TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Giants finish a three-game set today with the sixth and final meeting between the teams this season...The Giants swept a three-game set at SunTrust Park earlier this season, May 4-6 before the Braves took the first two games of this series.

A The Braves won, 4-1, yesterday to take a series in San Francisco for the first time since sweeping a three-game set, April 22-24, 2011...They went 0-4-2 in series play at AT&T Park over that stretch.

A Entering this series, the Braves were 8-13 in San Francisco since that sweep, and were outscored 104-70.

A RHP Aníbal Sánchez is set to face the Giants for the seventh time in his career and for the first time since beating them on July 6, 2017 while with Detroit...The righty is 4-1 with a 2.13 ERA (10 ER/42.1 IP) in his career against San Francisco, including 3-0 with a 0.36 ERA (1 ER/25.0 IP) here at AT&T Park...He threw a one-hitter here with the Marlins on July 29, 2010 to win 5-0, before tossing a five-hitter again while with Florida to win, 1-0, on May 26, 2011.

A LH Derek Holland faces the Braves for the second time in his career...The lefty last faced them exactly four years ago today, taking a no-decision in a 2-1 win on September 12, 2014 while with Texas...He tossed 7.0 innings and allowed one run, earned.

WINS: The Braves collected their 81st victory of the season last night and with one more win will ensure their first winning season since going 96-66 and winning the N.L. East in 2013.

A The Braves were one of five teams in the National League to enter this year with no winning seasons since 2013...Cincinnati, Miami, Philadelphia and San Diego are the other four.

A Yesterday's win coupled with Philadelphia getting swept in a doubleheader dropped Atlanta's magic number to clinch the National League East to 12... They are a season-high 6.5 games up in the East with 17 games yet to play.

COMPLETE GAME: RHP Mike Foltynewicz threw a six-hitter to win, 4-1, last night and collect his second complete game of the season...Foltynewicz struck out seven and walked one to earn his 11th win of the season.

A Foltynewicz is the first Braves pitcher to throw a complete game since Julio Teheran tossed a one-hitter to beat New York on June 19, 2016.

A He is also the first Braves pitcher with multiple complete games in a season since 2015, when Shelby Miller also had two.

A The Braves did not have a complete game from a starting pitcher in 2017, marking the first season in franchise history they did not have one.

VS. THE N.L. WEST: Last night's victory gave the Braves five wins in six games so far on this seven-game trip to Arizona and San Francisco...A win today would give the Braves their most wins on a road trip that included multiple National League West teams since 2011, when they went 6-4 on a 10-game swing to Los Angeles, San Francisco and San Diego.

A The last time the Braves went 6-1 or better in consecutive road series against National League West teams was 2003, when they also went 6-1 at Los Angeles and San Diego.

A Prior to the start of this trip, the Braves went 29-64 (.312) on the road against the National League West, dating to the start of 2013...They are now 9-6 this season and will finish with a winning record in West division parks for the first time since going 11-6 in 2012.

ON THE ROAD: The Braves are 44-30 (.595) away from SunTrust Park this season, which is the best road record in the National League and the fourth best in baseball.

A The 44 road wins are the most since the 2012 club went 46-35 away from Turner Field.

A Braves starters have a 3.31 ERA (147 ER/399.2 IP) on the road this season, the best mark in the National League and trailing on Houston's 3.19 ERA for the major league lead...At home, Braves starters have a 3.66 ERA (166 ER/408.0 IP), the sixth-lowest mark in the league.

THE ROTATION: Since inserting trade acquisition RHP Kevin Gausman into the rotation on August 1, Atlanta starters lead the majors with a 2.94 ERA (77 ER/235.1 IP)...They also have the best average against at .206, while ranking tied for fifth with 223 strikeouts.

A For the season, the Braves rotation ranks fifth in baseball with a 3.49 ERA (313 ER/807.2 IP) and third in the National League.

ACUÑA JR: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. finished 1-for-3 with a triple, two walks and a run scored last night, and since moving into the leadoff spot for the first game out of the All-Star break on July 20 at Washington, the rookie is hitting .327 (64-for-196) with 44 runs scored, 18 home runs, a .419 on-base percentage and a .699 slugging percentage.

