TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians have acquired outfielder **LEONYS MARTIN** from the Detroit Tigers...Martin is batting .251 (76-303) this season, and he is tied for the American League lead with nine outfield assists.

» Cleveland leads the Majors in a number of categories this July, including runs scored (147), extra-base hits (95), stolen bases (25), team OPS (.840) and home runs (36, T1st).

» The Tribe holds a 30-15 record against the A.L. Central this season, posting a 2.78 ERA (125ER/405.0IP) that ranks as the lowest intradivisional mark in MLB.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** enters play tonight tied for the MLB lead in home runs...his 32 longballs are already T4th in franchise history among third basemen, and he is the first player to reach 32 homers before August since **Jim Thome** hit 33 in 2001.

» **TREVOR BAUER** has fanned seven-or-more batters in 12 straight starts, tied with **Sam McDowell** for the 2nd-longest streak in club history behind **COREY KLUBER** (14 starts, 2017)...with eight punchouts tonight, Bauer would become the first Tribe pitcher to reach 200 strikeouts before August 1 since **McDowell** in 1970.

DEADLINE DEAL

» Cleveland today acquired **OF LEONYS MARTIN** and **RHP KYLE DOWDY** from Detroit in exchange for **INF WILLI CASTRO**.

» Martin, 30, has hit .251 (76-303) with nine homers, 15 doubles and 29 RBI in his first season with the Tigers...his nine outfield assists are tied with Seattle's **Mitch Haniger** for the most in the American League this year, while his 59 outfield assists since 2013 are tied with **Gerardo Parra** for 2nd-most in MLB over that span (**Starling Marte** - 60).

» Across eight Major League seasons with Texas, Seattle, Chicago-NL and Detroit, Martin has batted .248 with 47 homers, 87 doubles, 22 triples, 205 RBI and 299 runs scored.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians dropped their series opener at Target Field last night, falling 5-4 to the Twins in walk-off fashion.

» Five of the Indians' nine hits went for extra bases, including three home runs...**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** snapped an 0-for-16 slide with a solo homer in the top of the 1st inning, and later tied the game at 2-2 with another solo shot in the top of the 4th inning...marked his 3rd multi-homer game of the season and the 12th by an Indians batter.

» **YAN GOMES** (1-4) also homered for Cleveland (solo), briefly giving the Tribe a 3-2 lead in the top of the 5th inning...**YONDER ALONSO** was 1-for-4 with a game-tying RBI-double in the 6th inning, while **FRANCISCO LINDOR** went 1-for-4 with a triple and a stolen base.

» **SHANE BIEBER** did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs (three earned) on six hits over 6.1 innings of work, with two walks and seven strikeouts...Bieber has walked two-or-fewer batters in each of his first nine career starts, tying **Eric Raich** (1975) for the second-longest streak by an Indians pitcher to open his career in the *Baseball-Reference* Play Index era (1908-)...Bieber now only trails **Cody Anderson** (first 12 starts in 2015).

TWIN BILLING

» The Indians are playing their fourth of six series against the Minnesota Twins, as well as their last at Target Field this season.

» The clubs most recently met June 15-17 at Progressive Field, when Minnesota claimed two of three games...the Twins took three of four contests from May 31-June 3 in the teams' only previous matchup in Minnesota this season.

» Overall, the Indians own a 3-7 record vs. the Twins this season, going 1-2 at Progressive Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 1-4 at Target Field...the Tribe is at least five games over .500 against every other team in the A.L. Central division.

CENTRAL DOMINANCE

» Cleveland has gone 30-15 against the A.L. Central, with a record of 9-3-2 in series play...the Indians' .667 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 2nd in the A.L. and MLB (Boston - .702)...the Tribe has gone 18-4 in divisional home games and 12-11 on the road.

» In 45 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers have posted a 2.78 ERA (125ER/405.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in Major League Baseball.

» **MV Scrappers (Short-A): 26-15, 1st (+4.0G)** » 7/30: L, 1-4 vs. Williamsport » Today: 7:05 vs. Williamsport
Zach Draper (ND) allowed one run over 6.0 innings (5H, 1BB, 3K)...Henry Pujols went 3-for-4 with a solo homer.

