### FISH BITES

The Marlins continue their final homestand before the All-Star break with the second of three games against the Milwaukee Brewers tonight at 7:10 p.m. RHP **Dan Straily**, making his 14th start of the season, has won each of his last four starts against the Brewers. In six career appearances, five starts, against the Brew Crew, he has gone 4-0 with a 2.12 ERA (34.0 ip/8 er). Milwaukee is countering with RHP Freddy Peralta, who is making his first career start against the Marlins. Miami just returned from a quick four-game road series against Washington at Nationals Park, and will continue this homestand with a three-game set against Philadelphia after Thursday's off-day.

### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami dropped game two of this three-game set against the Milwaukee Brewers by the score of 8-4. Down 1-0 after the first three outs, **Derek Dietrich** led off with a double and came around to score on a **Garrett Cooper** single. **JT Riddle** followed with an RBI-single to center to score **Starlin Castro** and give Miami a 2-1 advantage. It was a short lead, as Milwaukee answered with four runs in the top of the second. Dietrich cut the Marlins deficit to two with a sac fly in the second to score **Bryan Holaday**. **Brian Anderson** cut Milwaukee's lead to one in the fourth, driving in **Pablo López**, who led off the inning with a walk. López, making his third career start, took the loss, allowing five runs on six hits with three walks and career-high six strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

### WINNING

Miami has a 20-27 record at home this season, and has improved mightily after going 3-10 to start the season at Marlins Park. The Marlins have gone 9-6 in series openers at home this year, including wins in each of the last six home series, which has led to a 17-17 mark at home since April 28.

- Overall since June 5, the Marlins have gone 18-17, and are just two wins shy of equaling the Dodgers, Diamondbacks, Reds, and Phillies for the most wins in the NL in that span.

### VS. THE BREWERS

Milwaukee is out in front of the 2018 season series, 5-1, after sweeping the four-game set at Miller Park from April 19-22. The series marks the first played against Milwaukee at Marlins Park since May 9-11, 2016, when the two teams split a four game series. The 2017 series at Marlins Park was played in Milwaukee due to Hurricane Irma. The Marlins hold a 39-33 advantage in South Florida, which includes a 32-21 record since 2002. Miami, however, trails the all-time series, 70-76.

### UP NEXT

Following tomorrow's off-day, the Marlins will open up a three-game series against the Philadelphia Phillies Friday night at 7:10 p.m. The 2018 season series is knotted at 3-3 following 2-1 series wins by each team at their home ballparks: at Philadelphia from April 5-7 and in Miami from April 30-May 2. The Marlins hold a 109-102 advantage in South Florida, including a 31-28 mark at Marlins Park, yet trail the all-time series, 190-232.

### SOMETHING SPECIAL

With two hits last night, **Brian Anderson** upped his season total to 103, which leads all Major League rookies and ranks sixth overall in the National League. His 103 hits are the most by a rookie prior to the All-Star break since Corey Seager tallied 105 in 2016, and he is the only rookie in Marlins history to record 100+ hits prior to the break. Anderson has posted 22 doubles, the second-most by a Marlins rookie prior to the break (24-Mike Jacobs, 2006), and his 31 extra-base hits ranks as the fifth-most. He currently leads all qualifying Major League rookies in runs scored (51), hits, RBI (46), average (.285), and average with RISP (.402).

### CASTRO-LLING

**Starlin Castro** went 0x3 last night to snap his hitting streak at eight games. Castro has hit safely in 14 of his last 16, batting .438 (28x64) over that span to lead the Majors (min. 50 PA), and in that time he has raised his average from .267 to a current .297. He is one of just eight National League players with 100+ hits this season (109), joining Nick Markakis (115), Ozzie Albies (111), Freddie Freeman (108), Scooter Gennett (108), **Brian Anderson** (103), Nolan Arenado (100), and Trea Turner (100). He has recorded multiple hits in seven of his last nine games and has 31 multi-hit games on the season. His 31 multi-hit games are tied with Scooter Gennett for the fourth-most in the National League, behind Nick Markakis (38), Ozzie Albies (34), and Nolan Arenado (34).

### HEATING UP WITH SUMMER

Since May 28, Miami's offense has hit at a .266 clip (398x1494) with 184 runs scored. The 398 hits lead all Major League clubs in that time, ahead of the Red Sox (388), Cubs (379), Reds (377), and Rockies (369). The Marlins average in that time ranks fourth in the NL (sixth in MLB), behind the Reds (.280), Rockies (.277), and Cubs (.273).

### RIDDLING ALONG

With another hit last night, **JT Riddle** extended his current hitting streak to a season-high six games (.379; 11x29). He has hit in nine of his last 11 games, batting .370 (17x46) with a double, two triples, two home runs and nine RBI over that span. He is two games shy of matching a career-best eight-game hitting streak done from July 2-9, 2017.

### PUSHING THE LIMITS

The Marlins are playing the final game in a stretch of 20 consecutive games between off-days. During the stretch, Miami will have faced off against two first-place teams (Arizona and Milwaukee), and will have played five of six series against teams with .500-or-better records. Prior to their last homestand, Miami finished a run that saw them play 25 of 35 games on the road. On June 25 they started a stretch where 15 of 22 games would be at home.

