FISH BITES

Miami continues the second series of this six-game homestand with game two of three against the Philadelphia Phillies tonight at 7:10 p.m. RHP **Trevor Richards**, who is making his 21st start of the season, is facing the Phillies for the fourth time, posting a 1-1 record and 2.40 ERA. Philadelphia is countering with RHP Jake Arrieta, who in seven career starts against Miami has gone 4-1 with a 2.66 ERA; is 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA in three starts against Miami this season. The Marlins began their current homestand by dropping two of three to the Toronto Blue Jays. Miami returned a week ago tomorrow following a two-game sweep at the hands of the Boston Red Sox. Prior to that series, the Marlins split a six-game homestand against the Yankees (1-1) and Braves (2-2). **Programming note:** the Marlins will have four remaining games moved to 610AM WIOD: September 8 vs. Pittsburgh, Sept. 15 vs. Philadelphia, Sept. 22 vs. Cincinnati, and Sept. 29 vs. Mets.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

Miami snapped a four-game slide against Philadelphia, coming away with a 3-1 win in just 2 hours, 24 minutes. All of the game's scoring came in the second inning, when Philadelphia tallied its lone run on a home run by Asdrúbal Cabrera. Miami followed in the bottom half of the frame, when **Lewis Brinson** singled home **Derek Dietrich**, who led off with a triple. Following an **Austin Dean** double, **Rafael Ortega** drove in two with a single to left field to give Miami all it would need. Brinson tallied two hits and now has five hits in 11 at-bats since returning from the disabled list. **José Ureña** earned his second straight win, allowing just one run on four hits; he struck out seven and walked none in 7.0 innings. **Drew Steckenrider** worked a perfect ninth for his third save.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Marlins today returned from rehab and reinstated both LHP **Jarlin García** and RHP **Elieser Hernandez**, placed INF **Martin Prado** on the 60-day disabled list with a right abdominal strain, transferred INF/OF **Garrett Cooper** to the 60-day DL, recalled UTL **Christopher Bostick** (#48), and selected the contracts of RHP **Tyler Kinley** (#39) and INF/OF **Peter O'Brien** (#45) from Triple-A New Orleans. Both Kinley and O'Brien are from the local area, attending Nova High School in Davie, and G. Holmes Braddock High School in Miami, respectively.

VS. PHILADELPHIA

Miami trails the season series, 6-8, however they guaranteed a home season series win, its first against Philadelphia since going 6-3 in 2014. The Marlins are 112-103 overall in South Florida (34-29 at Marlins Park), yet trail the all-time series, 193-237.

STINGY

In nine starts at Marlins Park this season, **Trevor Richards** has allowed a total of 41 hits, tied with Chris Sale and Blake Snell for the fourth-fewest hits allowed at home this season (min. 9 GS). Ryne Stanek has allowed just 16 in 23 appearances (13 starts), while Trevor Cahill has allowed 32 hits in his nine starts and Dereck Rodriguez 39 in 10 appearances (nine starts).

PUTTING IT TOGETHER

Over their last 18 home games since July 28, the Marlins have posted a 2.73 ERA (168.0 ip/51 er) to mark the second-lowest ERA among National League staffs (fourth in MLB) at home in that span. They have limited opponents to a .212 average against, tops in the NL and second in the Majors. Starters have allowed three-or-fewer runs 16 times, including 12 starts of two-or-less runs allowed, and posted a 2.33 ERA (104.1/27), while the bullpen has allowed 24 earned runs over 63.2 innings pitched for a 3.39 ERA.

HOT CORNER TO THE SIX

The left side of Miami's infield has combined on a .980 fielding percentage (952 TC/19 E), the second-highest combined fielding percentage of any Major League third base/shortstop combo, behind only the Arizona Diamondbacks, who have fielded at a .981 clip (932 TC/18 E). Miami third basemen lead in the Majors with a .979 fielding percentage (328/7), ahead of second-ranked Arizona (.976; 338/8). Among shortstops, Miami's .981 (625/12) mark ranks sixth in MLB, behind San Diego (.986; 574/8), Arizona (.983; 595/10), the Angels (.983; 590/10), Colorado (.982; 559/10), and Detroit (.981; 537/10).

ALL AROUND ANDY

Brian Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (137), at-bats (524), runs (76), average with RISP (.376), and on-base percentage (.356); ranks second in hits (143), doubles (30), walks (55), and multi-hit games (42); ranks third in RBI (58) and average (.273); is tied for third in triples (3); fourth in slugging (.402); and tied for 12th in HR (10). On the defensive side, he leads all rookie outfielders with a .994 fielding percentage, committing just one error in 176 total chances. He also owns eight outfield assists, most among all ML rookie outfielders and just four off the Major League lead held by Billy Hamilton. His five total errors this season are fifth-fewest by a NL rookie (min. 60 GS), and he is the only rookie on that list to spend significant time at two different positions (45 GS at 3B; 89 GS in RF).

- He is on pace for 167 hits this season, which would rank as the fourth-most by a National League rookie since 2007, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, Troy Tulowitzki's 177 in '07, and Matt Duffy's 169 in '15, and would be the 11th-most by an NL rookie since 2000.
- He recorded 109 hits before the All-Star break, tying Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.
- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season. Since 1958, 34 rookies have recorded 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games and went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*
