OF Nick Markakis collected two more hits against a left-handed pitcher last night to raise his average against lefties to .404 (19-for-47).

That mark is the highest by a left-handed batter in the majors this season and the next closest player is Minnesota's Max Kepler at .333 (9-for-27).

Markakis' average against lefties would be the highest ever full-season mark by a qualifying left-handed batter, percentage points higher than Ichiro Suzuki's .404 (84-for-208) in 2004 for Seattle.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Marlins start a three-game set tonight with the third game of the Braves' third road trip of the season...This is the first meeting between the clubs this season...The teams will play again next weekend in Atlanta, May 18-May 20.

A The Braves went 11-8 against the Marlins last season, including 4-5 at Marlins Park...The four wins tied for the fewest the Braves ever recorded at the park in a single season since its opening in 2012 (also went 4-5 in 2014)...Overall, the Braves are 35-19 at Marlins Park and have the second-best winning percentage (.648) at the park by a N.L. team...Only St. Louis' .650 mark is better.

A RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set to make his ninth career appearance, eighth start, against the Marlins tonight...Over his last four starts against them, Foltynewicz has allowed seven total runs (2.59 ERA) while going 2-1 with 27 strikeouts and just three walks in 24.1 innings.

A LHP Caleb Smith has never faced Atlanta...Has allowed just four runs in three starts (17.1 IP/2.08 ERA) at Marlins Park, compared to a 10 runs in four road games (17.0 IP/5.29 ERA).

SCORELESS: The Braves ran their road scoreless streak to 34.0 innings last night at Tampa Bay to set a new modern-era franchise record...RHP Peter Moylan allowed two eighth-inning runs to end the run...The 1992 team held the previous record with a 30.0-inning run in July of that season.

A The club started the streak by beating the Mets, 7-0 and 11-0 on May 2 and May 3 before Tuesday night's 1-0 win over Tampa Bay.

A The three consecutive road shutouts were the longest such streak in Atlanta franchise history and the longest by a Braves team since the 1948 Boston club also had a three-game run.

ON THE ROAD: The Braves won their seventh consecutive road game last night, and have outscored the opposition 41-6 over this stretch...Their seven-game road winning streak is the club's longest single-season road run since 2013, when they also won seven to open the season, April 8-April 18.

A They last won eight straight road games in a single season in 2009, when they took a franchise record-tying 10 consecutive away from Turner Field September 10-September 27...They also took 10 straight road games in 1992 and 1994.

A Across multiple seasons, the franchise record is 12 straight, September 25, 1993-April 17, 1994.

A The Braves have gone 13-7 away from SunTrust Park this season, while compiling the fifth-best road ERA in the majors at 3.14 (63 ER/180.2 IP)... Only Colorado (23) and Pittsburgh (22) have played more road games in the N.L. than the Braves.

STARTERS SCORELESS: RHP Julio Teheran tossed 6.0 more shutout innings last night, to run his scoreless streak to 15.0 consecutive innings, one more than teammate Sean Newcomb's run.

A Teheran is 3-1 with a 1.54 ERA (6 ER/35.0 IP) over his last six games.

A Braves starters have not allowed a run on the road over their last four starts, totaling 26.0 innings...Over the seven-game road winning streak, the Braves starting staff owns a 0.62 ERA (3 ER/43.1 IP).

VS. LEFTY STARTERS: The Braves are set to face another left-handed starter tonight, LHP Caleb Smith, after facing LHP Ty Blach, LHP Andrew Suárez, LHP Blake Snell and LHP Ryan Yarbrough the last four games...Prior to this stretch the Braves had faced four left-handed starters all season...The Marlins are set to throw LHP Jarlin García on Saturday.

A The Braves are hitting .284 against all lefties, the only team in the majors with a mark above .268... Atlanta also has the sixth-best on-base percentage (.340) and the best slugging percentage (.466) to give them a majors-leading .806 OPS against lefties.

A 2B Ozzie Albies is hitting .450 (18-for-40) against all left-handers, the third-best mark in baseball among qualifiers...His .900 slugging percentage is fifth-highest mark.

MARKAKIS: OF Nick Markakis finished 2-for-4 last night with a three-run home run and is now hitting .338 (47-for-139), the third-best mark in the N.L. ... His 47 hits are the most in the league, while his .419 on-base percentage is third, and his 28 RBI are tied for third.

A Markakis' third-inning home run came against Ryan Yarbrough, another left-hander... He has seven home runs against lefties since joining the Braves in 2015...Six of his last nine home runs, however, have come against a lefty.

A He now has seven home runs in 35 games this season...Markakis did not reach seven home runs last season until game No. 117 (August 15 at Colorado).