ON THE BAUER PLAY

» Right-hander **TREVOR BAUER** is set to make his second start this season against the Minnesota Twins, following an outing on June 2 at Target Field...took the loss after allowing seven runs (three earned) on six hits over 5.2 innings (3BB, 11K).

» **Bauer has posted a 2-0 record with a 1.87 ERA (7ER/33.2IP) in five July starts...enters play with the 2nd-lowest ERA in the A.L. (min. 30.0IP) this month (HOU's Dallas Keuchel - 1.65).**

» **Bauer owns a 6-3 record with a 2.06 ERA (16ER/70.0IP) in 10 starts vs. the A.L. Central this season...marks the 2nd-lowest ERA vs. the division (min. 50.0IP) behind teammate COREY KLUBER (1.62 ERA).**

» He enters play with a 4-5 record and a 2.64 ERA (21ER/71.2IP) in 11 road starts, good for the 5th-lowest road ERA in the American League...his 2.32 overall ERA (38ER/147.1IP) currently ranks 4th-lowest in the A.L.

» **Bauer sits 3rd in the American League with 192 strikeouts this season, fanning 10-or-more in nine starts (2nd-most in A.L.)...with eight strikeouts tonight, Bauer would become the first Indians pitcher to reach 200 strikeouts before August 1 since Sam McDowell had 210 through July in 1970.**

» Has fanned seven-or-more batters in 12 straight starts, tied with **McDowell** (1965-66) for the 2nd-longest streak in franchise history...**COREY KLUBER** recorded a club-record 14 straight starts from June 1-August 13, 2017.

TWICE AS NICE

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** notched his third multi-homer game of the season last night, moving him into a tie with Boston's **J.D. Martinez** for the Major League home run lead.

» Ramírez already ranks T4th in franchise history for home runs by a third baseman with **Brook Jacoby** (1987) and **Matt Williams** (1997)...with 57 games remaining, he trails **Al Rosen** in 1953 (47 HR), **Jim Thome** in 1996 (38 HR) and **Rosen** in 1950 (37 HR).

» He is also just the third different Indians player to belt 32-or-more homers by the end of August, along with **Albert Belle** (35 in 1994, 36 in 1996) and **Jim Thome** (33 in 2001).

» 16 of Ramírez's 32 home runs have either tied the game or given Cleveland the lead, tied with PHI's **Rhys Hoskins** and ARI's **Paul Goldschmidt** for the MLB lead...Ramírez has also hit 11 homers in the 1st inning this season, tied with COL's **Nolan Arenado** for the MLB lead and matching **Al Rosen** (1953) for the franchise single-season record.

SCORE TACTICS

» **The Tribe leads the Majors in the month of July in runs scored (147), steals (25), team OPS (.840), runs per game (6.13), extra-base hits (95) and home runs (36, T1st).**

» Cleveland also ranks 2nd in team batting average (.283), 2nd in team slugging percentage (.490), 2nd in on-base percentage (.350) and T2nd in doubles (52) this month.

» Overall this season, the Tribe's 541 runs scored are 2nd-most in MLB (BOS - 571)...they additionally sit 2nd with 150 home runs (NYY - 167), 2nd with 83 stolen bases (MIL - 84), 3rd with 371 extra-base hits and 3rd with a .259 team batting average.

THE BASE KEEPS RUNNING

» The Indians have stolen two-or-more bases in 23 games this season and swiped at least three bags in 10 contests, both of which lead MLB...the Tribe's 83 steals overall are 2nd in MLB (MIL - 84).

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** leads the Indians and ranks 2nd in the A.L. with 24 stolen bases...**FRANCISCO LINDOR** and **RAJAI DAVIS** are T10th with 16 steals each, and Cleveland is the only team in MLB boasting three players in their respective league's Top 10.

MISC. HITTING NOTES

» **YONDER ALONSO** has driven in 21 runs this July, T5th-most in the American League (**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** is 2nd with 23 RBI).

