**NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES**

- The Yankees suffered their first home loss, falling to 2-1 on their six-game homestand...are still 8-3 at home vs. Baltimore since the start of 2017.
- RHP Masahiro Tanaka** (6.1IP, 6H, 3ER, 0BB, 7K, 1HR) started and took his first loss of the season...had his 10.0-inning scoreless streak snapped by Adam Jones' two-run HR in the seventh...has 15K and 0BB this season.
  - Extended his scoreless streak at Yankee Stadium to 28.0IP (regular season and postseason) before Jones' homer...had not permitted a run at home since Trey Mancini's solo HR in the sixth inning of a start vs. Baltimore on 9/14/17.
  - Suffered his first loss and failed to complete 7.0IP or earn a win at home for the first time since 8/2 vs. Detroit, snapping a streak of six starts (reg. and postseason) for each...snapped a streak of four consecutive winning starts at home (regular season) and six such starts (incl. postseason).
- Yankees pitchers** allowed all 5R in the seventh, the most runs they have allowed in an inning this season.
- Tonight marked the first time this season that a **Yankees starter** suffered a loss or allowed more than 2R.
- Yankees relievers** allowed 2ER in 2.2IP (4H, 1BB, 6K)...have 15K and 1BB on this homestand...have recorded 33K and just 6BB in 21.2IP this season, but have a 6.65 ERA (21.2IP, 16ER) while allowing opposing batters to hit .526 (10-for-19) with RISP, including 2-for-5 tonight.
- RF Aaron Judge** (1-for-4) broke a 0-0 tie with a solo HR to right in the sixth...his 58 career home runs are the most by any player through 189 career games in Major League history.
  - Since the start of 2017, is hitting .415 (27-for-65) with 32R, 5 doubles, 12HR, 25RBI and 24BB in 20G vs. Baltimore...in 11 home games in that span, is hitting .459 (17-for-37) with 22R, 3 doubles, 9HR, 18RBI and 14BB.
- SS Didi Gregorius** (1-for-1, 1R, 1 double, 2BB, 1HP) led off the seventh with a double and scored...was his ninth hit and eighth extra-base hit of the season...entered the day tied with Toronto's Justin Smoak for the MLB lead in extra-base hits with seven.
  - Is the fifth Yankee since 1908 to tally at least 8XBH through the team's first 7G of a season, joining Alex Rodriguez (9XBH in 2007), Derek Jeter (8XBH in 1999), Rickey Henderson (8XBH in 1988) and Babe Ruth (8XBH in 1921).
  - Tied a career high with 2BB (10th time, first since 7/3/17 vs. Toronto)...has 5BB in 29PA this season (17.2%); drew walks in just 4.4% of his PA's over his first three years with the Yankees.
- 2B Tyler Wade** (1-for-2, 1 double, 2BB) reached base safely a career-high three times...six of his 12 career hits are doubles.
- 3B Miguel Andújar** (0-for-3) made his first career start at third base.

**BALTIMORE ORIOLES NOTES**

- The Orioles snapped their five-game losing streak in their first game against an AL East opponent this season...improved to 1-3 on their current seven-game road trip (went 0-3 at Houston).
  - Won for just the third time in their last 11 games at Yankee Stadium since the start of 2017.
- RHP Andrew Cashner** earned his first win as an Oriole, allowing 1ER in 6.0IP (2H, 3BB, 5K, 1HR)...is 2-1 with a 1.73 ERA (26.0IP, 5ER) and 17K in four career starts vs. the Yankees...among active pitchers with at least 25.0IP against the Yankees, his 1.73 ERA is fourth-lowest behind Roberto Osuna (0.90), Dallas Keuchel (1.41) and Yu Darvish (1.64)...was his first career appearance at Yankee Stadium, the 28<sup>th</sup> ballpark in which he has pitched.
- RHP Darren O'Day** (1.1IP, 1BB, 1K, 1HP) has not allowed a hit in 3.1 scoreless innings in relief this season.
- Orioles batters** scored 5R in the seventh inning, their most runs in a single inning this season...have scored more than 3R in a game just twice this year (6R on Tuesday at Houston).
- CF Adam Jones** (2-for-4, 1 double) hit a go-ahead two-run HR in the seventh inning...has three of the Orioles' 6HR this season, with each coming in the sixth inning or later (also an 11<sup>th</sup>-inning Opening Day "walk-off" solo HR vs. Minnesota and a sixth-inning solo HR on Tuesday at Houston)...was his first homer with a runner on base since 8/31/17 vs. Toronto.
- LF Trey Mancini** (3-for-4, 2RBI) collected his first multi-hit game of the season after entering the game with only 3H in 20AB in 2018.