OUTHIT: The Braves were outhit in both games against Tampa Bay, but swept the series from the Rays... They entered the series 1-11 this season when finishing with fewer hits than their opponent.

A The Braves have three players with 40 hits already this season (Nick Markakis, 47; Ozzie Albies, 43; Freddie Freeman, 40)...Only one other N.L. team, Pittsburgh, has two.

STOLEN BASES: OF Ender Inciarte swiped two more bases last night and is now tied for the major league-lead with 15 steals...Seattle's Dee Gordon also has 15.

A Inciarte has been successful on his last eight steal attempts and 11 of 12.

Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his eighth start of the season and the 73rd (93rd appearance) of his career.
- A* Is 3-1 with a 4.19 ERA (18 ER/38.2 IP) and 42 strikeouts in eight career games (seven starts) against Miami...Went 2-1 with a 3.08 ERA in five games (four starts) against the Marlins last season.
- A* Has made just one career start at Marlins Park, 5/12 of last season...Tossed 6.0 innings of one-run ball to earn the win...Also pitched 2.0 innings of relief at Miami on 4/11/17, his only appearance out of the bullpen last season.
- A* Each of his last four starts against Miami have been "quality" turns dating to 5/12/17, including a start on 8/5 of last season in which he fanned a career-high 11 batters over 6.1 innings.
- A* Received just 22 total runs of support over his last 14 starts, during which Atlanta is 2-12 as a team...His 2.83 runs of support per 9.0 innings in that stretch is fewest in the National League and third fewest in the majors among pitchers who have made at least 10 starts.
- A* Over his last 11 starts dating to 8/27/17, Foltyniewicz has pitched to a 3.70 ERA (24 ER/58.1 IP), yet is just 2-6 in that span...Atlanta is 2-9.
- A* Fanned 43 batters over 37.0 innings in his first seven starts...His 10.46 strikeouts per 9.0 innings are fifth most in the National League.

2018 Recap

- A* Allowed a season-most nine hits and six runs over 5.0 innings in his last start, 5/4 vs. SF...All six runs he allowed came in the second inning.
- A* The outing snapped a 10-start stretch in which he allowed three earned runs or fewer, the longest such stretch of his career...Went 2-5 with a 3.04 ERA during the run, which started 8/27/17...Was one of just five starters in the majors to have as long a streak of three earned runs or fewer in that span, and was the only one with a losing record -- the other four pitchers went a combined 40-5.
- A* Went 6.0 innings and allowed three hits and one run to earn his second win of the season, 4/28 at PHI...Struck out six.
- A* Threw just 91 pitches, his fewest of the season...Went as deep in a game on as few pitches for the first time since completing 6.0 innings in just 82 pitches on 4/30/17 at MIL...Entered play averaging an MLB-most 19.2 pitches per inning.
- A* Tossed a season-low 4.2 innings, 4/23 at CIN...Allowed three hits, four walks and two runs, striking out seven.
- A* Foltyniewicz left the game with the score tied 2-2, but Atlanta eventually lost 10-4...The Braves fell to just 1-11 in Foltyniewicz's last 12 starts.
- A* Logged his first "quality" start, 4/17 vs. PHI...Held the Phillies to four hits and one run over 6.0 innings, fanning eight.
- A* The eight strikeouts matched his season high and gave him 26 strikeouts through 21.1 innings on the season...Through the date of his fourth start, his 10.97 SO/9.0 IP ranked fifth in the N.L. (min. 20.0 IP)
- A* Took his first loss of the season, 4/10 at WSH...Allowed three runs (two earned) over 5.0 innings of work, and struck out a season-low three.
- A* Faced the Nationals for the second consecutive start, just the second time in his career he started against the same opponent in back-to-back turns...Also did so against Colorado on 7/16 and 7/21/16.
- A* Held the Nationals to four hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/4 at SunTrust Park...Walked two and fanned eight to earn his first win of the season and snap a career-worst seven-game losing streak.
- A* Went 0-7 with a 7.34 ERA (31 ER/38.0 IP) over the spell, the longest losing streak of his career and tied for the second longest active streak in the majors at the time...The run dated to 8/11/17 at STL and spanned eight total starts.
- A* Took a no-decision in his season debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...Allowed five hits and three runs over 5.0 innings, striking out seven.
- A* The no-decision snapped of streak of seven consecutive losses after he dropped each of his final seven starts of 2017...His skid in consecutive starts was one short of the franchise record, set by Preston Hanna from 1976-1978 and matched by Shelby Miller in 2015.
- A* Made five starts this spring, going 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA (6 ER/16.0 IP)...Allowed just 11 hits and give walks, fanning 10.