A Acuña Jr. has drawn 11 walks over his last eight games and has 12 total this month...Only Washington's Bryce Harper has more base-on-balls in September than Acuña Jr.

A Acuña Jr. leads the majors with his 44 runs scored since the All-Star break, while his 18 home runs are second most.

WIN STREAK: The Braves have four straight, one shy of their season-high total...They have won five straight three different times, last, August 12-August 15.

Today's Game

- A* Makes his 21st start of the season (22nd appearance) and the 283rd (306th appearance) of his career.
- A* Faces San Francisco for the first time this season, and for the seventh time in his career...Is 4-1 with a 2.13 ERA (10 ER/42.1 IP) in his first six starts.
- A* Has never lost at AT&T Park, going a perfect 3-0 in his three starts and pitching to a 0.36 ERA (1 ER/25.0 IP)...Has allowed just 17 baserunners over 25.0 innings.
- A* Tossed back-to-back shutouts in his first two career starts at San Francisco, July 29, 2010 and May 26, 2011 while with Florida...Is one of three pitchers in the history of AT&T Park to throw shutouts in consecutive starts, and the only one to do so as a member of the visiting team...Both Shawn Estes and Liván Hernández did so pitching for the Giants in 2000.
- A* Is winless in his last six starts, his longest winless stretch of the season and his longest since going 10 straight winless starts from August 6 of last season to April 7 of this year...Has a 3.64 ERA (12 ER/29.2 IP) during the spell, while Atlanta is 2-4 as a team.
- A* Has received just 13 runs of support during the skid, including no more than two runs in each of Atlanta's four losses.
- A* His 3.72 run support average for the season is lowest on the Atlanta staff, and sixth lowest in the National League among pitchers with as many starts.
- A* Went 4-2 with a 2.60 ERA (19 ER/65.2 IP) in 11 starts (12 appearances) for Atlanta prior to the All-Star break...Is 2-3 with a 3.75 ERA (20 ER/48.0 IP) in nine starts after the break.
- A* For his career, has pitched to a 4.17 ERA in 166 appearances before the All-Star break and a 3.86 mark in 139 games after.
- A* His 2.60 ERA at the All-Star break this season was the lowest of his career... His previous best was a 2.93 ERA in 2013, when he went on the pace the American League with a 2.57 full-season mark.

2018 Recap

- A* Left his start, 8/25 at MIA, after 5.2 innings with right hamstring tightness...Allowed just four hits and one run but was saddled with the loss.
- A* Missed 37 games from 4/18 to 5/29 with a right hamstring strain.
- A* Also left his start on 6/26 vs. CIN with cramping in his right calf.
- A* Fanned six batters, 8/14 vs. MIA, including Brian Anderson in the first inning...The strikeout of Anderson was the 1,500th of his major league career.
- A* Nineteen players currently on a 40-man roster have reached the 1,500-strikeout plateau, paced by CC Sabathia (2,952 in 18 major league seasons).
- A* Defeated Washington, 8-5, on 7/20 at Nationals Park...Allowed six hits and three runs over 6.0 innings.
- A* His 2.08 career ERA (36 ER/155.2 IP) against the Nationals/Expos is the lowest all-time mark by a qualifying pitcher against the franchise.
- A* His .909 (10-1) winning percentage is also the best mark all-time against the Nationals/Expos (minimum 10 decisions).
- A* Tossed just 4.2 innings, 6/26 vs. CIN, and allowed five hits and two runs to take his second consecutive loss.
- A* Was removed after throwing just 73 pitches due to cramping in his right calf.
- A* Took his first loss of the season, 6/20 at TOR...Allowed five hits and a season high-tying four runs over 5.0 innings...Set season highs in walks (4) and strikeouts (7).
- A* The loss snapped a streak of three straight wins to open the season...Opened a season 3-0 for the second time in his career...Won the first four decisions of his major league career to open his rookie campaign 4-0 in 2006.
- A* Won two consecutive starts, 6/9 at LAD (5.1 IP, 2 R) and 6/14 vs. SD (7.0 IP, 0 R)...The wins were the first of his career against each team.
- A* Entered the stretch winless against just three major league teams, all three of which played in California...Was winless against the Dodgers, Padres and Angels (0-4) before defeating Los Angeles-NL and San Diego in his last two turns.
- A* Allowed a pair of unearned runs over a season most-tying 7.0 innings, 6/3 vs. WSH...Allowed just four total baserunners.
- A* Returned from the disabled list, 5/29, and started that night vs. NYM...Allowed five hits and four runs over 4.0 innings in a no-decision.
- A* Missed 37 games after suffering a right hamstring strain on 4/18.
- A* Snapped a career-long six-game losing streak, 4/13 at CHI...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in the Braves' 4-0 shutout of the Cubs.
- A* Went 0-6 with a 6.51 ERA (34 ER/47.0 IP) during the losing streak, which dated to 8/6/17 at BAL and spanned 11 games (10 starts).

