RAY MATTER—Yesterday's win was the Rays first since Opening Day vs. BOS, snapping an 8-game losing streak which was their longest since July 5-16, 2016 vs. LAA, at BOS, vs. BAL (8)...it was their first road win of the season, snapping a 5-game road losing streak which tied the club record (2001) to begin a season...the 14 hits were a season high and their most since Aug 25, 2017 at STL (16), and the 4 XBH tied a season high (also Sun at BOS)...the White Sox ground crew cleared the field of 2" of snow and the game began following a 21 minute delay.

COLD SNAP—First-pitch temperature was 35° in yesterday's game, the 2nd-coldest ever for a Rays game...the Rays have played 13 games in franchise history with a first pitch at 40°F or colder and four of those games have come on this road trip...according to weather.com, remaining highs forecasted for this series are 46° and 61°...the Rays have seen snow in all three cities (New York, Boston, Chicago) of this trip...they are 25-37 all-time in games with a first pitch at 50°F or colder and 7-6 at 40°F or colder.

GUT CHECK—Despite yesterday's win, the 2-8 record matches 2011 for the worst 10-game start in club history...those 2011 Rays also had an early-season series in Chicago against the White Sox, and won 5 straight after a 1-8 start to improve to 6-8—perhaps sparked by a diving catch from **Sam Fuld** in right field to rob at least a bases-clearing triple from **Juan Pierre**...the 2011 Rays are one of two teams to ever advance to the post-season after a 1-8 start to the season, along with the 1995 Reds...the Rays were 9 games out of playoff contention through Sep 3 and came back to clinch a postseason berth on the final day of the regular season.

- + The Rays were the sixth team and second AL team since Baseball Reference data is available (1908) to win on Opening Day and lose their next 8 games, following the 2005 Rockies (8), 1998 Marlins (11), 1961 Angels (8), 1944 Cubs (13) and 1939 Pirates (8).

RAYS vs. WHITE SOX—This is the second of 6 games with the White Sox this season...the White Sox visit St. Petersburg for a 3-game series from Aug 3-5...the clubs split the season series last year, with the Rays going 2-1 at Tropicana Field and 1-2 on the road...the Rays are 68-82 (.453) all-time, 38-38 at home and 30-44 on the road...they are 38-36 in the Rays era (since 2008) and 12-8 (.600) under Manager **Kevin Cash** (since 2015).

- + This is the seventh game of an 8-game, 10-day trip to New York (0-2), Boston (0-3) and Chicago (1-0).

DAY IN, DAY OUT—This road trip is the first time in club history that every game of a multi-city trip is a day game...three times previously, every game on a road trip was a day game, but all of these were 1 game:

- + **Aug 26, 2013 at KC** (makeup game in the middle of a 6-game homestand after a May 2 rain/snowout, described as a "wintry mix")
- + **April 14, 2004 at NYY** (only game played on a 2-game trip after an originally scheduled night game on April 13 was rained out and rescheduled as a traditional doubleheader on Labor Day, Sep 6)
- + **Sep 23, 2004 at NYY** (makeup game in the middle of a 9-game homestand after the Rays arrived, due to Hurricane Frances, three hours after the scheduled start of a Sep 6 doubleheader)

ALL IN A DAY'S WORK—Including the final game of the first homestand, the Rays will play nine consecutive day games from April 1-11...according to Rays PR research, this will be the longest streak of consecutive day games in franchise history...the previous club record was eight straight from April 8-16, 2012 vs. NYY, at DET, at BOS...in fact, aside from these instances, the longest such streak is four straight: Aug 6-10, 2014 at OAK/CHC, April 10-15, 2013 at TEX/BOS and April 4-7, 2002 vs. DET, at NYY.

SEEKING LENGTH—Only once this season has a Rays starter gone at least 6 IP, when **Chris Archer** did it on Opening Day vs. BOS (6 IP plus 2 BF in the 7th inning)...last season, Rays starters went 6 IP or more in 88 of 162 starts (54.3 pct.), tied for the 3rd-highest rate in the AL...the Rays are the only team in the majors without a "quality start" this season (6 IP or more, 3 ER or fewer)...their 10 games without a "quality start" ties the lon-

gest single-season streak in club history (4th time, last April 10-20, 2005), while the overall club record is 12 straight spanning 1998-99.