2017 Recap

- A* Spent his first full season in the majors and set career-high totals in wins (10), innings (154.0 IP), strikeouts (143), appearances (29) and starts (28).

Career Recap

- A* Was diagnosed with costochondritis on 9/2/15 and sidelined for the remainder of the season...Underwent surgery on 9/21/15, to remove the anterior half of his first rib...The procedure was performed by Dr. William Mayfield at Wellstar Kennestone Hospital in Marietta, Ga.
- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Rio Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 7/5 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 3/3

- Right-handed batters have just two hits, both singles, in 22 at-bats (.091) against him...Lefties are hitting .455/.538/.909 with five hits, two walks, two doubles, a home run and five RBI.
- Allowed the first two runs of his major league career, 5/4 vs. SF...Surrendered a two-run home run to Brandon Crawford in the top of the seventh.
- Went 2.0 innings and fanned a career-most five batters, 4/29 at PHI...Became the first Atlanta reliever to strike out at least five batters in 2.0 or fewer innings since Dario Álvarez did so on 6/15/16...Just four Atlanta relievers have had an outing of five strikeouts in 2.0 or fewer innings since 2000.
- Made his major league debut, 4/21 vs. NYM, and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first Atlanta reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley on 9/3/16 at PHI.
- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 4/17, for his first appearance on an active roster.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 16/12 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/3

- Converted his sixth hold of the season, 5/8 at TB...Six holds pace the club (tied) and are tied for second most in the majors among rookie pitchers (with A.J. Minter)...No rookie has paced the Atlanta staff in holds since Jonny Venters in 2010 (24).
- Holding right-handed batters to a .143 (6-for-42) average...Lefties are hitting .273 (9-for-33).
- Returned to action 5/5 vs. SF and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Threw two pitches and left with numbness in his right index finger and thumb in his last outing, 5/1 at NYM.
- Holding batters to a .171 (6-for-35) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-25, .120) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .257 (9-for-35) with no one on base.
- Tallied his first career win, 4/3 vs. WSH...Tossed 3.1 scoreless innings, while also stranding the bases loaded after entering the game in the third.
- Took the loss in his Braves debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...The loss was his first major league decision.

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 19/14 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 18/3

- Has not allowed a hit to a left-handed batter this season (0-for-19).
- Allowed just two hits and two walks over his last five appearances, totaling 5.2 scoreless innings...Prior to his current run, allowed two hits, eight walks and eight runs (six earned) over four games (2.1 IP) from 4/14-23.
- Ranks tied for seventh in the majors with 19 appearances this season...Has pitched in 54% of Atlanta's games...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Tossed 1.1 scoreless innings to earn his first win of the season, 4/26 at CIN.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 4/19 vs. NYM, and allowed a sacrifice fly before stranding the remaining two runners...Has inherited an N.L.-most (tied) 18 runners, and has stranded 15 (83%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which was the second-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) had a longer streak in MLB history.

Luiz Gohara • LHP • 6-3 • 265 • 21 yrs • #53

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 0/0 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 5/8, for his first appearance on the active roster this season...Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- Made four starts between Mississippi (AA) and Gwinnett (AAA), combining to go 0-3 with a 6.89 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts...Went 4.1 innings in his last start, 5/2 at Charlotte, and allowed eight hits and six runs.
- Made five starts with Atlanta last season, going 1-3 with a 4.91 ERA...Spent time at three different levels of the Braves farm system before making his major league debut last September...Became the first Braves starter since 2004 to begin the year in Single-A and make his MLB debut later that season.
- Ranked by Baseball America as Atlanta's No. 2 prospect, and by MLB.com as the Braves' No. 4 farmhand.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 17/11 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 6/2

- Is a perfect 6-for-6 in hold chances and has converted his only save opportunity...Six holds are tied for the team lead (with S. Carle) and are tied for second among rookie pitchers in the majors (also with Carle)...No rookie has paced the Atlanta staff in holds since Jonny Venters in 2010 (24).
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/9 at TB, and allowed two runs to score...The runs were the first inherited runners he has allowed to score in his career...Has stranded four of six runners this season and eight of 10 in his career.
- Earned the first save of his major league career with a scoreless ninth inning, 4/25 at CIN...Became the first left-handed pitcher to record a save for Atlanta since Jonny Venters logged five in 2011.
- Allowed a career high-tying three hits and two runs, 4/24 at CIN...Had surrendered just four hits total entering play...Had not allowed three hits or two runs since 8/27/17 vs. COL, his second career appearance.
- Appeared on consecutive dates times this season...His back-to-back outings on 4/3 and 4/4 vs. WSH marked the first time doing so in his career...Did so just once in the minors (7/23 and 7/24/17 with GWN)...Underwent "Tommy John" surgery in 2015.
