FISH BITES

The Marlins continue their only 10-game homestand in the opener of the 2018 Citrus Series against the Tampa Bay Rays tonight at 7:10 p.m. LHP **Wei-Yin Chen**, making his 13th start of the season, has compiled a 5-6 record and 3.72 ERA (123.1 ip/51 er) in 21 career starts against the Rays. Tampa Bay is starting former Marlin RHP Nathan Eovaldi, who in his only career start against Miami surrendered eight runs on nine hits in just 0.2 inning on June 16, 2015. Miami recently completed a 10-day, nine-game road trip to Baltimore (2-1), San Francisco (1-2), and Colorado (2-1). The current homestand began with the Marlins dropping three of four to Arizona, and followed with Miami taking two of three from the New York Mets. Miami will take a four-game leave from Marlins Park beginning Thursday to visit the Washington Nationals, before returning home on July 9 to finish off the unofficial first half with a six-game homestand against Milwaukee and Philadelphia. The Marlins have only four series over the remainder of the season that will not be against an NL or AL East opponent: Milwaukee (July 9-11 at home), St. Louis (August 6-8 at home), Pittsburgh (Sept. 7-9 at PNC Park), and Cincinnati (Sept. 20-23 at home).

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

Miami fell behind early and couldn't make up the difference, falling to the New York Mets, 5-2. Trailing 3-0 in the fourth, **Miguel Rojas** stroked a one-out double, stole third and scored Miami's first run on a misplayed bunt off the bat of **Dan Straily**. **Cameron Maybin** added the final run with his first home run of the season, a solo shot to straight-away center. **J.T. Realmuto** tallied two of the Marlins four total hits in the game. Straily took the loss, tossing a season-high seven innings while allowing three runs on five hits and four walks, and tied a season high with seven strikeouts.

VS. THE RAYS

The season series will wrap up after the All-Star Break, as the intra-state rivals open the unofficial second half with three games at Tropicana Field from July 20-22. The Marlins dropped the 2017 Citrus Series, 1-3, with the only win coming on May 3 at the Trop. Miami is 29-26 against Tampa bay in South Florida, including a 4-10 mark at Marlins Park, and trail the all-time series 52-55.

SPLITTING DIFFERENCES

In five starts at Marlins Park this season, **Wei-Yin Chen** has posted a 2.30 ERA (27.1 ip/7 er), compared to a 9.85 ERA (28.1/31) ERA in seven road starts. He has the largest difference between home/road ERA this season at 7.55. The Rays' Jake Faria ranks second at 5.11 (2.70 at home; 8.14 on road), followed by Minnesota's Lance Lynn at 5.13 (2.70; 7.83). - *Stats LLC*

SCORING CHANGE

In the top of the eighth inning, with two outs and a runner on first base Todd Frazier reached third on what was originally scored an RBI double, and advanced to third on the throw. That has since been changed to a dropped fly error on **Lewis Brinson**, no RBI, thus making the run scored on the play unearned for **Tayron Guerrero**.

BEAR-ING DOWN

Marlins reliever **Kyle Barraclough** today was named the Hartford Presents National League Reliever of the Month for June. In 12 games during the month, Barraclough tossed 12.0 scoreless innings, went 7-for-7 in save chances, and allowed just one hit over 38 total batters faced (.028 average against). He and Dellin Betances both allowed just one hit in 36 at-bats last month, marking the lowest June opponent average in Major League history since 1913 (min. 35 BF). Their average against was the lowest by a MLB reliever over any calendar month since Craig Kimbrel had a .025 (1x40) in May 2017. Barraclough's average against is the fifth lowest by any NL reliever since 1913 (min. 35 BF), behind Brad Clontz (.024; 1x41 in April 1998), Jim Brewer (.027; 1x37 in April 1970), Todd Wellemeyer (.027; 1x37 in May 2005) and Carlos Torres (.027; 1x37 in July 2012). He is the first Marlins reliever to win a monthly award since Todd Jones in August 2005.

FIRST-YEAR TRIFECTA

Brian Anderson currently leads Miami in on-base percentage (.363), RBI (40), and hits (94), and is looking to become just the fifth National League rookie since 1920 to lead his team in all three categories. The last NL rookie to lead his team in all three categories was Joey Votto in 2008 (.368/84/156). The others to do so were Greg Luzinski (.332/68/158) for Philadelphia in 1972, Wally Berger (.375/119/172) for Boston in 1930, and Babe Herman (.375/81/158) for the 1926 Brooklyn Robins. - *Stats LLC*

A COUPLE OF ZEROES

Kyle Barraclough (12.0 ip) and **Drew Steckenrider** (12.1) combined to toss 24.1 scoreless innings in the month of June. The pair are the first set of teammates to each toss 12.0-or-more scoreless innings in a calendar month since David Robertson (15.0) and Aroldis Chapman (12.0) in Sept. 2017. They are just the second pair since 1920 to do so in the month of June, joining Seattle's Charlie Furbush (17.0) and Tom Wilhelmson (15.2) in 2012. Additionally, they became the seventh and eighth relievers (eighth and ninth time) in Club history to toss as many as 12.0 innings without allowing a run in a calendar month, joining Justin Wayne (April 2004, 12.0 ip), Robb Nen (May 1996, 14.0 & August 1995, 13.2), Chad Qualls (July 2013, 12.0), **Brad Ziegler** (August 2017, 13.0), Braden Looper (Sept. 2002, 15.0), and Clay Hensley (Sept. 2010, 12.2). Additionally, Steckenrider became the first pitcher in Club history to make 14-or-more appearances in a calendar month without allowing a run.