REDEFINING RELIEF—Through 10 games, a Rays reliever has thrown at least 50 pitches six times...the other 29 teams have combined to do it 12 times, and only the Marlins (2) have done it more than once...Rays relievers combined to make 6 apps of 50-plus pitches all of last season...Rays relievers have totaled a 4 apps of at least 4 IP, most in the majors, and 9 apps of at least 2 IP, tied for 2nd-most in the majors behind the Brewers (10).

BATS HEATING UP—The Rays have combined for 12 runs, 25 hits, 3 2B, 3 3B and 2 HR over their last 2 games, batting .329 (25-for-76) overall and .346 (9-for-26) with RISP...over their first 8 games of the season, they combined for 20 runs, 49 hits, 9 2B, 1 3B and 3 HR, batting .188 (49-for-261) overall and .208 (10-for-48) with RISP...they were held to 4 runs or fewer in 6 of their first 8 games and 2 runs or fewer in 5 of those 8 games.

THE MALLEX EFFECT—The 4 hits by **Mallex Smith** yesterday tied his career high (also July 5, 2017 at CHC)...he became the third Ray in franchise history with at least 4 hits and 2 SB, joining **Carl Crawford** (7x-last June 29, 2010 at BOS) and **Julio Lugo** (July 7, 2005 vs. DET)...Mallex was the first Ray with 4 hits, 1 2B and 1 3B in the same game since **Evan Longoria** hit for the cycle last Aug 1 at HOU...his 7 total bases were the 2nd-most of his career behind May 17, 2016 at PIT (8, with ATL)...was the fourth multi-XBH game of his career and the fifth multi-SB game of his career.

- + In the 8th inning, he attempted to steal home on a pickoff throw to first base...the Rays challenged the call, which was upheld after video review...it would have been the 11th steal of home in club history...no Ray has stolen home since **Desmond Jennings** on July 3, 2012 vs. NYY, and no Ray has done that not involving a double steal since **Melvin Upton Jr.** on July 8, 2009 vs. TOR.

MOVING ON UP—In yesterday's win, **Chris Archer** recorded 8 SO, giving him 1,066 SO in his career to pass **David Price** (1,065) for 2nd in franchise history behind **James Shields** (1,250), who starts tomorrow for the White Sox...**Alex Colomé** recorded the 86th save of his career, passing **Fernando Rodney** (85) for 2nd in franchise history behind **Roberto Hernández** (101)...Archer and Price remain close friends, as do Colomé and Rodney, both Dominicans who were teammates for the Rays in 2013 and again during last spring's World Baseball Classic...**Kevin Kiermaier's** next steal will tie **Jason Bartlett** (61) for 8th in club history...**Wilson Ramos** is 1 2B shy of 100 2B for his career, and 6 HR shy of 100 HR.

LA PANTERA—Shortstop **Adeiny Hechavarria** has not committed an error since last July 30 at NYY, a streak of 60 games and 204 chances without an error...it is the longest streak by games and 3rd-longest by chances for a shortstop in club history...since last Aug 1, he is the only shortstop in the majors to appear in at least 20 games without committing an error...since being acquired by the Rays on June 26, 2017, he has a .988 fielding pct. in 86 games (83 starts)...prior to his arrival last season, Rays shortstops ranked 14th of 15 AL teams with a .959 fielding pct.

STACKED DECK—The Rays began the season with 9 games against the Red Sox (7) and Yankees (2), the AL East's two postseason teams last season...this series is the first of three consecutive series against teams that finished last season below .500: White Sox, Phillies, Rangers...this series began a stretch where 15 of 19 series through June 13 are against opponents that finished last season below .500.

MLB ON TWITTER—Select MLB games will be streamed via Twitter as a result of a renewed partnership...Twitter will feature weekly day game live streams of out-of-market games...this will include today's Rays-White Sox game...fans may watch online or on connected devices at live.twitter.com/mlb and do not require a Twitter account to watch.

LAST START—On Wed at NYY, yielded home runs to **Giancarlo Stanton** (1st inning) and **Gary Sánchez** (3rd inning), tying a career high with 2 HR allowed (3rd time) and snapping his scoreless streak at 12.2 IP...threw 90 pitches in 3.1 IP, and his pitch count by inning was 27-23-27 plus 13 to 2 BF in the 4th inning...fell to 2-3 in 9 starts against the Yankees, his most frequent opponent, and 0-3 in 6 starts at Yankee Stadium... since Baseball Reference data is available (1908), is one of two visiting pitchers with 6 starts at Yankee Stadium in the first 45 games of his career, joining **PHA/BOS Biff Schlitzer** (7)...his line: L, 3.1 IP, 4 H, 5 R, 3 BB, 5 SO, 2 HR, 90 pit, 54 str.

