BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- ✦ Fall to 15-37 in games vs. LH starters (56-49 vs. RHPs)...Are back below .500 at home (39-40)...Drop to 1-3 vs. Houston this season...Lost a game while out-hitting their opponent for the second time in as many nights (10th time this year).
- ✦ **MARCO ESTRADA** allowed 4 runs on 7 hits across 4.2 innings of work...Struck out a batter and issued a walk...Is winless in his last 6 starts...Now has a 7.17 ERA (43 ER/54.0 IP) since his 7/30 return from the DL.
- ✦ **KEVIN PILLAR** got the Jays on the board in the 4th inning with a two-run homer...Was his 15th HR of the year, 1 shy of his career high from last season...Marked his 11th HR at Rogers Centre...Was his 55th XBH, setting a career mark (54 in 2017)...Also set a new personal best with 58 RBI this year (56 in 2015).
- ✦ **YANGERVIS SOLARTE** picked up an RBI with a bases-loaded single in the 5th...Snapped a 0-for-16 drought with that hit...Was his first RBI since 7/28 at CWS...His 19G drought without an RBI was a career long (15G in 2014)...Added another single in the 7th to finish 2-for-4 with his 30th multi-hit game of the year.
- ✦ **RICHARD URENA** had 3 singles for his 2nd career 3-hit game (also 9/12/17 vs. BAL)...Marked his second straight multi-hit game (6th career)...Has hits in 17 of his 22 starts...Is now batting .289 (24-for-83) with 4-2B, 1-HR and 6-RBI while up with the Jays this season.
- ✦ **RANDAL GRICHUK** recorded his 31st double...Is now 1 XBH shy of tying his career high (56 in 2016)...Came into tonight ranked 3rd in the AL with 32 XBH since the All-Star break.
- ✦ **ALEDMYS DIAZ** walked twice and singled...Has gone 11-for-28 (.393) with 3-2B, 1-HR and 6-RBI over his 10 contests.
- ✦ **LOURDES GURRIEL Jr.** left the game after the 1st inning with left hamstring tightness.

ASTROS NOTES:

- ✦ Narrowed their magic number down to 2...Improved to 17-4 in September...The .810 win% this month leads the Majors...Move to 6-1 on the current road trip and are now an MLB-best 53-22 on the road, tying the best road win total in team history (2017).
- ✦ **DALLAS KEUCHEL** allowed a trio of runs on 7 hits across 5.0 innings...Walked 3 batters and struck out 5...Has now thrown 201.2 innings, reaching the 200-IP plateau for the 3rd time (200.0 in 2014 and 232.0 in 2015)...Became the 15th pitcher in team history with 3+ seasons of 200+ IP...Leads all LHPs this season in IP.
- ✦ **BRIAN McCANN** notched his 6th home run of the season...Was his first HR since 6/14 at OAK...The 18G stretch without a HR was his longest since a 21G drought in 2014.
- ✦ **JOSH REDDICK** followed up McCann's blast with one of his own...Formed Houston's 6th set of back-to-back homers this year (last: Reddick/Gattis on 7/14 vs. DET)...Was Reddick's 16th HR this season and his 10th to come on the road.
- ✦ **ALEX BREGMAN** doubled in a run in the 3rd inning...Came into tonight with 81 XBH, 2nd most in the AL (Betts-82)...**Has now reached base safely in 52 consecutive road games, the longest streak in franchise history**, breaking Jeff Bagwell's 51-game road streak set from 1998-99...It is also the longest streak by a Major League player since Derek Jeter posted a 59-game road streak from 2006-07.
- ✦ **YULI GURRIEL** opened the scoring with an RBI single in the 1st inning...Finished the night 2-for-4...Extended his hitting streak to 10 games, batting .439 (18-for-41) with 3-2B, 3-HR and 15-RBI over that stretch (1.197 OPS).
- ✦ **GEORGE SPRINGER** led off the game with his 26th double, 3 shy of his career high (29 in 2016 and 2017)...Is now batting .342 (27-for-79) this month...Ranked 7th in the AL with his September .351 AVG entering tonight.
- ✦ **JOSE ALTUVE** singled twice, picked up an RBI and scored a run...His .317 AVG coming into this evening ranked 3rd in the AL.
