## NATIONALS NEWS

### MOVIN' ON UP

The Washington Nationals enjoyed a day off on Monday after returning home from a successful 7-3 road trip...Sweeps of the Miami Marlins (3 G) and Baltimore Orioles (3 G) to start the trip helped to catapult the Nationals from fourth to second place in the National League East...Despite a series defeat at the hands of the Atlanta Braves last weekend, Washington enters play on Tuesday just 1.0 game back of the Braves.

- The Nationals begin a five-game homestand starting with the Tampa Bay Rays for two games before welcoming the San Francisco Giants for three games.

### WINNING WAYS

Since April 29, the Nationals are 22-9 and have outscored their opponents, 130-85...The 22-9 (.710) record is the best in Major League Baseball, ahead of the New York Yankees (21-9, .700), during this stretch.

### BULLPENNING

Over the last 13 games, **Henry Blanco's** bullpen has tossed 42.0 innings of relief, striking out 39 batters, walking nine and surrendering just five earned runs along the way (1.07 ERA)...Nationals relievers have inherited 18 runners during this stretch and have allowed just one to score.

- Washington's 1.07 bullpen ERA is the best in Major League Baseball since May 21.
- On the season, Washington relievers rank among National League 'pens in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3rd, 2.87), inherited runners scored percent (3rd, 20.0%), and strikeouts per 9.0 IP (4th, 9.33).

With 97 in hand, **Trea Turner** is approaching 100 career stolen bases...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, here is the list of quickest active players in terms of games (Turner: 257 games) to reach 100 stolen bases:

### START ME UP

Washington's starting rotation leads the National League in ERA (2.90), strikeouts (395), opp. AVG (.212), opp. OBP (.275), hits per 9.0 IP (6.98), WHIP (1.06)...The staff ranks second in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.87), opp. SLG (.358), and opp. OPS (.633).

- Since April 28, Nationals starters have allowed three earned runs or fewer in 31 of 33 starts.
- The Nationals boast four starters in the top 16 in the National League in ERA...No other team has more than two: **Max Scherzer** (2nd, 1.92), **Gio Gonzalez** (5th, 2.27), **Stephen Strasburg** (14th, 3.20) and **Tanner Roark** (16th, 3.38).

### DINGERS OF THE DAY

The Nationals lead the National League with 75 home runs...**Bryce Harper** (1st, 18) and **Matt Adams** (T6th, 12) rank in the top 10 in the National League...Harper's 18 home runs are tied for third in Major League Baseball.

- Since joining the Nationals on May 13, **Mark Reynolds'** six home runs are tied for second-most in the National League.

### 2018 FIRST-YEAR PLAYER DRAFT

The Washington Nationals selected prep right-handed pitcher **Mason Denburg** with the No. 27 selection in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft and left-handed pitcher **Tim Cate** with their second-round selection (No. 65 overall) in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

- Denburg, a 6-foot-3, 190-pound right-hander, went 5-1 with a 1.27 ERA (5 ER/35.1 IP) in eight starts during his senior season at Merritt Island (Fla.) High School...He struck out 73 batters while walking just 10.
- Cate, a 6-foot-1, 186-pound junior went 5-4 with a 2.91 ERA (17 ER/52.2 IP) in 11 games (seven starts) for the University of Connecticut...He recorded 67 strikeouts, walked 19 batters and held opponents to a .258 batting average.

### ALL HANDS ON DECK

The Nationals have used 42 players so far in 2018...That number does not include the players that have been on the active roster, but did not appear in a game (**Jhonatan Solano**, **Austin Voth**)...The 42 players used are tied for the most in Major League Baseball:

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### June 5 (9-5 on this date)

2012 - **Bryce Harper** drove in the Nationals' first and last runs in a wild winner-takes-first-place 12-inning, 7-6 home victory over the Mets. Harper's single in the 12th, which came on an 0-2 pitch, rendered the first walk-off hit of his career. **Ian Desmond**—via RBI in the eighth, 10th and 12th innings—became the first big leaguer since Cincinnati's **Art Shamsky** in 1966 to tie a game three separate times in the eighth inning or later.

## OPPONENT

### TAMPA BAY RAYS

**Dave Martinez** spent seven seasons (2008-14) as the bench coach for the Tampa Bay Rays...He was the longest tenured bench coach in Rays history...**Tim Bogar** worked with Martinez during the 2008 season, serving as Tampa Bay's quality assurance coach...Joe Dillon spent the 2009-10 seasons in Tampa Bay's system, appearing in 15 games for the Rays in 2009...Rays catcher **Wilson Ramos** spent seven seasons (2010-16) with the Nationals.