» **MELKY CABRERA** has hit safely in all eight of his starts since being recalled on July 20, batting .400 (12-30) in his second stint with Cleveland with a homer, two doubles and three runs scored.

» Yesterday marked Cleveland's 47th game with multiple homers, 2nd-most in MLB (NYY - 48)...the Tribe's 20 games with three-or-more homers are tied with Oakland for 2nd-most in MLB (NYY - 24).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

2010: The Indians participate in a three-team trade with San Diego and St. Louis that nets them eventual ace **Corey Kluber**...Cleveland sent veteran right-hander **Jake Westbrook** to the Cardinals and received Kluber from the Padres...Kluber would make his MLB debut for the Tribe just over a year later on September 1, 2011, and has earned two Cy Young Awards and 89 Major League wins in an Indians uniform.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 27-year-old right-hander is due to make his 23rd start of the season in the middle contest of this three-tilt set against the Twins in Minnesota...will mark his 155th career appearance and 146th start.

» Will be pitching on regular four days' rest after his last start on July 25 vs. Pittsburgh...earned his ninth win of the season (7.0IP, 2H, 2BB, 10K).

» Marked his ninth start this season with 10-or-more strikeouts, the 3rd-most such starts in MLB (**Max Scherzer** - 11, **Chris Sale** - 10).

» Bauer is due to start against the Twins for the second time this season...last faced Minnesota on June 2 at Target Field (L, 5.2IP, 7H, 7R/3ER, 1HR, 3BB, 11K).

» He has compiled a 6-3 record and 2.06 ERA (16ER/70.0IP) in 10 starts vs. the A.L. Central this season...his **89 strikeouts vs. the Central are the 2nd-most by any pitcher against a single division this season** (**Gerrit Cole** - 106K vs. A.L. West).

» **Bauer has struck out seven-or-more batters in each of his last 12 starts, which is tied with Sam McDowell (12GS, September 14, 1965-May 17, 1966) for the 2nd-longest such run in franchise history, behind COREY KLUBER's 14-start streak (June 1-August 13, 2017).**

» Entering tonight's game, ranks among the American League pitching leaders in innings pitched (147.1, 2nd), strikeouts (192, 3rd), strikeouts-per-9.0IP (11.7, 3rd), ERA (2.32, 4th), night ERA (2.31, 4th) and opponent batting average (.212, 6th).

VS. MINNESOTA | A.L. CENTRAL

» Bauer is due to face the Twins for the second time this year...owns a career 4-7 record and 4.84 ERA (52ER/96.2IP) in 17 appearances (16 starts) vs. Minnesota, including a 2-2 mark and 4.46 ERA (21ER/42.1IP) in eight outings (seven starts) at Target Field.

» Last faced Minnesota on June 2 at Target Field...took the loss, allowing seven runs (three earned) on seven hits (one home run), with three walks and 11 strikeouts in 5.2 innings...**start was the second outing in his streak of four consecutive starts with 10-or-more strikeouts**...also marked the 11th start of 5.2-or-fewer innings and 10-or-more strikeouts by an Indians pitcher in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-).

» Bauer is due to make his 11th start vs. the A.L. Central this season...**has compiled a 6-3 record and 2.06 ERA (16ER/70.0IP) in his 10 starts so far against the division.**

» **His 89 strikeouts vs. the Central are the 2nd-most by any pitcher against a single division this year, behind Houston's Gerrit Cole (106K vs. the A.L. West).**

ROAD WARRIOR

» Tonight marks Bauer's 12th road outing of the season...enters tonight with a 4-5 record and 2.64 ERA (21ER/71.2IP) in his prior road starts...his **2.64 road ERA ranks 6th in the A.L. and 10th in MLB entering play tonight.**

» Did not factor into the decision in his last road start on July 20 at Texas...allowed four runs on nine hits, with five walks and seven strikeouts, in the Tribe's 9-8 win.

» Bauer owns a career record of 24-26 with a 3.95 ERA (170ER/387.0IP) in 72 road appearances (67 starts).

