2nd, 10), strikeouts (2nd, 109), games started (T4th, 18), innings pitched (4th, 108.2), ERA (8th, 4.80) and opponent batting average (10th, .294).

VS. CHICAGO-AL | A.L. CENTRAL

» Bieber is due to face the Chicago White Sox for the second time in his career tonight...took a no-decision in his prior start on August 10 at Guaranteed Rate Field (6.2IP, 3H, 2BB, 8K).

» Tonight marks his ninth career start against an opponent from the A.L. Central division and has compiled a 4-1 record and 4.07 ERA (22ER/48.2IP) in his eight prior starts...took his lone intradivisional loss in his last start against the division, on September 16 vs. Detroit (6.0IP, 9H, 5R/ER, 1HR, 0BB, 4K).

WALKING TALL

» From May 31-September 6, Bieber posted a streak of 16 starts with two-or-fewer walks allowed, marking the longest streak by an Indians starting pitcher to begin his career in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-).

» Overall, he has allowed 21 walks in his 19 Major League appearances (108.2IP)...his 1.74 BB/9 (21BB/108.2IP) is the lowest among all MLB rookie pitchers this season (min. 70.0IP), as well as the 2nd-lowest single season mark by an Indians rookie hurler (min. 70.0IP), behind **Tom Brennan** (0.97 in 1982).

» Has also posted a 5.19 SO/BB ratio (109SO/21BB), the highest mark among all Major League rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP) and the highest single-season mark by an Indians rookie pitcher (min. 70.0IP).

ON THE ROAD

» Tonight will mark Bieber's 11th career road start and has yet to lose a road outing in his career, going 6-0 with a 3.92 ERA (26ER/59.2IP) in his 10 starts.

» Bieber is one of three Indians pitchers in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-) to go 6-0 on the road in a single season, joining **George Culver** (6-0 in 1967) and **Joe Heving** (6-0 in 1944)...with a win tonight, Bieber would become the first Tribe hurler since 1908 with seven wins and zero losses on the road.

10 WINS AND COUNTING

» Bieber won his 10th career game on September 10 at Tampa Bay, becoming the first Indians rookie pitcher with 10 victories in a single season since **Mitch Talbot** had 10 in 2010...should he emerge victorious tonight, his win total would mark the most wins by an Indians rookie since **David Huff** had 11 in 2009.

» Became the fifth Indians pitcher to reach the 10-win mark this season, alongside **COREY KLUBER** (18), **CARLOS CARRASCO** (16), **TREVOR BAUER** (12) and **MIKE CLEVINGER** (12)...Tribe is the second team in MLB to feature five such pitchers this year, alongside Houston.

» Cleveland has featured five pitchers with 10+ wins each of the last three seasons (since 2016), the first such streak in franchise history...Tribe is just the fifth team in MLB with a similar three-season streak in the last 50 years, joining Tampa Bay (2010-12), Boston (1977-79), Los Angeles-NL (1976-78) and Cincinnati (1973-76).

2018 CLEVELAND RECAP

» Bieber's start on September 11 at Tampa Bay (6.2IP, 3H, 3BB, 11K) marked just the third start of 6.0-or-more shutout innings, three-or-fewer hits allowed and 10-or-more strikeouts in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-), alongside similar outings by **Herb Score** (July 30, 1955 at Baltimore) and **Steve Dunning** (July 17, 1970 at Kansas City).

» Bieber has struck out 109 batters this season, the 4th-most punchouts through an Indians pitcher's first 19 career games in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-), behind **Herb Score** (144), **DANNY SALAZAR** (118) and **Greg Swindell** (112).

» Earned his fifth win on July 13, marking the first Indians pitcher with five wins in his first seven career starts since **CC Sabathia** did so in 2001.

» Won his fourth career game on July 3 at Kansas City, becoming the third Tribe pitcher in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-) with four wins in his first five career starts, joining **John Farrell** (1987) and **Scott Lewis** (2008-09).

» On June 22 vs. Detroit, Bieber became the sixth Indians pitcher since 1908 to record a start with 7.0-or-more shutout innings and four-or-fewer hits allowed within his first three career starts, and the first since **Scott Lewis** did so on September 10, 2008 at Baltimore...at 23.022 years old marked the youngest pitcher in franchise history to achieve that feat, surpassing **Ray Benge** (23.157), who did so on Sept. 26, 1925 at Philadelphia.

» Bieber fanned a then-career high nine Tigers hitters in the June 22 outing, becoming the first Indians pitcher since **Luis Tiant** in 1964 with six-or-more strikeouts in each of his first three career appearances...his 22 strikeouts combined across his first three career starts tied him with **DANNY SALAZAR** (also 22) for the 3rd-most strikeouts in a pitcher's first three career appearances in Indians franchise history.

» Earned his first career win in his second career start on June 17 vs. Minnesota...allowed one run on 11 hits in 5.2 innings, with one walk...fanned seven batters, becoming the fourth pitcher in Indians franchise history to strike out six-or-more batters in each of his first two career starts and first since **SALAZAR** did so in his first two appearances from July 11 - August 7, 2013.

» Made his Major League debut against the Twins at Target Field on May 31...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 9-8 win (5.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 6K)...struck out six batters, including his first career batter faced (**Brian Dozier**), marking the most punchouts in a Tribe pitcher's first Major League start since **SALAZAR** fanned seven in his MLB debut on July 11, 2013 vs. Toronto.

» Bieber became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to make his Major League debut on his birthday, as well as the second player after outfielder **Dave Clark** on September 3, 1986 at Toronto.
