SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Brett Kennedy** tallied a career-high four strikeouts in his third-career start and has worked 5.0 innings in back-to-back games...allowed just two runs (earned) in today's contest after surrendering 11 runs on 20 hits in his first two starts combined.
- **Hunter Renfro** belted his 14th homer of the season and has 18 RBI in his last 15 games since Aug. 4 at CHC...owns a .598 SLG percentage vs. ARI in his career (six doubles and nine HR)...his nine homers, 19 RBI and 18 hits against the D-Backs are the most he's accrued against any single team.
- **Eric Hosmer** extended his hitting streak to eight games, the longest active streak on the team (.367, 11-for-30)...has reached base via hit or walk in 24 of his last 25 games (.376 OBP) and has hit safely in 22 of his last 25 games (.316 BA).
- **Travis Jankowski** has three leadoff doubles in the past five games...is hitting .326 (14-for-43) with a .408 OBP (six walks) in 17 games in August.
- **Wil Myers** has gone 8-for-8 in stolen-base attempts this season...only Cody Bellinger (10) and Jurickson Profar (9) have more steals this year without being caught.

ARIZONA NOTES

- **Zack Greinke** has 2,401 career strikeouts, tying Dennis Eckersley for 44th on the all-time strikeout list...remains 7-3 with a 2.18 ERA (19 ER, 78.1 IP) over his last 12 starts and has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 11 of his 13 starts on the road...in 22 career games vs. the Padres, owns a 11-2 record with a 2.20 ERA (35 ER, 143.1 IP) and a .203 opponent average.
- **Paul Goldschmidt** reached base safely in 10 consecutive plate appearances (six hits, four walks) to set the club record...the last major league player to reach base safely in 10 consecutive plate appearances was Brandon Nimmo (NYM) from Aug. 14-16, 2018...has reached base in 25 straight games since July 23, the longest streak of his career.
 - Extended his hitting streak to 12 games, going 22-for-51 (.431) during that span.
- **David Peralta** launched his 23rd home run of the year...is batting .364 (16-for-44) with a double, a triple, six home runs and 11 RBI in his last 11 games since Aug. 6.
- **Daniel Descalso** hit his career-high 11th home run of the season, surpassing his previous career-high of 10 set in 2017...has reached base safely in 19 consecutive starts, going 17-for-57 (.298) with 20 walks over that time.
- **A.J. Pollock** recorded his first home run since July 31 vs. TEX...has logged multiple hits in back-to-back games for the fourth time this season.
- **Jeff Mathis** tallied his first three-hit game of the season, and first since July 24, 2017 vs. ATL.
