MOVING ON: The Padres fell 7-3 to the visiting Colorado Rockies yesterday afternoon, splitting the four-game set 2-2...it was the last occasion this season in which San Diego will see their mountainous foe, finishing the 2018 campaign with an 8-11 record vs. COL... heading into tonight's game @ ARI, the Padres have won four of their last six games, and they look to snap their five-game losing streak on the road since Aug. 22 @ COL.

LAST TIME OUT: Yesterday in San Diego, starter **Jacob Nix** was saddled with his third-career loss (now 2-3), working 6.0 innings of five-hit ball and allowing five runs (earned) on two walks and four strikeouts...**Manuel Margot** added his 25th double of the season and **Franmil Reyes** logged two RBI (his fourth in four games).

MAKING MOVES: Today, the Padres reinstated RHP **Luis Perdomo** from the 10-day DL and reinstated RHP **Kirby Yates** from the bereavement list...both Yates and Perdomo will serve in the Padres bullpen.

MITCHELL MONDAY: On Sept. 1, the Padres reinstated **Bryan Mitchell** from the 10-day disabled list (sidelined with a right elbow impingement on June 20)...his start tonight is his eighth of the season and his first since May 5 vs. LAD, and he is seeking his first winning decision since April 12, 2017 and his first win as a starter since Sept. 7, 2016.

PAST STAND: In five games since the beginning of their past homestand on Aug. 28, SD pitchers have held opposing bats to a .207 clip and have a 2.48 ERA (16 er, 58.0 ip).

BE SUPPORTIVE: The Padres rotation have received an average of 4.17 runs per game, the second-lowest average in the NL this season (behind MIA's 4.07).

LESS IS MORE: Since the All Star break, the Padres bullpen has a .217 opponent average and a 3.11 ERA (55 er, 159.1 ip).

WHAT A RELIEF: There have been 130 occasions this season in which Padres relievers have completed more than three outs in a game...that mark leads the National League and is third-most in the ML behind BAL (134) and TB (165)...the Padres relievers are averaging 3.7 outs per game in relief, which leads the NL and trails just TB (4.6).

ZACK ATTACK: Friars with notable numbers vs. opposing starter **Zack Godley**: **Wil Myers** (.444, 8-for-18 with one double, one triple and one homer) and **Hunter Renfroe** (.357, 5-for-14 with two doubles).

GONE STREAKIN': **Hunter Renfroe** has hit in a career-high 10 straight games, batting .357 (15-for-42) since August 23 with two 2B, five HR and 11 RBI...**Franmil Reyes** is also riding a career-high eight-game hitting spree (.375, 9-for-24 with four HR).

CHECKING THE RUNNER: The Diamondbacks have stolen third base 16 times this season, tied for the fourth-most of any team.

PADRES ON DECK: Last night for El Paso (AAA), C **Francisco Mejía** went 3-for-4 with a home run, three RBI and three runs scored...Mejía has 23 RBI for El Paso with a .322 batting average...also for El Paso, RHP **Cal Quantrill** allowed one run on six hits and no walks with three strikeouts in 5.0 innings to pick up the win...he is 3-1 with a 3.48 ERA since being promoted from San Antonio (AA)...**Carlos Asuaje** (.322) was 3-for-4 for the Chihuahuas Sunday, going 3-for-5 with a double, RBI and a run scored...for Fort Wayne (A), LHP **Ryan Weathers**, 18, the Padres' first-round pick (seventh overall) in this past June's draft, allowed a run on three hits and no walks or strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#50 RHP Bryan Mitchell (0-3, 7.08)

MITCHELL MONDAY: 27-year-old RHP Bryan Mitchell is set to make his first start since May 5 after being reinstated from the 10-day DL on Saturday with a right elbow impingement...it will mark his eighth start of the season and first of his career against the Arizona Diamondbacks.

WHILE YOU WERE AWAY Mitchell made six rehab appearances (all starts) with Lake Elsinore (A) from 8/2-27, posting a combined 4.13 ERA (13 ER, 28.1 IP) and a 1-3 record with 28 strikeouts against 12 walks.

- He most recently tossed a season-high 7.0 IP in his last outing on 8/27 at Lancaster, allowing five runs (four earned) with five strikeouts and two walks.

LAST BIG LEAGUE OUTING: Tossed 2.2 IP of relief in SD's 14-1 loss on 6/5 vs. ATL, allowing five runs (earned) on five hits and a strikeout.

STARTER VS. RELIEVER: Mitchell made seven starts to begin the season from 4/2 to 5/5, going 0-3 with a 6.47 ERA (23 ER, 32.0 IP) as a starter...was moved to bullpen after his start on 5/5 and made five relief appearances, posting an 8.27 ERA (15 ER, 16.1 IP).

BACK ME UP: The Padres are 2-5 in games which Mitchell has started...he has received more than two runs of support on just one occasion (four 4/17 vs. LAD).

- His 11 total runs of support as a starter (runs scored while he's in the game) are tied for the second-fewest among pitchers with at least 32.0 IP...his 3.09 run support average is the eighth-lowest among all such pitchers.

NO FREE PASSES: Mitchell has issued 79 walks compared to 87 strikeouts...his 6.52 BB/9.0 IP ratio is the second-highest in the majors (min 48.0 total IP).

KEPT IN CHECK: Mitchell and the rest of the Padres pitching staff didn't surrender an extra-base hit to the Astros in the first two games of their series on 4/6 & 4/7...it was the first time Houston was held without an extra-base hit in back-to-back contests since September 17-18, 2014 vs. CLE.

- Mitchell tossed 5.2-shutout innings on 4/7 at HOU, allowing just three hits but a career-high six walks in SD's 1-0 extra-inning defeat.

TOMORROW'S STARTER — #37 LHP Joey Lucchesi (7-7, 3.59) — joeyfuego23 📷

LET'S GET FUEGO: LHP Joey Lucchesi is set to make the 22nd start of his career and his fifth against the Arizona Diamondbacks...is in search of his first win against the D-Backs, having been tagged with the loss in each of his four outings against Arizona with a 7.71 ERA (16 ER, 18.2 IP).

- Improved to 7-7 after his last start on August 29 vs. SEA, setting career highs in innings pitched (6.2) and pitches thrown (108) in SD's 8-3 victory.
- Lucchesi's 37 walks allowed this year are the eighth-fewest of any NL hurler who has made at least 21 starts.
- Is one of just 19 rookies to have reached the 20-start plateau in Padres franchise history...prior to Dinelson Lamet (2017) and Luis Perdomo (2016), the most recent Friar rookie arm to do so was Justin Germano in 2007.
