MARINERS NOTES:

- The Mariners had their season-high winning streak snapped at 8 games (6/25-7/3).
- The Mariners have now lost 7 straight games played on Independence Day...Seattle is 16-24 all-time on the Fourth of July.
- Kyle Seager** and **Ryon Healy** hit back-to-back home runs in the 2nd inning...marked the first time this season the Mariners have hit back-to-back home runs.
- Dee Gordon** (1x5) is now batting .333 (24x72) when leading off a game this season.
- Kyle Seager** (2x4, R, HR, RBI) is batting .350 (14x40) with 5 runs, 4 doubles, 3 home runs, and 9 RBI in his last 11 games (6/23-c).
 - Has recorded multiple hits in back-to-back-back games, bringing his season total to 26 multi-hit games.
 - Leads the club with 38 extra-base hits (22 2B, 16 HR).
- Nelson Cruz** (1x4, RBI) has recorded 22 RBI in his last 22 games, batting .325 (26x80) with 11 home runs over that span.
- Mitch Haniger** (1x4, R, 2B) is batting .294 (5x17) with 4 runs scored, 2 doubles, 1 home run and 3 RBI on the homestand (6/29-c).
- Mike Leake's** 4.0+ innings pitched marked the shortest outing by a Mariners starter since **James Paxton** threw just 2.1 innings on June 15 at Boston.

ANGELS NOTES:

- Angels pitchers have struck out 10+ batters in 40 contests this season, the 4th-most such games in the AL.
- Albert Pujols** (2x5, 2B, RBI) hit his 633rd career double in the 4th inning, surpassing David Ortiz for 10th-most doubles all-time...marked his 1,275th career extra-base hit, tying Alex Rodriguez for 6th-most all-time.
- Garrett Richards** has allowed 3 earned runs or fewer in 13 of his last 14 starts.
- Kole Calhoun** (3x5, 2 R, HR, 2 RBI) has hit 2 home runs in his last 3 games after hitting just 3 home runs in his previous 62...since returning from the disabled list on June 18, is batting .306 (15x49) with 3 doubles, 4 home runs, 7 RBI and 10 runs scored.
- Mike Trout** (1x3, R, 2B, 2 IBB) has hit safely in 7 of 8 games at Safeco Field this season, batting .548 (17x31) with 9 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs and 9 RBI.
 - Has been intentionally walked 2-or-more times in 3 games this season, the most in the Majors...his MLB-best 14 intentional walks rank ahead of Bryce Harper-WAS (10) and Manny Machado-BAL (10).
- David Fletcher** (1x4, R, 2B) extended his hitting streak to 6 games, batting .318 (7x22) during that span.
 - Is batting .311 (14x45) in the Majors since making his big league debut on June 13.
- Andrelton Simmons** (1x5, 2B) has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games, batting .364 (16x44) with 7 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 home runs and 5 RBI over that span.
 - Is batting .400 (10x25) with 2 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, and 3 RBI against the Mariners this season.
- Jaime Barria** (rhp) will start tomorrow for the Angels...Barria is 5-4 with a 3.40 ERA (21 ER, 55.2 IP) in 11 starts this season.

ANGELS MANAGER MIKE SCIOSCIA:

On Garrett Richards' first start since returning from the DL:

"I thought Garrett showed good stuff, I think that the back-to-back home runs in the 2nd ...he just kind of exhaled and made some pitches after that and, you know, he hadn't been out there in a while. Getting into the 6th inning is important for us but more importantly just giving us a chance to win there. It was a good outing."