A HALF TO REMEMBER

» Bauer has had a dominant start to the season, etching his name into the Indians record books in the first half...**he posted a 2.24 ERA in the first half, which marks the 5th-lowest first-half ERA by an Indians pitcher since 1969.**

» Recorded 175 strikeouts in the first half, which is the 3rd-most by an Indians pitcher in the first half of the season, behind **Bob Feller** (19th in 1946) and **Sam McDowell** (183 in 1970)...also enters tonight 3rd in the A.L. (4th in MLB) in strikeouts.

» Bauer also averaged 11.55 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP in the first half, which is the 2nd-highest rate by an Indians pitcher in the first half of the campaign (min. 80.0IP), behind **COREY KLUBER** (11.86 in 2017).

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS | 2018 RECAP

» **Bauer was named to his first career All-Star team this year, representing the Indians on the American League squad on Tuesday night in Washington, D.C.... did not pitch in the A.L.'s 8-6 win over the National League.**

» **From June 8 - July 10, Bauer recorded a streak of seven consecutive quality start with eight-or-more strikeouts and not home runs allowed, which represented the 2nd-longest such streak in the live ball era (1920-), behind Pedro Martínez's run of eight starts from July 1 - August 10, 2002 (STATS LLC).**

» Bauer also struck out eight-or-more batters in nine consecutive starts from May 27-July 10, a career-long run for Bauer and the longest such run by an Indians pitcher since **COREY KLUBER's** 14-start streak from June 1-Aug. 1, 2017.

» Bauer finished the month of June with a 2.18 ERA (10ER/41.1IP), **marking his 3rd-lowest ERA in a single month in his career (min. 4GS), behind March/April 2015 (1.80 ERA) and June 2016 (2.01 ERA)....he also led MLB with 62 strikeouts in June.**

» **He has struck out 10-or-more batters in nine starts this season, which is the 3rd-most such starts in MLB, behind Washington's Max Scherzer (11) and Boston's Chris Sale (10).**

» Has made quality starts in 17 of his 22 starts, the 2nd-most on the club (**COREY KLUBER** - 18) and tied for 4th-most in MLB.

» Bauer has thrown 100-or-more pitches in each of his 22 starts so far this season, which is the longest such streak of his career and the longest active run in MLB...**streak is also the longest streak of consecutive starts with 100-plus pitches by an Indians pitcher since 1988, the most recent year that Baseball Reference has accurate pitch count data available...streak marks the longest such run in MLB since Tampa Bay's Chris Archer had a 24-game run from August 12, 2016 - June 16, 2017.**

» Recorded a streak of 10-or-more strikeouts in four consecutive starts from May 27 to June 13...streak the longest such run in MLB this season...**marked just the third pitcher in Indians franchise history to record a streak of four-or-more starts with 10-or-more strikeouts, joining teammate COREY KLUBER (two streaks of five starts in 2017) and Hall-of-Famer Bob Feller (one streak of four starts from 1938-39).**

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his sixth season with the Indians organization after being acquired from the Arizona Diamondbacks on December 11, 2012, along with RHP Matt Albers, RHP Bryan Shaw (from Arizona) & Drew Stubbs (from Cincinnati), in a 3-team trade...at time of trade, was ranked as Arizona's No. 1 prospect by *Baseball America* and had just earned Dbacks Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.

» Made his Major League debut with Arizona on June 28, 2012, becoming the first player from the 2011 Draft Class to reach the Majors...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings of work.

» **In 2017, recorded his best Major League season to date in the Tribe rotation, posting career-highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196) and innings pitched (176.1), while recording his lowest full-season ERA (4.19).**

» The 2018 season marks his eighth overall in professional baseball after being selected by Arizona in the first round of the 2011 draft out of UCLA, where he went 38-4 with a 2.36 ERA across three seasons for the Bruins...finished his college career holding a number of school records, including a Pac-10 record with 203 strikeouts in 2011.

» The Southern California native graduated from Hart High School in Santa Clarita, the same HS that produced Kevin Millar, James Shields, Bob Walk and Todd Zeile.