INTERLEAGUE NOTABLES

The Marlins are tied with the Mets for the second-most wins (187) all-time in Interleague Play among National League clubs, behind Washington (195), and they have the fourth-best winning percentage (.496; 187-190), behind St. Louis (.507; 176-171), the Mets (.507; 187-182), and the Cubs (.501; 173-172). Miami's offense is the all-time leader among NL clubs in Interleague runs (1,737), hits (3,417), doubles (683), and RBI (1,648).

WHAT A RELIEF

Since May 28, Miami's bullpen has limited opponents to a National League-leading .210 average against, ahead of Washington (.213) and San Francisco (.219). The 'pen also leads the NL in innings pitched (132.2) and ranks third in ERA at 3.19 (132.2 ip/47 er), behind only Arizona (2.48) and the Giants (2.76).

MARLINS TO VISIT VA MEDICAL CENTER

Marlins players **Dan Straily** and **Brett Graves**, along with Marlins alumnus **Gaby Sanchez**, will visit the Miami Veterans Affairs Medical Center tomorrow, Tuesday, July 3, from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m., delivering lunch and spending time with our Nation's heroes. The visit is just one of many events and activities scheduled by the Marlins leading up to the Fourth of July. During tonight's game vs. the Rays, the Marlins will present a \$10,000 check to United Way - Mission United, and will recognize United States Army Sergeant Jose Blandon as the TIKD Salute & Serve Monday Military honoree.

SERIES NOTES

- The Marlins and Rays are squaring off in the Citrus Series for the 21st time. Miami dropped three of four in 2017 after taking three of four in 2016. The Marlins are 52-55 (.486) in the intrastate Interleague traditional rivalry. The Marlins are looking to even the all-time series record between the teams, which is currently in the Rays favor at 10-9-1.
- The Miami-Tampa Bay rivalry is one of seven active intrastate Interleague traditional rivalries, and one of the most closely contested, as the .514 winning percentage for the Rays is the second-slimmest by a series leader. Only the White Sox .513 winning percentage (59-56) over the Cubs is narrower. The most dominant intrastate rivals are the Yankees with a 68-47 (.591) record against the Mets, followed by the Cardinals, who have a 56-41 (.577) advantage over Kansas City. The Angels are third with a 63-51 (.553) lead on the Dodgers. Cleveland is fourth, as they hold a 56-47 (.544) mark against Cincinnati, and Oakland owns a 59-55 (.518) margin over San Francisco to rank fifth.

THIS DAY IN MARLINS HISTORY

JULY 2

In 2006 at Dolphin Stadium, both the Red Sox and Marlins recorded leadoff home runs. Kevin Youkilis led off the game with a home run for Boston, and rookie Hanley Ramirez hit his second leadoff home run of the season in the bottom of the frame. Florida would lose the game, 4-3, as Boston scored the go-ahead run in the eighth.

Wei-Yin Chen tonight will make his 13th start of the season as the Marlins face the Rays in the opener of a three-game set, the last leg of this 10-day, 10-game homestand.

Began season on DL (left elbow strain). Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, allowing just one run over 7.2 innings, with just one walk and 11 strikeouts. In first appearance, April 17 vs. Lakeland, allowed one run and three hits over 2.2 innings. In second start, April 22 vs. St. Lucie, tossed two-hit, 5.0-inning complete game. Struck out seven without issuing a walk.

Made season debut on April 28 vs. Colorado, earning a win after allowing just one run on four hits (one home run), two walks, and a hit batter over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts.

Did not earn his second win until his start on June 16 at Baltimore. Completed 6.0 innings in that start for the first time since going a season-best 7.1 innings on May 26 vs. Washington, a span of three starts (did not complete 5.0 in between those outings).

Has 2.30 ERA (27.1 ip/7 er) in five home starts, compared to 9.85 (28.1/31) in seven road starts.

Has more starts against Tampa Bay (21), by far, than any other opponent in his career. Second-most is against Boston (15).

He is 0-0, 5.40 (11.2/7) in two starts against Rays since signing with Miami in 2016.

Is 7-5 with a 4.38 ERA (102.2/50) in 17 career Interleague start. Is 2-0 with a 5.14 ERA (35.0/20) in six starts against AL since joining Miami.

His start on May 26 vs. Washington marked 150th of career. Among pitchers born in Taiwan, Chen leads all in innings pitched (918.2), starts (156) and strikeouts (713). He ranks second in career wins with 55, behind Chien-Ming Wang (68). Wang ranks second in innings pitched (845.2), starts (126), and strikeouts (394).

Opened 2017 on 25-man roster, but made just five starts before beginning DL stint on May 5. Reinstated on September 4, after which he made just four relief appearances before being shut down with left elbow discomfort following outing on Sept. 22. Finished with 2-1 record and 3.82 ERA (33.0/14).

Best start of the year came on April 18 at Seattle, holding Mariners hitless over 7.0 innings while striking out two and issuing just two walks. Marked first start of career holding an opponent hitless. Previous low-hit start was one, done on June 2, 2016 vs. Pittsburgh (6.0 ip).

Allowed season-high tying seven hits, with four runs and two walks, along with three strikeouts, over 5.0 innings on April 26 at Philadelphia. Loss marked first and only defeat of season.

Recorded season-high seven strikeouts in final start, on May 1 vs. Tampa Bay. Did not receive a decision despite allowing just two runs and two hits over 6.0. Also walked a season-high four.

Upon reinstatement from DL, made first career relief appearance on September 4 vs. Washington, tossing 1.0 perfect inning. Allowed one run on two hits over 6.0 innings (1.50 ERA) in four relief outings to close out season.

Picked up first career hit, an infield single, off of Zack Wheeler on April 7 at the Mets.
