UNDER THE SATURDAY NIGHT LIGHTS: The Padres bested the Cincinnati Reds 8-2 last night, winning the second game of the three-game series...today, the Friars look to claim the series in the rubber match, owning a 1-6 record in rubber games this season...SD has won four of its last five games and six of its last 10.

- On the eve of his 23rd birthday, starter **Eric Lauer** was awarded his second career victory, working 5.0 innings of five-hit ball and allowing just a single run (earned) with two walks and four strikeouts...he threw eight first-pitch strikes (all of them called strikes) of the 21 batters he faced, and at the plate, he added a sacrifice fly in the second inning for his first-career RBI and his first sac-fly.
- LF **Travis Jankowski**, 1B **Eric Homser**, CF **Manuel Margot**, and RF **Franmil Reyes** all contributed multi-hit efforts in the game...Jankowski also added his second two-steal game of the season.
- **José Castillo's** debut in the eighth inning marked the ninth Padre to debut this season, joining Adam Cimber, Kazuhisa Makita, Joey Lucchesi, Colten Brewer, Eric Lauer, Javy Guerra, Franmil Reyes and Walker Lockett.

QUITE THE CATALYST: OF **Travis Jankowski** was recalled from El Paso (AAA) on April 29, and in 31 games since, his .314 average is the 11th best average among NL players in that time, and his 10 steals headline the NL and tie with BOS's Mookie Betts for the most in the majors...prior to Jankowski's arrival, the Padres were 10-18, and after April 29th, they've gone 16-16 overall and 14-10 (.583 winning percentage) in games he's started.

ELIAS SAYS: Last night, LHP **José Castillo** made his Major League debut in the eighth inning, striking out Joey Votto, Eugenio Suarez and Adam Duvall (third, fourth and fifth in the Cincinnati order)...in doing so, he became the third Padres pitcher in club history to strike out the first three batters he faced in his Major League debut...the other two were Jeremy Fikac on Aug. 16, 2001 vs. NYM and Tommy Layne on Aug 14, 2012 @ ATL.

TYSON TIME: Starter **Tyson Ross** has thrown 518 sliders this season, the second-most sliders of any pitcher behind Chris Archer's 542... this season, he's relied on a four-seamer (47.3%), slider (46.5%) and a sinker (6.1%)...opposing batters have hit just .171 this season against his slider and .200 against his sinker...Ross' 516 first-pitch strikes are the most on the Padres pitching staff.

QUITE THE INHERITANCE: Of the 73 runners the Padres bullpen has inherited this season, only 12 have scored...those 12 are the fewest of any team this season, and their 16.4 inherited runners scoring percentage is the lowest in the majors...LHP **Brad Hand** has inherited 15 runners without allowing a single one to score, good for the best IR scoring percentage (0 percent) of any qualifying reliever this year.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Last night, the Padres went 5-for-9 with RISP, and San Diego has now hit .257 (113-for-439) with RISP this season, the fourth-best mark in the NL...they also rank second in the NL with RISP/2 out (hitting. 270), behind just MIL's .272 average in such scenarios.

IT IS YOUR BIRTHDAY: Join the Padres in wishing LHP **Eric Lauer** a happy 23rd birthday!

PADRES ON DECK: For Lake Elsinore (A), LHP **Adrian Morejon**, the Padres' sixth-ranked prospect, allowed one run on six hits with seven strikeouts in 6.0 innings...for Fort Wayne (A), LHP **Oswaldo Hernandez** allowed four hits and a walk with six strikeouts in 6.0 scoreless innings...he is now 3-2 with the TinCaps with a 2.20 ERA...for San Antonio (AA), CF **Michael Gettys** homered in his third straight game.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#38 RHP TYSON ROSS (4-3, 3.29) @TysonRoss

TYSON'S TURN: 31-year-old RHP **Tyson Ross** is set to face the Cincinnati Reds for the first time since June 5, 2015.

- Is 4-0 with a 1.20 ERA (4 ER, 30.0 IP) in his five career appearances (four starts) against the Reds...his 1.20 ERA is his lowest against any opponent in which he's made at least four starts against.

QUALI-TY-SON: Has seven quality starts in his 11 outings, tying him for the sixth-most in the NL...the Padres are now 7-0 when he has a quality outing...the Padres are 8-3 overall in games which Ross starts.

STATCASTED: Starter Tyson Ross has thrown 518 sliders this season, and those are the second-most sliders of any pitcher, behind Chris Archer's 542... this season, he's relied on a four-seamer (47.3%), slider (46.5%) and a sinker (6.1%)...opposing batters have hit just .171 this season against his slider and .200 against his sinker...Ross' 516 first-pitch strikes are the most on the Padres pitching staff.