### THE SERIES

The Nationals and Rays will play four times in 2018 (2 in D.C. and 2 in Tampa)...Tampa Bay took three of four from Washington in 2015, the last time these two clubs faced off in Interleague Play.

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

## #31 - MAX SCHERZER - RHP

Polished veteran right-hander, three-time Cy Young Award Winner and five-time consecutive All-Star signed a historic seven-year contract with Washington on Jan. 21, 2015...Joined the Nationals after seven Major League seasons with the Detroit Tigers (2010-14) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2008-09)...Is one of just 10 pitchers in Major League history to take home the Cy Young Award three or more times.

**AGAINST THE RAYS:** Faces Tampa Bay for the first time since Aug. 19, 2014, when he was a member of the American League Detroit Tigers...Went 4-2 with a 2.91 ERA in eighth starts against the Rays from 2010-14.

**LAST START:** Extended his winning streak to eight games by tossing 8.0 shutout innings on May 30 at Baltimore...Struck out 12 batters while allowing two hits and walking just one.

### 2018 NOTES

- Is in the midst of an eight-game winning streak, the third-longest streak of his career (13 G; 4/6-7/3/13 and 9 G; 8/20/16-4/7/17)...It is the longest winning streak in Major League Baseball in 2018.
- Ranks among National League pitchers in strikeouts (1st, 120), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (1st, 13.56), wins (1st, 9), WHIP (1st, 0.85), opp. AVG (1st, .171), opp. OBP (1st, .232), hits per 9.0 IP (1st, 5.54), ERA (2nd, 1.92), opp. OPS (3rd, .546), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3rd, 6.32) and opp. SLG (5th, .314)...Leads National League pitchers in Wins Above Replacement according to FanGraphs.com (3.3).
- His 13.56 strikeouts per 9.0 IP would be the best since **Randy Johnson** in 2001 (13.41).
- Opposing right-handed batters are just 18-for-122 (.148) against him...Has not allowed a home run to a RHB (Last: **Stanton**; 8/7/17 vs. MIA).
- Struck out at least 10 batters in three consecutive starts from May 6-19, tied for the third-longest streak of his career (6 G; 5/26-6/21/17).
- Did not earn the win, but struck out a season-high 15 batters on May 6 vs. PHI...It was his 69th career 10+strikeout game and fifth career 15+strikeout game...He became the first pitcher in Major League history (since 1913) to strike out at least 15 batters in no more than 6.1 IP according to Baseball-Reference.com.
- Was named National League Pitcher of the Month for April (5-0, 1.62 ERA, 57 SO, 9 BB, .165 opp. AVG) and May (4-0, 2.21 ERA, 63 SO, 10 BB).
- Has been called upon to help snap five-game, three-game and four-game losing streaks this season...Washington won all three starts.
- Was named National League Player of the Week for the week of April 9 through 15 (2-0, 1.13 ERA, 21 SO, BB, 3 H).

### CAREER NOTES

- His 72 games of 10+ strikeouts are 10th-most in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers...**Bob Gibson** (H.O.F., 1981) and **Sam McDowell** are tied for eighth with 74.
- Is one of 11 pitchers (only active) in MLB history (since 1913) with at least 39 G of at least 10 SO and one earned run or fewer allowed.
- Is one of 9 pitchers (2 active, **Kershaw**) in MLB history (since 1913) with at least 20 G of at least 10 SO and zero earned runs allowed.
- Scherzer's five career games with 15 or more strikeouts are the most among active players and tied for seventh-most all-time.
- Leads all active starters and ranks second in MLB history with a career 10.33 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (**Randy Johnson** - 10.61).
- His career .198 opp. AVG vs. right-handed batters is fourth-best all-time and second among starting pitchers (**J.R. Richard** - .186).
- Is the only pitcher in MLB with an active streak of six-plus seasons with at least 200 strikeouts.
- Since joining the Nationals in 2015, has taken a no-hitter into the sixth inning in 11 or 110 starts (10.0%), per MASN in-game reporter, Dan Kolko.
- Since 2015, has posted a 0.92 WHIP, behind only **Clayton Kershaw** (0.88) for the best over this stretch.
