THE GIANTS: Have lost a season-high seven-consecutive games, which marks their longest losing skid since dropping seven-straight contests from June 13-19, 2017.

INSIDE THE SERIES: San Francisco is looking for a win today to avoid being swept by the Brewers in a three-game set in Milwaukee for the first time since April 16-18, 2013...dating back to 2015, San Francisco has won seven of their last 12 games at Miller Park, however they have dropped five of the last seven.

LOOKING FOR A WIN: The Giants are 0-5 over the first five games of this current road trip to Colorado (0-3) and Milwaukee (0-2)...SF is looking for a win today to avoid going winless on a road trip of six-or-more games for the first time since going 0-6 from June 30-July 5, 2015 at Miami (0-3) and Washington (0-3).

ON THE MOUND: LHP **Madison Bumgarner** has posted a 7-3 record with a 2.25 ERA and a .217 opponents average in 11 career starts against the Brewers...his 2.25 ERA is the second-lowest average among active players (min. 10 games started)...he is 3-0 with a 2.36 ERA (7er, 26.2ip) in his four starts at Miller Park with the Giants winning all four games.

IN A PINCH: The Giants recorded their seventh pinch-hit home run of the season last night...it marks the most they've had in a single season since they recorded 14 in 2001...SF's seven pinch-hit homers are tied for the second-most in the National League (Brewers: eight pinch-hit HRs).

ON DECK: Following today's game, the Giants will travel home for a six-game homestand against the Atlanta Braves (Monday-Wednesday) and Colorado Rockies (Friday-Sunday)...SF swept the Braves in a three-game series from May 4-6 at SunTrust Park and have posted a 4-3 record at home against the Rockies.

ON THE ROAD: The Giants have dropped 11 of their past 13 road games, during that stretch they are hitting .200 and have posted a 4.60 ERA...the Giants' .392 (29-45) winning percentage overall on the road is the third-lowest in the league.

LOAD 'EM UP: The Giants are hitting .311 (32-for-103) with the bases loaded, which is the highest figure in the National League and fourth-highest in the Majors...however, SF is one of just two teams without a grand slam this year (also: LAA)...opponents have hit .316 against the Brewers with the bases loaded this season, the second-highest average in the NL (Rockies, .360).

BASEBALL INFO SOLUTIONS: Since July 2, the Giants are 23-35, the third-worst record in the NL...over that stretch, SF hitters' have the second-highest strikeout rate (24%), the second-lowest walk rate (6.8%) in the NL and have been outthomered 68-39...however, the defense ranks sixth in MLB with 36 defensive runs saved in that span.

RISP MANAGEMENT: The Giants have just five hits in 37 at-bats (.135) with runners in scoring position over their last seven games and are hitting just .200 with RISP over their past 12 contests.

BULLPEN STRUGGLES: Giants' relievers have struggled in the month of September, posting a 0-4 record with a 5.40 ERA (12er, 20.0ip) and 0-for-2 in save chances over seven games...during that stretch they've issued 13 walks.

The Giants defeated the Rockies by a score of 9-4 in 11.0 innings...**Barry Bonds** hit three home runs in a game for the second time in 2011, giving him 63 for the year and besting Roger Maris' mark of 61.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#40 LHP Madison Bumgarner
6-4, 243, 29 years old (August 1, 1989)
5-5 Record, 3.07 ERA

- The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the mound today for his 18th start of the season...the Giants are 8-9 in his outings this year, going 5-3 at home and 3-6 on the road... his 18th start today will surpass his total from 2017 (17).
- Last pitched Monday at Colorado and allowed a season-high seven runs (six earned) on a season-high tying eight hits over 5.0 innings in a no-decision...allowed a career-high tying three homers in the Giants' 9-8 defeat...was the seventh time in his career allowing three homers and exactly one year to the day since the last time (9/3/07).
- Has allowed three runs or fewer in 13 of his 17 starts.
- Bumgarner has an 1.59 ERA (9er/51.0ip) in innings 1-3 this season...he has a 4.44 ERA through the rest of the game...his OPS jumps 182 points (.554 vs .736 the first time vs. order compared to second time through the order).
- Has been given a total of just 31 runs of support in his 17 starts (2.64 RSA).
- Faces Milwaukee for a second time this season...suffered the loss on July 27 at AT&T Park in the Giants' 3-1 defeat... allowed three runs, two earned, in 8.0 innings.
- His 2.25 career ERA in 11 games started vs. Milwaukee is second-best among active players with at least 10 starts vs. the club...Lance Lynn owns a 2.20 career ERA vs. MIL.
- Today will mark his fifth career start at Miller Park, is 3-0 with a 2.36 ERA (7er, 26.2ip) in his four prior starts in Milwaukee...the Giants are 4-0 in his four career starts at Miller Park.
- Is 1-2 with a 5.12 ERA (11er, 19.1ip) in three starts this season vs. NL Central opponents.
- With today's road start, it's worth noting his home/away splits (*Baseball Info Solutions*)...
 At home: 1.49 ERA, 2.8 K/BB, .191 BA, .555 OPS
 On road: 4.73 ERA, 2.0 K/BB, .276 BA, .840 OPS
- Is averaging 7.84 strikeouts per 9.0 innings, the lowest rate of his career since 2010...his 3.32 walks per 9.0 is the highest of his career.
- Was reinstated from the 60-day DL June 5.
- Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.
- Had never been on the DL in his first eight MLB seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games...SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.
- His 109 career wins are the third-most in SF-era history (since 1958) behind **Juan Marichal** (238) and **Gaylord Perry** (134).
- Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36)... needs 38 strikeouts to match **Gaylord Perry** (1,606) for the fourth-most in SF-era history...is still seeking his first double-digit strikeout game this year (2018 season-high in strikeouts is eight).

HITTING NOTES: Is 4-for-35 (.114) with three RBI this year...batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season...has hit 17 homers in his 10-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968...has yet to homer in 2018.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP DERECK RODRIGUEZ

2018: 6-2, 2.41 ERA / Career: 6-2, 2.41 ERA

NOTES: 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 16th Major League start (18th appearance) tomorrow night against the Atlanta Braves...the Giants are 9-6 overall when he takes the hill as a starter, going 5-4 at home and 4-2 on the road...among NL rookie pitchers he ranks first in ERA (2.41), fourth in opponents batting average against (.211), tied for fourth in wins (6), seventh in innings pitched (97.0ip), and ninth in strikeouts (78)...his 2.41 ERA is the sixth-lowest among all NL pitchers with at least 90.0 innings pitched...last pitched Tuesday at Colorado and did not factor into the decision in a 6-2 loss...allowed just one run (a solo HR to David Dahl) on six hits in 6.0 innings...left with the game tied at 1-1 before the bullpen got charged with four runs...marked his 12th start this year of 6.0+ innings pitched and two or fewer runs allowed...has never faced the Braves.
