MARINERS NOTES:

- The Mariners improve to 35-19 (.648) at home this season... entered today's game with the 4th best home winning percentage in the Majors.
- The Mariners improve 27-13 in 1-run games, lead the MLB in 1-run wins.
- Today's attendance of 45,548 marks the 3rd sellout crowd at Safeco Field this season (also: 3/29 vs. CLE and 6/17 vs. BOS).
- Ryon Healy** (2x3, R, HR, RBI) has reached base via hit or walk multiple times in 3 consecutive games... marks the 4th time this season he has reached base 2+ times in 3 straight games (last: 5/5-8).
 - Is batting (10x22) with 5 runs, 1 doubles, 5 home runs, and 13 RBI over his last 6 day games.
 - Recorded his 21st home run of the season and is now tied with Matt Olson for most home runs among American League 1st basemen.
 - Recorded his 19th multi-hit game of the season.
- Edwin Díaz** recorded his Major League leading 38th save of the season... his 21 saves in 1-run games are only 2 shy of equaling the Major League single-season record, set by Francisco Rodriguez in 2008 (23).
 - His 38 saves are tied for 4th-most in single-season club history (also: David Aardsma, 2009)...the club record is 48, set by Fernando Rodney in 2014.
- Jean Segura** (1x3, 2 RBI, SF) has hit safely in 7 straight games, batting .258 (8x31) with 5 runs scored, 1 double, 2 RBI, and 1 walk over that span.
 - Recorded his 5th game-winning RBI of the season, ranks T4th most on the team (also: Nelson Cruz).
- Mike Leake** has recorded back-to-back quality starts, and has tossed a quality start in 9 of his last 12 starts.
 - Retired 15 of the first 16 batters he faced through 5.0 innings.
 - Recorded his 4th consecutive no-decision in which he has pitched 6+ innings and allowed 2 runs or fewer.
- Dee Gordon** (1x2, R, SFB, HBP) picked up his AL-leading 23rd stolen base of the season.
 - The Mariners are 15-2 this season when he records at least 1 stolen base.
 - Reached base 2+ times for the 33rd time this season.

GIANTS NOTES:

- The Giants fall to 7-15 against the Mariners over their last 22 matchups.
- Hunter Pence** (1x3, 2B, RBI) finished the road trip batting .417 (5x12) with 1 run, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 4 RBI, and 1 stolen base.
- Derek Holland** has tossed 6+ innings and allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 14 of his 24 career starts against the Mariners... is 5-3 with a 2.71 (20 ER, 66.1) IP in 10 career starts at Safeco Field.
- Brandon Belt** (1x3) recorded a hit in his 3rd at bat... was only his 2nd hit in his last 34 at bats.
 - Was lifted in the 7th inning for a pinch-runner.
- Brandon Crawford** (1x4, R, 2B, RBI) recorded his 3rd RBI in July to drive in the 1st run for the Giants in the 7th inning... had only 1 RBI in his last 17 games prior to today's contest.

GIANTS MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY:

On Brandon Belt's injury:

"Right now it's a hyperextended right knee. He'll get checked out tomorrow. I can't tell you how long or anything. Probably best case it's going to be two or three days but we'll know more tomorrow after he gets looked at in San Francisco."

On whether Evan Longoria will be brought back as a result:

"We're going to talk about it. The game just ended, so I haven't had a chance to talk to [Brian Sabean] and Bobby [Evans] and also check on Longo. Also, we've got to wait and see what we find out with Brandon. That's a tough break, we could've used him there at the end. It might've changed how we played it a little bit...Hopefully we will get the best news."
