- ♦ RHP **Zack Godley** has not allowed a run in 3 Cactus League starts (8.2 IP) with just 4 hits allowed.
- ♦ RHP **Fernando Salas** has made 4 scoreless appearances with 2 hits given up.
- ♦ LHP **T.J. McFarland**, in 4 outings, has surrendered only 2 unearned runs (4.1 IP).
