SAN DIEGO NOTES

- The Padres have won three series in a row for the first time since last season, when they took two of three from CLE, PHI, SF (July 4-16)...have also won eight consecutive series against the Braves at Petco Park, dating back to June 24, 2011...since then, they've had a home record of 19-5 vs. ATL.
- **Matt Strahm** worked a season-high 2.1 IP in his fifth-career start...owns a 3.07 ERA (5 ER, 14.2 IP) in 10 games (two starts) this season.
 - Made his first-career plate appearance.
- **Freddy Galvis** plated Jose Pirela with a safety-squeeze in the ninth inning...is batting .250 (5-for-20) with a triple and four RBI over his last six games and has reached base via hit or walk in 13 of his last 14 games, owning a .327 OBP with six walks.
- **Cory Spangenberg** logged his second triple of the season...has hit in six of his last seven games vs. ATL, batting .360 (9-for-25) with a double, three triples and a homer.
- **Jose Pirela** has a .320 OBP at home this season with 14 walks...the Padres are 11-7 when he gets more than one hit in a game.
- **Jose Castillo** earned his first-career win, working 1.2 IP off one-hit with two strikeouts in today's game.

ATLANTA NOTES

- **Mike Foltynewicz** made his first start against the Padres since Sept. 1, 2016...has worked at least 5.0 IP in 12 of his last 13 starts this season and owns a 0.97 ERA (4 ER, 37.0 IP) over his last six starts with 45 strikeouts.
 - Allowed two earned runs in an outing for the first time this season since May 4 vs. SF, when he allowed six earned runs.
- **Freddie Freeman** belted 11th home run of the season and his second in as many days...is hitting .365 (31-for-85) against lefties and leads the National League with a .432 OBP.
- **Charlie Culberson** extended his hitting streak to seven games, batting .400 (10-for-25) with a .640 SLG during that time...over his last 12 games, has a .351 average with six extra base hits and nine RBI.
- **Ozzie Albies** leads the National League in extra base hits (35) and doubles (19).
