#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have won eight of their last 13 games, 14 of 22 and 19 of 33 as they continue a 10-game, 11-day homestand tonight with the series opener vs. the Angels.
- LHP Carlos Rodón, who has allowed two earned runs or less in eight of his last 10 starts, is scheduled to start for Chicago.
- The Sox are 3-4 on the homestand, losing two of three vs. Detroit and splitting a four-game series vs. Boston.
- Following this three-game weekend series vs. the Angels, the Sox will take a nine-game, 11-day trip to Kansas City (8/10-12), Baltimore (8/14-16) and Cleveland (8/18-20).
- The Sox went 5-2 on their last trip to Detroit (3-1) and New York-AL (2-1) from 8/23-29, including their first series win at Yankee Stadium since 2005.

#### **TONIGHT'S STORYLINES**

- The White Sox are coming off their first off day since 8/16. they played on 20 consecutive days from 8/21-9/5 (12-8 record).

  Chicago is looking to win just its second season series vs. Los
- Angeles-AL since 2011 (1-6 season mark during that span).
- The White Sox own a 3.56 ERA (46 ER/116.1 IP) over the last 13 games since 8/24, the fifth-best mark in the American League starters have posted a 3.27 ERA (26 ER/71.2 IP) in that span
- Carlos Rodón is 5-1 with a 2.19 ERA (17 ER/70.0 IP), .159 opp. average and 0.96 WHIP in his last 10 starts (nine QS).
- Yolmer Sánchez has reached base safely in 22 of his last 23 games, going 25-87 (.287) with five doubles, one home run, four RBI and a .398 on-base percentage.

### **WEDNESDAY'S RECAP**

- Detroit hit four home runs off White Sox starter Michael Kopech and scored the first 10 runs of the game in its 10-2 win.
- Jeimer Candelario opened the game with a home run, and the Tigers scored six runs in the third, highlighted by homers from Mikie Mahtook, Ronny Rodriguez and JaCoby Jones.
- Kopech suffered his first career loss after allowing seven runs on nine hits with one walk and six strikeouts over 3.1 IP ... José Ruiz worked 1.1 scoreless IP in his White Sox debut
- Kevan Smith (2-3) recorded the Sox only multihit effort ... Yolmer Sánchez had his 22-game, on-base streak snapped.
- $\bullet\,$  The game was delayed twice by rain (28 minutes in the third and 33 minutes in the fifth), the third Kopech start in Chicago to involve a rain delay ... the Sox finished 7-12 vs. Detroit in 2018.

#### **RODÓN ON A ROLL**

- Carlos Rodón is 5-1 with a 2.19 ERA (17 ER/70.0 IP), .159 opp. average and 0.96 WHIP in his last 10 starts (nine QS) ... his 2.19 ERA during that span is the lowest in the American League.
- Rodón's streak of nine straight quality starts while allowing five hits or less from 7/5-8/27 was the longest such streak by a White Sox pitcher since at least 1908 (Baseball Reference).

- White Sox Spanish radio play-by-play broadcaster Héctor Molina tonight will be honored as the Budweiser Hero of the Game for Hispanic Heritage Night.
- Molina, who has called games in Spanish for the Sox, Chicago Bears and Chicago Bulls for nearly 30 years, served as a radio operator for an Army infantry unit during the Vietnam War.
- Former Chicago Bears offensive lineman and member of the Latin American International Sports Hall of Fame Roberto Garza will throw the ceremonial first pitch.

#### JONES ON ASSIGNMENT

 The White Sox have sent RHP Nate Jones to Class A Winston-Salem on an injury rehab assignment ... Jones, 32, was placed on the 10-day disabled list on 6/13 with a pronator strain in his right arm and transferred to the 60-day disabled list on 9/1.

#### **RACE FOR THE PRIZE**

- Class A Winston-Salem last night fell to Buies Creek, 3-1, and trail, 2-0, in the Carolina League semifinals ... Lincoln Henzman received a ND despite allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 IP.
- RHP Kyle Kubat, who is 6-3 with a 3.55 ERA (36 ER/91.1 IP) in 32 games (nine starts) with the Dash, is scheduled to start tonight's elimination contest
- Class A Kannapolis suffered a 4-2 loss to Lakewood on Wednesday in Game 1 of the best-of-three, South Atlantic League semis ... LHP Parker Reigler (6-9, 4.43) will start Game 2 tonight.
- Advanced Rookie Great Falls tonight will open the Pioneer League best-of-three semifinals at Billings.

#### WHITE SOX VS. LOS ANGELES ANGELS

- The White Sox are 2-2 vs. the Angels this season despite being outscored by a 28-20 margin.
- The Sox are hitting .231/.307/.470 with nine home runs, own a 7.41 ERA (28 ER/34.0 IP) and have made two quality starts.
- Chicago has won five of the last eight games but are 5-10 in the last 15 ... the club is 9-3 over the last 12 games at Guaranteed Rate Field, compared to 3-16 in the last 19 at Angel Stadium.
- The Sox went 3-4 vs. Los Angeles-AL in 2017 (3-1 at home). • Chicago has lost six of the last seven season series dating back to 2011 ... 2015 marked the only victory (4-3).
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 363-370 ... they are 194-169 at home (68-58 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 169-201 on the road (147-178 at Angel Stadium).

