### SAN DIEGO NOTES

- The Padres' seven pickoffs are the most of any team this season.
- Eric Lauer** made his fourth career start and first at Petco Park...recorded his second pickoff of the season, along with Lucchesi's three pickoffs this season, it is the first time the Padres have had two rookie starters to combine for five-or-more pickoffs in the same season since 2009, when Clayton Richard and Josh Geer combined for six.
  - Is the first Padres starting pitcher to allow three home runs in an inning this season, the last Padres starter to allow three home runs in the same inning was Ben Howard on Sept. 14, 2003 at LAD (per STATS).
- Travis Jankowski** belted his first homer of the season...recorded his fourth career three-hit game (last: Oct. 1, 2017 at SF)...his nine putouts tonight were one shy of the Padres single-game record of 10 putouts (3x; last: June 11, 2004).
- Manuel Margot** has hit safely in six of his last nine career games vs. STL (.333, 10-for-30) with three multi-hit efforts.
- Franchy Cordero** is batting .324 (11-for-34) in 10 games in the month of May.
- Jose Pirela** logged his team-leading sixth three-hit game of the season...has reached base safely in 15 of his last 17 games and has hit safely in six of his last seven (.400, 10-for-25)...recorded his first extra-base hit since April 15 vs. SF.
- Christian Villanueva** made his first career appearance at short stop...his 0-for-33 is now the longest hitless streak by a Padres rookie position player, all time.
- The club allowed five home runs tonight, the most they have given up in a game this season (previous high was three, 4x).

### ST. LOUIS NOTES

- The Cardinals hit five home runs in a game for the first time since June 16, 2017 at BAL...hit back-to-back home runs for the third time this season (last: April 12 at CIN).
- Luke Weaver** did not allow a run in tonight's game, the first time he has not allowed a run in a game this season...improves to 2-0 in two career games vs. SD with a .000 ERA (0 ER, 12 IP).
- Tommy Pham** has 12 hits in eight career games at Petco Park, batting .462 (12-for-26) with a double, a triple, two homers and four RBI.
- Jedd Gyorko** logged his first three-hit game of the season...is batting .525 (21-for-40) with eight home runs and 17 RBI in 12 career games against his former team.
- Paul DeJong** recorded a career-high four RBI in tonight's game...leads the club in both multi-hit games (12) and home runs (8).
- Marcell Ozuna** is leading the team with 10 hits in May...went 2-for-4 tonight with a home run, an RBI and three runs scored...logged his 10th multi-hit game of the season.