OVERVIEW—Enters his third major league season, having been on the active roster for three stints in 2017 and two stints in 2016...selected as the No. 2 starter on March 15 by Manager **Kevin Cash**, up from No. 4 in last year's season-opening rotation... was 0-0 with a 3.12 ERA (17.1-IP, 6-ER) and 27 SO in 5 starts this spring.

vs. WHITE SOX—Is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (9.1-IP, 0-ER) in 2 starts, both at Guaranteed Rate Field...in his last start of 2016, allowed 1 hit in a rain-shortened start of 2.2 IP... last Sep 1, his only run allowed was unearned in the 2nd inning, a single by **Leury Garcia** (E3, throwing; no RBI)...his line: 6.2 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 1 SO.

THROWING BLANKS—In 12 starts since his Aug 8 recall last season, he is 5-2 with a 3.14 ERA (66-IP, 23-ER) and .199 opp avg. (47-for-236)...he hasn't allowed a run in four of these starts, and hasn't allowed an earned run in 5 starts...both losses have come against the Yankees—he hasn't lost to any other opponent since July 24, 2017 vs. BAL, or on the road since June 28, 2017 at PIT...he is 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (42-IP, 8-ER) in 7 starts at home over this span, including an active home scoreless streak of 23.2 IP, compared to 2-2 with a 5.63 ERA (24-IP, 15-ER) in 5 starts on the road.

TOUGH ON LEFTIES—Has never allowed a homer to a left-handed hitter in his career (173 BF), and hasn't allowed an extra-base hit to a lefty over his last 11 starts, dating back to the end of last season (36 BF)...since 2016, only one other pitcher in the majors has faced as many lefties without yielding a home run: SF **Ty Blach** (237 BF)...last season, lefties hit .182/.267/.227 (12-for-66) against him while righties hit .243/.325/.416 (101-for-416) with 15 HR.

WHERE HE LEFT OFF—In the 2017 season finale on Oct 1 vs. BAL, he totaled 7 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB and 13 SO in a 6-0 win...the 13 SO were a career high and most by a Rays lefty since **David Price** (13) on Sep 25, 2012 at BOS...it was only the third time in Rays history a pitcher recorded at least 13 SO without allowing a run, joining Price (14) on Aug 28, 2011 at TOR and **James Shields** (13) on May 22, 2011 at FLA.

PRICE-TRADAMUS?—In May 2017, while Snell was struggling through a rough beginning to his season, **David Price** told the *Tampa Bay Times*: “[Snell’s] stuff is better than my stuff at his age; I like his stuff way more. He’ll get through it. ... It takes some time. This game ain’t easy, especially at that age. There’s a small number of guys that come up at that age, especially in this division, and be really good at the beginning. It takes time.”

NO BRUISES INFLICTED—Has never hit a batter in 45 career starts, the longest streak by a Rays starter at any point in franchise history, passing **James Shields** (38) in 2009-10...min. 20 starts, only one other pitcher since the start of 2016 season has not hit a batter: ARI **Zack Greinke** (60 starts).

TURN OF FORTUNE—Compiled both the longest winless streak (15 starts, April 6–Aug 10) and unbeaten streak (10 starts, July 29–Sep 20) by a Rays starter in 2017...the 15-start winless streak was the longest by any pitcher to begin a season since MIL **Marco Estrada** (15) in 2012, and tied **Tanyon Sturtze** in 2002 for the longest in club history to begin a season...it extended to 16 starts including his final start of 2016, one shy of the club record.

+ Averaged 2.70 BB/9 IP over his last 13 starts beginning July 24, compared to 5.95 BB/9 IP in 11 starts prior to that.

- + His last ejection was July 18, 2017 at OAK, his seventh ejection as Rays manager...his 7 ejections are tied for 4th in franchise history.
- + Is the sixth Tampa-born manager in major league history, and second to manage the Rays...that list includes Hall of Famers **Al Lopez** and **Tony La Russa**, **Lou Piniella**, **Dave Miley** and **John Hart**.