#### WINNING WAYS

- The White Sox have gone 14-8 (.636) since 8/14, the sixth-best record in the majors and third-best in the American League.
- The Sox are 19-14 since 8/2, moving from 9.0 games behind Detroit to within one game of the Tigers in the AL Central.
- Chicago is 23-22 in the second half, including a 17-12 mark in August, its most wins in a month since May 2012 (18-11) ... the club is 9-6 since José Abreu was placed on the DL on 8/22.

#### WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox are 10-21 vs. the American League West in 2018, going 6-8 at home and 4-13 on the road ... they have been outscored, 78-56, in the 14 road games.
- The Sox have lost eight of the last 11 games, 10 of the last 14 and 15 of the last 24 ... the White Sox have won consecutive games vs. the division just twice this season.
- Chicago has lost 13 of 17 games and 19 of 26 on the road ... the club has allowed seven-plus runs 14 times in the last 26.
- The Sox are 188-175 vs. the West since 2008 (80-102 on road).

#### PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka, who was claimed off waivers from Minnesota on 11/4/17, ranks among the American League rookie leaders in home runs (3rd, 21), RBI (3rd, 55), extra-base hits (3rd, 38), runs scored (4th, 47) and total bases (5th, 165).
- Palka's 21 homers are the second-highest total in White Sox history by a left-handed hitting rookie, one behind Pete Ward's franchise-record of 22 in 1963.
- His three pinch-hit homers this season are tied with Oscar Gamble (1977), John Romano (1959) and Ron Northey (1956) for the White Sox franchise record, and his nine RBI are the most by a Sox pinch-hitter since Jerry Hairston in 1987 (10).

## YOUNG GUNS

- Lucas Giolito (24 years old), Michael Kopech (22), Revnaldo López (24) and Carlos Rodón (25) make up four-fifths of the White Sox starting rotation.
- Giolito leads the staff with 10 victories and is 3-1 with a 4.05 ERA (12 ER/26.2 IP) and 30 strikeouts over his last five starts.
- Kopech has allowed one run or less and one walk or less in three of his first four major-league starts (two rain-shortened).

  López is 1-0 with a 1.83 ERA (4 ER/19.2 IP) over his last three
- starts and has combined to go 2-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3 ER/20.1 IP) in three starts this season against Boston and the Yankees.

  Rodón is 5-1 with a 2.11 ERA (15 ER/64.0 IP) and .151 (33-
- 218) opponents average over his last nine starts

#### **POWER AND SPEED.**

- Tim Anderson (18 HR/25 SB) is one of five players in the major leagues with at least 18 home runs and 25 stolen bases, joining Boston's Mookie Betts, Pittsburgh's Starling Marte, Cleveland's José Ramírez and Colorado's Trevor Story.
- Anderson is attempting to become the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season, and could join Alex Ríos (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only players in franchise history to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.

### AND IMPROVED GLOVEWORK

- SS Tim Anderson has played a career-high 24 straight errorless games (91 TC) and owns a .985 fielding percentage (4 E/268 TC) since 6/10 (75 games).
- By comparison, Anderson posted a .957 (53 E/1,247 TC) fielding percentage over his first 302 career games at shortstop from 6/10/16-6/9/18.

#### **QUALITY AND QUANTITY**

 The White Sox have made 1,379 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, one behind the New York Mets (1,380) for the highest total in the major leagues and 51 more than Oakland (1,328), the next-closest American League team.

#### **RODÓN AT A GLANCE**

- The 25-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 16th start of the season, eighth at home and second against the Los Angeles Angels
- Is 5-1 with a 2.19 ERA (17 ER/70.0 IP), 53 strikeouts and a .159 (38-239) opponents average over his last 10 starts (nine quality) and 6-2 with a 2.59 ERA (24 ER/83.1 IP), 59 strikeouts and a .176 (51-290) opponents average over his last 12 (10 QS).
- His 458 career strikeouts are the most by a White Sox pitcher in his first 81 career games ... is averaging 8.71 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (473.1 IP) lifetime ... has struck out 10-plus seven times in his career.
- Started the 2018 season on the disabled list to continue his rehabilitation from left shoulder surgery ... underwent arthroscopic surgery on his left shoulder on 9/27/17.
- Was selected in the first round (third overall) in the June 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of North Carolina State University ... was the highest pick by the Sox since taking outfielder Harold Baines first overall in 1977.
- Entered the 2014 draft rated by Baseball America as the No. 1 college

prospect and the No. 3 prospect overall ... was rated by MLB.com as the No. 2 overall prospect.

#### LAST START

- Suffered the loss on 9/1 vs. Boston, ending his career-high tying, five-game winning streak ... allowed five runs (four earned) on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 6.1 IP ... his quality start streak ended at nine, one shy of tying his career high.
- Held the Red Sox scoreless over the first four innings ... surrendered solo homers to Eduardo Nuñez and Jackie Bradley Jr. in the fifth inning ... allowed three runs on two hits, one walk and one error in the seventh.
- Departed with the White Sox trailing, 4-2, in the seventh inning ... threw 109 pitches (71 strikes) ... the Sox lost, 6-1.

