**STORMIN' IN CINCY:** The Padres defeated the Cincinnati Reds 6-2 last night in Game 1 of the four-game set...the Friars have now won six of the last seven road games to open a series since July 23...**Eric Lauer** worked 4.0 innings and allowed just two hits on a career-high tying eight strikeouts...he walked three and did not allow a single run to score...**Wil Myers** went 2-for-4 with a double, and **Hunter Renfroe** hit his club-tying 20th home run of the season...Renfroe is chasing his career high of 26, set last season.

**YOU COULD SAY THAT BRETT IS SET:** Starter **Brett Kennedy** is set to make his first-career start against the Reds...he's coming off his first Major League victory on August 31 vs. COL, tossing 6.0-shutout innings in the Padres' 7-0 win...the 24-year-old rookie has posted a 2.81 ERA in his last three outings, going 1-0 with a .250 opponent clip and a .348 opponent slugging percentage.

**NOTHING MEH ABOUT MEJÍA:** Last night, **Francisco Mejía** hit his first career Major League home run in the top of the third inning and his second HR in the top of the fourth...he became the second Padre in club history to homer in two of his first three at-bats with the team (also: Seth Smith, who hit two HR from March 30-April 1, 2014), and he's the first Padre to ever hit a home run in his first two at-bats in his first start with SD...in the last 10 years, he's now one of just four players to homer in each of his first two at-bats in his first start with a team.

**SEEING RED:** The Padres have won three straight games against CIN since June 2, and their winning streak follows three-straight losses to CIN from Aug 9, 2017-June 1, 2018...they've gone 3-1 vs. the Redlegs this year, and the SD has a 7-4 record against them since the start of 2017...since 2017, the Friars have scored an average of 5.18 runs per game vs. CIN, which are their most against any single opponent in that time.

**POWER HUNGRY:** **Hunter Renfroe** has gone 11.62 at bats per homer since the All-Star break, which is the best mark on the Padres and the fifth-best in the majors...owns a team-leading .872 OPS in the second half of the season.

**GOING DEEP IN SEPTEMBER:** The Friars have hit 1.40 homers per game in the month of September, which is tied with LAD for the third-highest rate this month of any NL team (behind COL's 2.00 and STL's 1.80).

**28TH:** Since August 28, Padres starters have owned a 2.45 ERA (14 er, 51.1 ip) with a .202 average and a just two homers allowed (0.35 hr/9 ip).

**YOU CAN FIND ME IN THE TRENCHES:** The Padres bullpen has a 3.15 ERA since the break, the best mark in the NL and second-best in the majors (OAK's 2.77 ERA)...in that time, the SD bullpen has an NL-leading 10.92 so/9 ip (206 strikeouts in total).

**OUTS ABOVE AVERAGE:** The Padres have made 10 outs above average this season, which ranks eighth in the majors and sixth in the NL, just below CIN's 13.

**PADRES ON DECK:** Tonight, the Padres two minor league teams in post-season play face elimination...despite a 4-for-5, three-RBI game from San Diego State product **Ty France**, El Paso (AAA) lost to Fresno at Southwest University Park, falling to 0-2 in the best-of-five Pacific Coast League Pacific Conference finals...San Antonio (AA) lost a second straight game at Corpus Christi Thursday to drop to 0-2 in the best-of-five Texas League Southern Division finals...last night, C **Austin Allen's** solo homer in the ninth was the only run the Missions have scored in two games.

**STARTING PITCHER NOTES**

**#60 RHP Brett Kennedy (1-2, 5.76)**

**HE'S A KENNEDY:** In Game 2 of this four-game set, 24-year-old RHP **Brett Kennedy** is set to make his fifth-career start and first against the Cincinnati Reds here at Great American Ball Park.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his first career win in his last outing on 8/31 vs. COL, tossing 6.0-shutout IP in the Padres' 7-0 victory...his win came one game after rookie **Robert Stock** was credited with the win, and the duo became the first Padre rookies to record their first ML wins in back-to-back games since Clay Condrey and Doug Nickle (Aug. 31-Sept. 1, 2002).

