LAST START: Berríos lost his eighth start of the year after allowing three runs on nine hits and three walks with six strikeouts in 4.2 innings July 29 at Boston...allowed runners on base in each inning, stranding runners in scoring position in each inning of work...nine hits ties a career high and his most since July 1, 2017 vs. Kansas City...fewest innings pitched since June 29 at Chicago-NL...finished the month with fewest IP of any month this year.

YES WAY JOSÉ!: Starting pitcher José Berríos was named to the American League All-Star team, the first of his career...it marked the second consecutive season that the Twins have sent a starting pitcher to the All-Star Game (Ervin Santana)...below is a list of Twins starting pitchers to make the ASG:

CLEAN INNING IN THE CAPITAL: Berríos made his first career appearance in an All-Star game at the 89th ASG at Nationals Park in Washington D.C...Berríos came in for the fifth inning to throw for the American League and faced four batters, allowing one walk on 13 pitches, five of which were strikes.

MORE FROM THE LEADERBOARD: Berríos is leading the Twins starters in innings pitched (139.0), wins (10), strikeouts (142), quality starts (13), WHIP (1.05), opponent batting average (.218), has allowed the fewest walks (33) and second among starters in ERA (3.56 - Gibson, 3.40)...among AL starters with at least 21 starts, has the seventh lowest opponent OBP (.277), eighth in strikeouts, and ninth in IP...one of only three pitchers in baseball with two complete games (SEA James Paxton, CLE Carlos Carrasco)...one of 18 pitchers in the AL with 10 or more wins.

AGAINST THE ROYALS: Berríos is seventh career start and second of the year against Kansas City...in his career, is 1-1, 5.51 ERA (32.2 IP, 20 ER) with 10 walks and 22 strikeouts...last start against the Royals was July 9, earned the win after allowing one run on six hits with eight strikeouts over 7.0 innings...only career loss to Kansas City was September 5, 2016, allowed five runs on nine hits and one walk with six strikeouts over 5.0 innings...in his last two starts against the Royals, is 1-0, 1.92 ERA (14.0 IP, 3 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts.

BERR-OLLIN': Since May 15, Berríos is 7-4 with a 3.10 ERA (93.0 IP, 32 ER) with 24 walks and 102 strikeouts over a 13 start stretch...lasted 6.0+ innings in 12 starts of his 14 starts over that stretch...1.05 WHIP in that stretch is sixth best in the AL...his 102 strikeouts are fifth most in the AL and seventh most in baseball...his 3.10 ERA is fifth best in the AL and 13th in baseball.

KEEPING 'EM OFF THE BASES: In 2018, Berríos has walked 30 batters, which is tied for eighth fewest in the AL among starters with 21 starts...his BB/9 rate is 2.14, which is eighth best in the AL and 12th best in baseball...Berríos has also allowed 113 hits and owns a 1.05 WHIP, which is sixth best in the AL and 10th in baseball...opponents are only hitting .218 off of Berríos this year, seventh best in the AL.

WIZARD OF WHIFF: With his outing on June 7 vs. Chicago-AL, Berríos has now thrown the four most recent 10+ K, 0 run games in Twins history (April 12 vs. Chicago-AL, August 30, 2017 vs. Chicago-AL, May 18, 2017 vs. Colorado)...the last to do it before Berríos was Ervin Santana on August 30, 2015 vs. Houston...now with four games of 10+ strikeouts and 0 walks, he follows Johan Santana (8) and Bert Blyleven (6) for most such performances in Twins history...Berríos is seventh in the American League in strikeout-to-walk ratio at 4.30...four 10+ strikeout starts in 2018 and six in his career.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Since the beginning of 2017, Berríos is 16-3 with a 2.72 ERA (145.2 IP, 44 ER) in 23 games (22 starts) in home games...his 2.72 ERA at home is fifth best in the AL and 11th best in baseball since the beginning of last season...Berríos is 7-2 with a 2.99 ERA (78.1 IP, 26 ER) in 12 home starts in 2018...on June 24 against Texas, set a career high with 12 strikeouts over 7.0 innings, tied for second most by a Twins pitcher in Target Field history (Scott Baker, June 16, 2010 vs. COL)...all six of his 10+ strikeout games in his career have come at Target Field...on the road, Berríos is 8-13 with a 4.79 ERA (139.0 IP, 74 ER) in 25 starts since the beginning of 2017.

Santana is making his third start of the season after spending time on the 60-day DL recovering from surgery on his right thigh MCP joint...his last start was July 30 vs. CLE, did not factor into the decision after allowing four runs on six hits and two walks with a strikeout over 5.1 innings...will be making his 26th career start against Kansas City, is 7-10, 4.71 ERA (156.2 IP, 82 ER) lifetime...Santana was named 2017 AL All-Star and Twins Pitcher of the Year by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA.