#### **HOME SWEET HOME**

- Is 3-1 with a 2.23 ERA (12 ER/48.1 IP), 0.89 WHIP and .173 (30-173) opponents average over seven starts at Guaranteed Rate Field this season ... his 2.23 ERA at home is the second-lowest in the American League since 6/14.
- Has gone 15-12 with a 3.77 ERA (98 ER/233.2 IP), 227 strikeouts and a .240 (212-882) opponents average in 41 career games (40 starts) at home ... has allowed just 1.12 home runs per 9.0 IP at Guaranteed Rate Field, the ninth-lowest mark among major-league starters since 2015.

#### **QUALITY IS KEY**

- Made nine consecutive quality starts, going 5-0 with a 1.84 ERA (13 ER/63.2 IP), 49 strikeouts and a .151 (32-212) opponents average ... the nine straight quality starts were the most by a Sox pitcher since he tossed 10 straight from 8/11/15-4/13/16.
- Six of his 12 starts last season were quality, including five straight from 7/30-8/21/17.
- Made 17 quality starts in 2016, going 9-3 with a 2.16 ERA (26 ER/108.1 IP) in those outings ... recorded 16 quality starts in 2015, the most among American League rookies and second-most among major-league rookies behind Cincinnati's Anthony DeSclafani (17).
- Recorded 10 consecutive quality starts from 8/11/15-4/13/16 ... went 6-3 with a 1.73 ERA (13 ER/67.2 IP), 61 strikeouts and a .202 (48-236) opponents average during that span
- Is 26-10 with a 2.39 ERA (97 ER/364.2 IP) in 55 career starts when working at least 6.0 IP (49 QS).

## LOCKDOWN ON LEFTIES

- Is limiting lefties to a .214 (85-397) average with seven home runs in his career ... right-handers are batting .253 (349-1,377) with 51 homers
- Charlie Blackmon, Jackie Bradley Jr. (twice), Robinson Canó, Joey Gallo, David Ortiz and Corey Seager are the only lefties to homer off Rodón.

- Is averaging 8.71 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (458 SO/473.1 IP) over his career, the fifth-best mark among American League lefties since 2015.
- Has recorded 10-plus strikeouts seven times in his career, including a career-high 11 on four occasions: 8/4/17 at Boston, 7/25/17 at the Cubs. 9/25/16 at Cleveland and 8/11/15 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

#### **CARLOS ON THE MEND**

 Made four rehab starts during his stint on the disabled list: one with Class A Kannapolis and three with Class AAA Charlotte ... received a no decision in his only start with Kannapolis on 5/19 vs. Hickory . one run on three hits with no walks and six strikeouts over 5.0 IP ... went 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER/12.2 IP), five walks and 22 strikeouts over three starts with Charlotte ... opponents hit .222 (10-45).

#### 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

 Tied his career high with his fifth straight win on 8/17 at New York-AL (2 ER/7.0 IP) ... recorded the victory on 8/22 vs. Minnesota (2 ER/6.0 IP) ... earned his fourth win of the season on 8/15 at Detroit (3 ER/8.0 IP) after recording his seventh straight quality start ... threw 8.0 scoreless IP in his sixth quality start on 8/10 vs. Cleveland  $\dots$  allowed one unearned run over 6.0 IP on 8/4 at Tampa Bay  $\dots$  went 7.0-plus IP for the third straight start on 7/29 vs. Toronto (ND; 2 ER/7.2 IP)  $\dots$  struck out a season-high eight batters on 7/24 at Los Angeles-AL ... recorded a career-high 15.1 consecutive scoreless IP from 7/5-24 ... earned his second win of the season on 7/11 at St. Louis, allowing just three hits over 7.1 scoreless IP ... recorded his second quality start on 7/5 at Houston (ND; 2 ER/6.0 IP) ... collected his first win of 2018 on 6/24 vs. Oakland, allowing two runs on seven hits over a career-high tying 8.0 IP ... allowed just two runs over 5.0 IP in his second start on 6/14 vs. Cleveland ... made his season debut on 6/9 at Boston, suffering the loss after allowing four runs (two earned) over 5.0 IP.

## **VS. LOS ANGELES ANGELS**

- Is scheduled to make his fifth career start and second this season against Los Angeles-AL ... is 2-2 with a 3.52 ERA (9 ER/23.0 IP) lifetime.
- Won his last start on 7/24 at Angel Stadium (2 ER/7.2 IP) ... lost his last start at Guaranteed Rate Field on 4/18/16 (5 ER/0.1 IP) ... suffered the loss on 8/17/15 at the Angels, tossing his first career complete game (2 ER/8.0 IP) ... earned the win on 8/11/15 in Chicago, throwing 7.0 scoreless IP while striking out a career-high 11 batters
- Is 4-1 with a 3.04 ERA (18 ER/53.1 IP), 47 strikeouts and a .221 (44-199) opponents average over his last eight starts (seven quality) against the American League West.