**BRETT'S ARSENAL:** In his five starts, he's relied on three pitches: four seamer (65.8%), slider (25.3%), and changeup (8.9%)...opponents have hit just .182 against his changeup so far.

**LAST THREE:** Brett has posted a 2.81 ERA in his last three outings, going 1-0 with a .250 opponent clip and a .348 opponent slugging percentage.

**GET TO 5.0:** Kennedy has worked 5.0-or-more innings in four-straight starts...he has received more than one run of support in a game in which he's worked 5.0+ innings just once (Aug. 19 vs. ARI).

**BACK ME UP:** Has received just six runs of support in his five starts this season...his 2.16 run support average is the third-lowest among all ML pitchers who've made at least five starts.

**ROOKIE ROUNDUP:** The Padres have seen 55 starts this season by rookies (22 by **Joey Lucchesi**, 20 by **Eric Lauer**, five by **Kennedy** and **Jacob Nix** and three by **Walker Lockett**)...those 55 starts by rookies are third-most of any team this year, trailing MIA (62) and TB (58)...the Padre record for starts by rookies in a season was when they had 82 in 1969.

**EXIT VELO:** Through his first five appearances, opponents have an 84.6 mph exit velocity against him...the Major League average is 87.3 mph.

**CHASING DREAMS/PITCHES:** Kennedy has induced a 27.6 chase percentage in his first five starts...the ML average for a hurler's chase percentage is 28.2.

**#60:** Kennedy is the fifth Padre to ever wear the number 60...he joins Cory Mazzoni (2017), Dillon Overton (2017), Frank Garces (2014-2015) and Kip Wells (2012).

**IN HIS DEBUT:** In his Major League debut on August 8 @ MIL, he was saddled with the loss after working 4.0 innings and allowing six runs (earned) on 11 hits with three strikeouts...five of the six runs he allowed came in the first inning, however, and after the Brewers put a five-spot on the scoreboard in the first, Kennedy proceeded to hold the Brewers to just one run on two strikeouts in his last 3.0 innings.

**HISTORICALLY SPEAKING:** Before Kennedy gave up three-consecutive homers in the first inning of his debut on Aug. 8 @ MIL, no Padres pitcher had ever done so in his ML debut...he also became the first pitcher in the Modern Era (since 1900) to give up back-to-back-to-back homers in the first inning of his debut.

**DEBUT TIME:** Kennedy had his contract selected from El Paso (AAA) on Aug. 7, and become the 12th Padre to make their ML Debut this season and the fourth to do so as a starting pitcher...fellow righty **Jacob Nix** made his debut two games later on Aug. 10 vs. PHI.

**UN-BRETT-FEATED:** Made 16 starts for El Paso (AAA) this season, going 10-0 with a 2.72 ERA (27 ER, 89.1 IP), striking out 80 and walking 23 while limiting opposing hitters to a .233 average...earned Mid-Season Pacific Coast League honors.

**DIGGING DEEPER:** At the time the Padres selected his contract, Kennedy ranked first among the Pacific Coast League Southern Division-leading El Paso staff in ERA (2.72), wins (10) and ranked second behind only RHP **Walker Lockett** in innings pitched (89.1), games started (16) and strikeouts (80)...allowed just six HR this season, one of just eight pitchers to have tossed at least 89.0 IP and allowed six home runs or fewer in the homer-friendly Pacific Coast League.

**PUMPING OUT WINS:** The Chihuahuas won each of Kennedy's final eight starts from June 19 to August 1, with Brett getting the winning decision in seven of those outings...over the stretch, he was 7-0 with a 2.47 ERA (13 ER, 47.1 IP) with .226 opponent average.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER — #41 LHP Robbie Erlin (3-5, 3.87) — robbie\_erlin **

**ARE YOU READY TO ROBBIE:** LHP **Robbie Erlin** is set to make his ninth start of the season (36th appearance overall) and the 34th start of his career in Game 3 of the four-game set here at Great American Ball Park.

- Tomorrow will mark just his first career start and second appearance against the Redlegs.
- This year, he's relied on five pitches: sinker (31.2%), four seamer (29.7%), curve (18.9%), changeup (17%) and slider (3.3%).
- Has been saddled with the loss in consecutive starts for the first time since April 12-17, 2016.