THE TYSON WE KNOW & LOVE: While battling injuries from 2016-17, Tyson posted a 8.12 ERA, a 1.84 WHIP, a .286 opponent batting average and ratios of 6.79 K/9 IP and 1.08 K/BB across 13 appearances (11 starts).

- Over his 99 games (80 starts) from 2013-15, he posted a 3.07 ERA, a 1.23 WHIP, a .232 batting average, and ratios of 9.16 K/9 IP and 2.63 K/BB.
- Returning to form over his 11 starts in 2018, Tyson has posted a 3.29 ERA, 1.17 WHIP, .2016 average and ratios of 9.32 K/9 IP and 2.83 K/BB.

TRIPLE DIGIT TYSON: Tossed 100-or-more pitches in five consecutive outings from 5/1-23, the longest stretch of his career and the longest by a Padre since James Shields in '16 (May 2-25).

- Ross threw a career-high 127 pitches as he took a no-hitter into the eighth inning on 4/20 at ARI, tossing 7.2 IP of one-hit, one-run ball behind 10 strikeouts, one shy of his career high in the Padres' 4-1 victory.
- Ross' 127 pitches in that game are tied for the most thrown in a single outing this season (CLE Trevor Bauer on 5/27 vs. HOU ...teammate **Clayton Richard** threw the single-game high in 2017 (127 on June 13 vs. CIN).
- His 101.4 pitches per game are the the 10th-most in the ML

YOU SHALL NOT PASS FIRST: Has allowed 16 extra base hits, which is tied for the third-fewest among all pitchers (min. 65.0 IP).

A LITTLE HELP HERE: Tyson's 3.43 run support average (runs scored while he's in the game) is the sixth-lowest among all qualifying starting NLpitchers.

- His 25 total runs of support are fourth-lowest among all pitchers with at least 65.0 IP

ALL-STAR SEASON: In his first full season as a starter in 2014, he earned his first career All-Star nod and set career highs in starts (31), innings pitched (195.2), strikeouts (195) and ERA (2.81).

TOMORROW'S STARTER

CLAYTON'S TURN: LHP **Clayton Richard** is set to make his team-leading 13th start of the season tomorrow to open up the final series of this homestand against Atlanta.

- Over his last five starts, he is 2-2 with a 3.22 ERA (13 ER, 36.1 IP) with 29 strikeouts and five walks.
- Became the first Padre since **Brian Lawrence** in 2005 to pitch into the eighth inning in three-straight starts from 5/8-19.
- The last Padre to toss at least 7.0-innings-or-more in three straight was **Drew Pomeranz** in 2016.

- Is the first player in MLB history to wear number 90.

- Is the third Padres pitcher to strikeout all three batters faced in their MLB debut, joining Tommy Layne (August 14, 2012) and Jeremy Fikac (August 16, 2001), per STATS Inc.
- Has split the season between El Paso and Double-A San Antonio...in seven appearances for the Chihuahuas, has posted a 1-0 record with a 1.08 ERA (1 ER, 8.1 IP) with nine strikeouts against one walk.
- Acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays along with Wil Myers, C Ryan Hanigan and RHP Gerardo Reyes as part of a three-team deal between the Padres, Rays and Nationals, December 19, 2014.

- Tossed 5.2-scoreless innings on Monday, his longest relief appearance in his career...is the first Padres reliever to throw 5.2-or-more scoreless frames in a single outing since Josh Banks on May 25, 2008 vs. CIN.
- Is scoreless in 11 of his 15 relief appearances this season, posting a 1.80 ERA (6 ER, 30.0 IP) out of the Padres bullpen.
- Has not issued a walk in each of his last 11 appearances since April 23 at COL...his 11.50 strikeout/walk ratio ranks second among NL relievers, behind only WSH Sean Doolittle (12.67).
- Made two starts for the Padres in 2018...is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.

- Was named the National League Reliever of the month for May, the second such honor of his career (also, July 2017)...pitched to a 0.61 ERA (1 ER, 14.2 IP) during May with a 0.89 WHIP, 22 strikeouts and a .120 opponent average.
- His 17 saves rank fourth in the majors and second in the National League...converted each of his 11 save opportunities during the month of May, tying with BOS Craig Kimbrel for the most in MLB.
- Joined Trevor Hoffman as the only two Padre pitchers (third time) in team history to record 11-or-more saves during the month of May (Hoffman had 12 saves in 2005 and 11 saves in 2007).
- Is just the fourth reliever in Padres history to tally 11 saves in a single month, joining Craig Kimbrel (July 2015), Trevor Hoffman (May 2007, September 2006, May 2005, July 2004, July 1998) and Mark Davis (September 1989, April 1989).
- According to Statcast data, 50.4% of his pitches this season have been sliders.
