CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

JAVIER BÁEZ (4-for-5, HR, R, 2 RBI, SB) notched his third four-hit game of the season ... hit his 17th homer, tied with Kyle Schwarber for the team lead ... is batting .465 (20-for-43) with 12 RBI and 13 runs in his last 10 games ... leads the team with 26 multi-hit games.

VICTOR CARATINI (2-for-3, 2B, 2 R, RBI, BB) notched his fifth multi-hit game of the season and reached three times ... recorded his first hits since being recalled July 4.

ADDISON RUSSELL (2-for-3, 2B, 2 R, RBI, BB) is batting .342 (13-for-38) with eight runs scored and 12 RBI in his last 10 games.

ANTHONY RIZZO (0-for-4, RBI) collected his N.L.-best 11th game-winning RBI.

RANDY ROSARIO (2.1 IP, 2 H, 2 SO) tied a career-high with 2.1 innings pitched and also collected his first-career hit and RBI ... has a 1.000 OBP in two-career plate appearances (walk, single).

© Leads all Cubs relievers with four wins.

NOTES: The Cubs are a season-high tying 14 games over .500 ... snapped a five-game losing streak against the Reds.

© The Cubs have reached 50 wins prior to the All-Star Break for the seventh time in franchise history (last, 53-35 in 2016).

© The Cubs have come from behind in each of their last eight victories, the longest streak by a Cubs team since May 27-June 3, 2008 (eight).

© Ben Zobrist (2-for-5, 2B, R, 2 RBI) has reached safely in seven-straight games, going 8-for-23 with five walks, a hit-by-pitch and eight RBI during that span.

© Kyle Schwarber (1-for-4, R) has reached safely in seven-straight games, going 8-for-20 with five walks and seven runs scored in that span.

© Tyler Chatwood threw a career-high 120 pitches, the most pitches by a Cubs starter since May 7, 2017 (Jon Lester, 120 pitches) ... has allowed a season-high tying seven runs in consecutive starts.

© Brandon Morrow is the first Cubs pitcher with 20 saves prior to the All-Star Break since Kerry Wood in 2008 (24 saves).

CINCINNATI REDS NOTES

MATT HARVEY has allowed two or fewer earned runs in four-straight starts, posting a 1.88 ERA (5 ER/24.0 IP) ... is 4-3 with a 3.79 ERA (25 ER/59.1 IP) in 11 starts since joining the Reds.

EUGENIO SUÁREZ (2-for-3, HR, R, 3 RBI, 2 BB) hit a three-run homer in the third inning, giving him an N.L.-best 66 RBI this season ... extended his hitting streak to 10 games (.368/14-for-38), his second hitting streak of at least 10 games this season.

SCOOTER GENNETT (2-for-5, 2 R) has scored a run in six-straight and 13 of his last 15 games ... leads the N.L. with a .329 batting average.

JOEY VOTTO (2-for-4, 2B, 2 R, RBI, BB) is 11-for-26 with three doubles, one homer, eight runs scored and six RBI in his last seven games against the Cubs.

NOTES: The Reds dropped just their fifth game in their last 19 contests.

© Tied the Reds largest blown lead in a loss this season ... also led 7-2 against the White Sox, July 3, in a 12-8 setback.

© Billy Hamilton (3-for-4, R, 3 SB) has 18 stolen bases at Wrigley Field, the most all-time by a Reds player ... 19th career game with at least three steals ... has consecutive three-hit games for the fourth time in his career.
