MARINERS NOTES:

- The Mariners finish the season winning 3 straight games and are 10-7 over their last 17 games.
- The Mariners finish the season with a winning record against every AL West club, marks the 1st time they have held a winning record against every team in the division since Houston joined the AL West in 2013.
- Mariners pitchers increased their single-season club strikeout record to 1,328 (previous: 1,318, 2016).
- With the attendance of 21,146 for today's game, the Mariners finish the season with a total preliminary attendance of 2,300,162 (28,397/game)... marks the highest home attendance total since 2008 (2,332,530).
- Mariners pitchers did not issue a walk for the 24th time this season, extending their club record (previous: 17, 2002)... Seattle's 2r games without issuing a walk are 2nd-most in the Majors this season (Los Angeles-NL, 28).
 - Marks the 2nd time this season the club has tossed back to back games without issuing a walk.
- **Kyle Seager** (1x2, SF, RBI) is batting .279 (17x61) with 8 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, and 6 RBI in his last 17 games.
 - Left the game after the 5th inning.
- **Roenis Elias** tied his season-high with 5 innings pitched... his 5.0 scoreless innings mark his longest scoreless outing of the season (previous: 3.2 IP, 9/14 @ LAA).
 - Has not allowed a run in either of his last 2 starts (8.2 IP).
 - Holds a 0.59 ERA (1 ER, 15.1 IP) in 6 games (2 start) in September.
 - Faced the minimum through his 5 innings pitched.
- **Guillermo Heredia** (2x4, 2B) has reached base safely in 15 of his last 27 plate appearances since 9/17 (9 games).
 - Is batting .308 (4x13) with 1 double when batting in the leadoff spot this season.
 - Recorded his 14th multi-hit game of the season.
- **David Freitas** (1x2, 2B, RBI) made his first start since Sept. 23 vs. Texas and drove in the 1st run of the game for the Mariners with a double in the 2nd inning... marks his 5th RBI of the season.
- **Cameron Maybin** (2x2, R) has recorded back-to-back multi-hit games, reaching base safely in 5 of his last 7 plate appearances...marks his 4th time this season with back-to-back multi-hit games, his 1st time with Seattle.
- **Nelson Cruz** (0x2) made his first outfield start in an American League ballpark since Aug. 16, 2016 at the Angels.

RANGERS NOTES:

- The Rangers fall to 3-11 over their last 14 games.
- The Rangers went 18-28 in day games this season.
- **Adrián Beltré** (1x2) batted .282 (24x85) with 8 doubles, 8 home runs, and 18 RBI in 24 games in September.
 - Ranks in the top 30 all time in at-bats (8th, 11,068), doubles (11th, 636), games (14th, 2,933), extra-base hits (14, 1,151), hits (15th, 3,166), RBI (21st, 1707), and home runs (30th, 477).
- **Drew Robinson** hit his 3rd home run of the season, his 1st since 9/2 vs. MIN.

TEXAS MANAGER DON WAKAMATSU:

On his takeaway from the season as a whole:

“The experience that the young guys gained. It’s invaluable that we had that many guys, (Isiah) Kiner-Falefa, (Ronald) Guzman, Joey Gallo, (Nomar) Mazara. You go down the list, (Juriskson) Profar, had a breakout year. That’s what you look at in situations, especially as bad as the season went, but you look at the positive that they gained some valuable experience going in to play as a group next year. The other thing that really suck out in the last couple weeks is the development of these young pithcers. To be able to put them in situations where we normally wouldn’t, later in ballgames. The (Connor) Sadzeck’s, the (C.D.) Pelham’s, guys like that. To be able to put them in the 8th and 7th inning in pressure situations before the year finished. The young starting pitching did an outstanding job going down the stretch, so there was a lot of valuable experience gained.”

On how he reflects on Adrian Beltre’s career and his time with Texas:

“I’ve been real fortunate. This is the second time I’ve had the chance to manage him. The other thing is, that people don’t realize, especially the last couple games, the one at home and the one here where we took him out of the game, it wasn’t about Adrian. It was about his family, and that front row. It was about the fans, and Seattle did a nice job paying tribute to him, so it was a special day for him.”