### HOT-DOGGING

Fans are invited to bring their pups to Marlins Park to celebrate the annual Bark at the Park, presented by Tito's Handmade Vodka, on July 14. In addition, fans and their beloved guests will have access to the field at Marlins Park for the pregame Pup Parade. Ticket packages are available at [Marlins.com/BarkAtThePark](http://Marlins.com/BarkAtThePark), and a portion of the proceeds from each ticket package will support the Humane Society of Broward County. Additional activations, presented by Tito's Handmade Vodka, include: dog kissing photo booth, bandana giveaway for dogs and their owners, and a dog ice sculpture drinking station. On Sunday, July 15, the Marlins will also host their seventh annual Adopt-O-Mania, in partnership with Miami-Dade Animal Services, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. at Marlins Park. A variety of adorable dogs and cats will be available and ready to be recruited into loving forever homes. Adoption fees will be discounted by 50 percent for dogs over four months, and all cats and kittens are FREE. All pets adopted are spayed/neutered, microchipped and vaccinated. The first 100 guests to adopt a dog will receive two vouchers for a complimentary ticket to any Marlins game between July 15 and August 12.

- Since the start of 2016, **Justin Bour** is batting .354 (23x65) in 17 G vs. Brewers, with five doubles, three home runs, 15 RBI; has a hit in 15 of those games. Marks the fifth-highest average against Milwaukee in that span (min. 50 PA) behind Miguel Montero (.391), Jon Jay (.377), Gerardo Parra (.375), and Jesse Winker (.356).
- **Derek Dietrich** is batting .321 (25x78) over last 21 games against the Brewers, with four doubles, three triples, four home runs, 11 RBI, and five HBP.
- **Martín Prado** has hit in 11 of his last 13 games against the Brewers, batting .420 (21x50) over that span. He has recorded multi-hit efforts in each of his last three starts and eight of those 11 games.

## THIS DAY IN MARLINS HISTORY

### JULY 11

Dontrelle Willis struck out seven Mets over 6.1 innings and picked up his seventh win, while Armando Benitez notched his 30th save, in a 5-2 win at Pro Player Stadium in 2004. Jeff Conine drove in four of the Marlins' runs with a two-out grand slam in the fourth off former teammate Al Leiter. In 1995, Jeff Conine went 1x1 as a pinch-hitter in the 66th MLB All-Star Game at The Ballpark in Arlington and also earned the MVP title for the game.

- Dan Straily will make his 14th start of the season in the finale of this three-game series tonight.
- He is 4-0 with a 2.12 ERA in six appearances (five starts) against the Brewers in his career, with a .216 average against (27x125) and 28 strikeouts to just five walks.
- Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 16 of his last 17 starts against NL Central opponents, dating back to July 17, 2016. Has a 7-4 record and 3.30 ERA (101.0 ip/37 er) in that time.
- Is 2-1 (team 3-3) in six home starts this season, despite a 5.52 ERA (31.0/19); that is in contrast to a 3.67 ERA (34.1/14) in seven road starts, in which he has gone 1-3 (team 3-4).
- Snapped a personal three-game losing streak, and a 0-5 skid by the team in his starts, on June 25 vs. Arizona. Picked up win after tossing 6.1 innings (most since 7.0 on May 18 at ATL) and allowing three runs on four hits and a hit batter, with six strikeouts.
- Miami won his first five starts this season; he went 2-0, 3.12 (26.0/9) in that time, with a .204 (19x93) average against. Since then, Marlins have lost seven of his eight outings, and he is 1-4, 5.49 (39.1/24) over that span, with a .258 (39x151) average against.
- Is striking out 7.30 batters per 9.0 innings this season, down from 8.42 in 2017. Is also walking 4.41 batters per 9.0 this year, up from 2.97 and 3.43 the last two years, respectively. Has sixth-highest BB/9.0 rate of NL starters this season (min. 13 GS).
- He made four Spring Training starts, going 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (14.0 ip/2 er), before being shut down with right forearm inflammation on March 20.
- Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, going 1-1 with 8.22 ERA (7.2/7). Allowed seven runs (six earned) and five hits over 2.2 innings in first start, April 13 at Daytona. Limited Lakeland to one run and six hits over 5.0 frames on April 18. Transferred to Double-A Jacksonville and made 5.1-inning start on April 24 at Tennessee, allowing four runs (three earned) on six hits with a walk and six strikeouts.
- Last season, set career highs in starts (33) and strikeouts (170), leading the starting rotation in starts, strikeouts, and innings pitched (181.2).
- He went 5-3 with a 3.57 ERA (90.2 ip/36 er) in 17 starts at home, and 5-6, 4.95 (91.0/50) in 16 starts on the road.
- Was one of just seven NL starters to make 17-plus starts at home, tied with four others for the second-highest total, behind R.A. Dickey, Zack Greinke, and Jon Lester (18 each). Among that group, only Greinke (2.87) and Patrick Corbin (3.15) had a lower home ERA.
- Struck out nine batters on September 24 at Arizona, setting a new single-season career high. He finished the game with 167 strikeouts, surpassing his previous high of 162, set in 2016 with Cincinnati.
- Had one of the best starts of his career on July 7 at San Francisco. He set a career high with 8.1 innings pitched in picking up his seventh victory of the season. Allowed just four hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out four. He allowed just one run, a solo home run to Denard Span, the final batter he faced. From the second out of the second inning until there were two outs in the seventh, he set a new career high by retiring 16 consecutive batters, according to *Stats LLC*. It surpassed his previous high of 14, which he set over his first two starts of 2017 (April 22-29).
- In his start on July 19 vs. Philadelphia, he issued three walks. It snapped a streak of nine consecutive starts with one or zero walks, which tied Justin Nicolino (2016) for the second-longest such streak within one season in Club history, trailing Ricky Nolasco, who did so in his final 12 starts of 2008 (overall streak reached 13).
