TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** lost the third game of the four game series to Detroit, snapping a seven-game win streak at Target Field...are now 4-1 on the current homestand, 18-5 in their last 23 at home and 37-25 at Target Field overall...fall to 27-25 vs. the AL Central...are now 6-6 vs. Detroit this year, including 4-2 at Target Field...are now 30-26 when scoring first...the bullpen allowed three earned runs tonight, had previously only allowed one run in 15.2 innings on the homestand...third straight game with at least three home runs, tied for the second longest streak in franchise history, which has now been done six times (longest four games)...four home runs ties a season high (last June 3 vs. CLE).
- **KOHL STEWART** lasted only 2.2 innings in his second big league start after allowing three runs on three hits and four walks with two strikeouts...was removed from the game after allowing a two-RBI double to Ronny Rodriguez...shortest start by a Twins starter since Aaron Slegers lasted 1.1 inning on July 10 vs. Kansas City.
- **JOE MAUER** (3-for-5) hit a solo home run to lead off the game, his first career lead-off home run...the home run was his 142nd of his career, moving him into sole possession of 11th place on the Twins all-time home run list...second time in his career he's homered in consecutive at-bats (July 24, 2009 vs. Los Angeles-AL)...third lead-off home run by a Twin this year, the last coming by Robbie Grossman on June 20 vs. Boston...second straight game with a home run, only the eighth time he has homered in consecutive games in his career...his 27th multi-hit game this year and his seventh three-hit game...now has 2,082 career hits, three away from tying Rod Carew for second most hits in Twins history.
- **JORGE POLANCO** (1-for-5) doubled in the first inning and hit safely in 20 of his last 24 games, hitting .258 (28-for-95) with five doubles over that stretch...has now reached base safely in 34 of his 40 starts this year.
- **TYLER AUSTIN** (3-for-4) hit a solo home run in the second inning, his second straight game with a home run, only the second time he's done so in his career...all three of his home runs with the Twins have come against Detroit...his 12th multi-hit game this year and his second with the Twins; only his second career three-hit game, the other coming September 26, 2017 vs. Boston.
- **MIGUEL SANO** (2-for-4) homered and singled tonight and is now hitting .314 (19-for-61) with four home runs and 10 RBI in his last 17 games...has reached base safely in 15 of his last 17 games...12th multi-hit game this year and his seventh in his last 17 games

TIGERS NOTES:

- **THE TIGERS** took the third of the four game series vs. the Twins, snapping a five game losing streak...improve to 18-8 vs. the Twins in their last 26 meetings and improve to 25-28 vs. the AL Central...are now 19-43 on the road and 24-43 in night games...are now 37-33 when they hit a home run...this was their 22nd comeback win of the year...improve to 15-47 when being out-hit by their opponent...allowed four home runs, most allowed in a win this year.
- **RYAN CARPENTER** made his fourth career start and earned his first career win after allowing three runs on eight hits with three strikeouts over 5.1 innings...allowed three solo home runs, a career-high...his three strikeouts ties a career high and the eight hits allowed is a career-high...first career appearance on the road...second start in his career in which he didn't allow a walk.
- **RONNY RODRIGUEZ** (1-for-4) doubled and drove in a pair of runs in the third inning, only his third career double and first career game with multiple RBI.
- **JIM ADDUCI** (2-for-5) singled and doubled tonight, and has now had a hit in five straight games, hitting .300 (6-for-20) over the streak...the streak is the longest of his career...his sixth multi-hit game of the season.
- **MIKIE MAHTOOK** (1-for-3) hit a three run home run in the fourth inning, his second of the year...walked with the bases loaded to drive in four runs, his first career game with four RBI.