Career Recap

- A* 2018 marks his 13th major league campaign...Played the first six-and-a-half seasons (2006-12) of his career with the Marlins, before spending the last five-and-a-half seasons (2012-17) with Detroit.
- A* Led the American League with a 2.57 ERA in 2013.

- Recalled, 8/29, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his fourth stint on the active roster...Was also up from 8/11-18, and on 8/7 and 7/31...Was added to the roster as the 26th man for the doubleheader on 8/7...Had his contract selected, 7/31, and started versus Miami in his major league debut...Optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett postgame that night.
- Has allowed seven earned runs over 3.0 innings in two relief appearances with the Braves...Last pitched for Atlanta on 8/17 vs. COL (1.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R).
- Started vs. MIA, 7/31, in his major league debut...Allowed nine hits and five runs (four earned) over 5.0 innings to earn the win...At the age of 20 years, 352 days, became the youngest left-hander to win his debut for the Braves since Charlie Vaughan did so on September 3, 1966 at the age of 18 years, 332 days.
- Is 6-4 with a 2.72 ERA (34 ER/112.1 IP) in 19 starts for Triple-A Gwinnett this season.

- Has a 2.48 ERA in 52 relief appearances for Atlanta this season, the third lowest ERA by a left-handed rookie reliever in franchise history...Jonny Venters' 1.95 ERA in 2010 is lowest.
- Allowed three hits and two runs, 9/6 at ARI, to blow his third save and snap a nine-game streak without allowing an earned run...Earned his fifth win after Atlanta won in 10 innings, most among Atlanta relievers.
- Pitched more than 1.0 inning in 14 outings this season, compiling a 0.95 ERA (3 ER/28.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts...Three of his five wins this season have come in outings longer than 1.0 inning.
- Opponents are 8-for-43 (.186) with runners in scoring position, including 3-for-19 (.158) with two outs.
- Converted the first save of his career, 8/5 at NYM...Joined Arodys Vizcaino, A.J. Minter, Luiz Gohara, Luke Jackson, Jonny Venters and Dan Winkler as Atlanta relievers with a save this season.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

Brad Brach • RHP • 6-4 • 205 • 32 yrs • #46

Saves/Opp: 12/16 **Holds:** 10 **1st Batter/Retired:** 63/44 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 19/4

- Has allowed just two earned runs in 21 appearances (18.2 IP) since the Braves acquired him on 7/29...Earned his first save with Atlanta, 9/6 at ARI, and has seven holds since being acquired.
- Took his second loss with Atlanta, 8/31 vs. PIT after allowing one unearned run in 0.2 innings...Both of his losses with the Braves, and his two blown saves, have come in games in which he did not allow an earned run.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .243 (33-for-136) average, while lefties are hitting .320/.409/.410 in 116 plate appearances.
- Atlanta acquired him, 7/29, from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for an international signing slot...Made his Braves debut, 7/30 vs. MIA, with a scoreless eighth inning to earn his fourth hold of the season.
- Went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA (21 ER/39.0 IP) in 42 games with Baltimore, converting 11-of-13 save chances.
