SD Notes

- The Padres have tallied at least four walks in each of their last five games...their 24 walks in that time entered the day as the most in the majors.
- **Joey Lucchesi** has worked at least 5.0 innings in five-straight starts, posting a 3.58 ERA (11 ER, 27.2 IP) and a .260 opponent clip in that time...has made 18 starts this season in which he's worked at least 5.0 innings, owning an 8-4 record in those outings.
- **Franmil Reyes** belted his 16th homer of the season and is riding a career-high-tying 10-game hitting streak (also: Aug. 25-Sept. 4)...has a .455 OBP and a .679 SLG in 25 games since Aug. 21...his .385 batting average in that time entered the day as the highest in MLB.
- **Hunter Renfro** has six extra-base hits in his last 11 games since Sept. 6...has hit safely in 19 of his last 23 games since Aug. 23, batting .277 (26-for-94) with a .606 SLG.
 - Is batting .333 (2-for-6) with two extra-base hits, one RBI and two walks in his career against Derek Holland.
- **Freddy Galvis** has hit in four consecutive games (.500, 8-for-16, 4 2B, 4 R)...recorded his third-ever game with four-or-more hits, his first since June 15 at ATL when he tallied a career-high five hits.

SF Notes

- **Derek Holland** allowed a season-high-tying four earned runs in tonight's contest (6x; last: Aug. 10 vs. PIT)...prior to tonight's outing, had surrendered two runs-or-fewer in 10 of his last 11 starts.
 - Has received three runs of support-or-fewer in 11 of his last 12 outings
- **Hunter Pence's** two-run, go-ahead homer in the second inning was measured at 437-feet, the fifth-longest by a Giants hitter this season, per Statscast.
 - Logged his fifth stolen base and third home run of the season, his first homer since Aug. 25 vs. TEX.
- **Aramis Garcia** extended his hitting streak to four games and has hit safely in eight of his first nine career games...in seven starts as a Giant, has gone 8-for-24 (.333) with two home runs and four RBI.
- **Chris Shaw** recorded his first career stolen base...has gone 6-for-10 (.600) with three RBI over his last three games.
