FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a six-game homestand with the second of three against the St. Louis Cardinals tonight at 7:10 p.m. RHP **Trevor Richards**, making his 17th start of the season/career, is facing the Cardinals for the second time in 2018; he took the loss after allowing three runs on seven hits and no walks, with four strikeouts, on June 7 at Busch Stadium. St. Louis is countering with RHP John Gant, who in two career appearances (one start) against Miami has gone 0-1 with a 4.70 ERA (7.2 ip/4 er); has not faced the Marlins since 2016. The current homestand will continue following tomorrow's off-day with a three-game set against the New York Mets. Miami just returned from a six-game road swing to Atlanta (0-2) and Philadelphia (0-4). The final game of the Atlanta series was rained out and will be made up as part of a split doubleheader on August 13. Broadcast note, FOX Sports Florida will carry both games of the doubleheader.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Pablo López provided another quality outing by Marlins starters, yet Miami came out on the wrong end of a 3-2 decision to the St. Louis Cardinals. The Marlins struck quickly, scoring the first run of the game in the opening frame on an RBI-single by **Justin Bour**. In the fifth, **Miguel Rojas** extended the lead to 2-0 by driving in **JT Riddle**, who tripled to lead off the inning. That would be all for the Marlins offense, as they would record just one hit over the remaining four innings. Dietrich recorded three of Miami's six hits in the game. López tossed a career high 7.0 innings, allowing just two runs on four hits with a walk and five strikeouts.

UP NEXT

The Marlins open a three-game weekend set against the New York Mets Friday night at 7:10 p.m. Miami has gone 4-5 against New York in 2018, which includes a 2-4 record here at Marlins Park. After dropping the first four games of the season series, the Marlins have won four of the last five. The all-time series in South Florida is tied 106-106, which includes a 32-31 Miami advantage at Marlins Park, while the all-time overall series favors the Mets, 220-203.

IT'S HOW YOU START

Marlins starting pitchers have been a dominate force at home as of late, as evidenced by a consecutive scoreless innings streak of 26.1 innings over a five start stretch that ended in the seventh inning last night. The 26.1-inning streak at home by starters established a new club record, besting two previous 25.0-inning streaks; August 17-20, 2005 and June 14-18, 2002.

GOOD TO BE HOME

Since June 8, Miami has gone 17-14 over its last 31 games at Marlins Park. That is a drastic improvement over a 10-18 record over the first 28 games at home. The Marlins have posted a 3.49 ERA (299.0 ip/116 er) over the current stretch, which is the second-best among National League teams behind only the Dodgers (3.38). The staff has limited opponents to a .238 average against, which ranks sixth. On offense over that same span, **Brian Anderson** (35) and **Starlin Castro** (35) are tied for third in hits at home, behind David Peralta (41) and Charlie Blackmon (37). Anderson leads the NL in runs scored in that time with 23.

IT'S TREVOR TIME

Trevor Richards has been one of the hottest pitchers in the Majors over the last month, pitching to a 1.32 ERA (27.1 ip/4 er) over five starts. Since July 8, he has the third-lowest ERA in the Majors (min. 27.0 ip), behind only Dereck Rodriguez (1.23) and Carlos Rodon (1.26). In that time he has dropped his ERA from 5.26 on July 3 to a current 3.92. Over his last four starts his ERA stands at 0.76 (23.2 ip), which paces the Majors ahead of Masahiro Tanaka (1.04) and Zack Greinke (1.26).

STEPPING UP

The two rookie starters in Miami's rotation, **Pablo López** and **Trevor Richards**, have combined to go 2-2 with a 1.86 ERA (48.1 ip/10 er), 34 hits allowed, 11 walks and 44 strikeouts over their last eight combined starts. López has allowed eight earned over his last four starting assignments (24.2 ip; 2.92 ERA), while Richards has surrendered just two runs over his last four starts spanning 23.2 innings (0.76 ERA).

GIVE ME A SECOND

Starlin Castro has recorded 127 hits in 113 games this season. Among all MLB second basemen, he leads in games played (112), is tied with Scooter Gennett for second in hits (Jose Altuve-128), is tied for second in multi-hit games (37), and is tied for fourth in runs scored (64) and doubles (23).

HIT TO THE NINES

With three more hits this season, **Starlin Castro** will reach the 130 hit mark for the ninth time in his Major League career. He would join a list of five others who debuted in the last 20 years to record 130+ hits in each of his first nine Major League seasons. See list at right provided by *Stats LLC*.

HOME COOKING

As a team, Miami is tied for sixth in the National League in total hits at home with 490, trailing Pittsburgh (529), Colorado (502), the Cubs (499), San Francisco (491), and Washington (491). Individually, **Starlin Castro** (67) and **Brian Anderson** (64) rank third and fifth in the NL, behind Nolan Arenado (70) and David Peralta (70). Anderson ranks sixth in runs scored with 39, and **Justin Bour** is tied for 11th in the NL with 11 home runs.

PROVING HIS WORTH

In his final game before the break, **Brian Anderson** recorded his sixth three-hit game of the season to run his season hit total to 109. His hit total prior to the break tied Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.

- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season, becoming the 142nd rookie since 1958 to record 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games. Of those, 34 went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*
- He leads all MLB rookies in games (114), at-bats (442), hits (126), multi-hit games (37), three+hit games (8), average with RISP (.406), runs (63), on-base percentage (.365), and RBI (53); ranks second in doubles (25), and slugging (.416); ranks third in average (.285) and walks (45); is tied for third in triples (3); and tied for 10th in HR (9).
- He is on pace for 177 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2010, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would tie Troy Tulowitzki for the fifth-most by an NL rookie since 2000. He is also on pace to score 88 runs, which would rank as the 11th-most by a rookie since 2000.

- Trevor Richards will make his 17th start of the season for Miami tonight in the finale of this three-game series against St. Louis.
- Since July 8, ranks third among Major League starting pitchers (min. 27.0 ip) with a 1.32 ERA (27.1 ip/4 er), lowering his season ERA from 5.26 to 3.92. He trails Dereck Rodriguez (1.23) and Carlos Rodon (1.26).
- In first eight starts with Miami, posted 1-4 record with 5.45 ERA (38.0 ip/23 er). Over last eight starts, has improved with 2-2 record and 2.55 ERA (42.1/12). In that time, has limited opponents to three-or-less runs seven times, and two-or-fewer six times. Has allowed a total of just four runs over last five starts (27.1 ip; 1.32 ERA).
- Lowered home ERA to 3.05 after holding Washington scoreless on three hits over 6.0 innings on July 28. His home ERA ranks 16th in the National League among pitchers with a minimum of seven starts. Was his third start this season of 6.0+ shutout innings.
- Tonight will mark the second start of his rookie campaign against the Cardinals. He took the loss on June 7 at Busch Stadium, surrendering three runs on seven hits while walking none and striking out four over 5.0 innings.
- Went 2-0 with 0.75 ERA (12.0 ip/1 er) in four Spring appearances (two starts) with Miami. Had contract selected on April 2 and made his Major League debut that night against Boston.
- He went 0-2 with a 4.94 ERA (23.2/13) across five starts in his first stint with the Marlins. Tossed 7.0 shutout innings with just two hits allowed on April 14 vs. Pittsburgh, and tossed 4.2 shutout innings, with a career-high 10 strikeouts, on April 25 at the Dodgers, his final start before being optioned back to NOLA.
- In the Pittsburgh start, became the first Marlins rookie starter to work at least 7.0 innings and allow two or fewer hits since Justin Nicolino on September 26, 2015 vs. Atlanta (7.0 ip, 2 h). He became just the 15th pitcher in Club history to do so (22nd time).
- Allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his six starts after returning to New Orleans. Tossed a career-high 7.1 innings against Round Rock in his first game back, on May 1. Struck out nine batters in that game, a Minor League season-high that he tied on May 26 at Iowa. Posted 37 strikeouts against just four walks with the Baby Cakes.
- Recalled from New Orleans prior to his start on June 7 at St. Louis. Is 3-4, 3.49 (56.2/22) in 11 starts since his return. Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in eight of those outings.
- In his start on June 23 at Colorado, picked up a win after tossing 6.0 innings, allowing just one run on three hits and two walks, with eight strikeouts (tied for third-most strikeouts at Coors Field by a starter in Club history).
- Took loss in debut MLB debut vs. Boston, allowing five runs on eight hits and a walk, while striking out five, over 4.1 innings. Surrendered just two hits over first three innings, but was touched for three runs in fourth and two in fifth, leaving with one out and a runner on first.
- In 2017, split second affiliated and third professional season between Single-A Jupiter (13 games, 11 starts) and Double-A Jacksonville (14 starts). Combined to go 12-11 with a 2.53 ERA (146.0 ip/41 er) overall and earned Marlins' Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.
- Led all Marlins farmhands in strikeouts (158), ranked second in wins, ERA and WHIP (1.03), and fifth in innings pitched.
- Opened campaign at Jupiter, going 7-4, 2.17 (70.2/17) to earn Florida State League Midseason All-Star honors.
- Set career high with 11 strikeouts on June 2 at Dunedin, when he allowed just one hit and no walks over 6.0 shutout innings, earning FSL Pitcher of the Week honors for May 29-June 4.

- José Ureña will make his team-leading 23rd start of the season in the opener of a three-game series against the New York Mets on Friday.
- Will be his eighth career start and 12th appearance against Mets, posting 3-4 record with 3.49 ERA (49.0/19). Will mark second start against New York this season; took loss on April 9 at Marlins Park, allowing three runs on five hits with a walk and four strikeouts over 5.0 innings. In five career starts (seven appearances) at home, owns 1-4 record and 3.97 ERA.
- Suffering from the lowest run support average of any starter in the Majors (min. 20 GS). Only four starts this season has he left the game with more run support than runs allowed, and he has allowed three-or-fewer runs 12 times.
- Friday will mark his sixth home start in his last seven starts overall. Has gone 1-8 with 4.29 ERA (77.2/37) in 14 starts at Marlins Park this season. Is tied with James Shields for the most home starts in the Majors, and his 77.2 innings at home rank 10th.
- Snapped streak of 14 consecutive home starts without a win on July 29 vs. Washington. Allowed just one hit and four walks, with five strikeouts, over 6.0 scoreless innings.
- The stretch of 14 home starts without a win was the longest such streak in Franchise history. Anibal Sánchez previously owned the longest stretch when he made 13 straight home starts without a win from June , 20, 2011 to May 24, 2012. The win also snapped an eight-decision home losing streak, which was also the longest such streak in Club history. Jack Armstrong (7/22-10/3/93), Livan Hernández (7/9/98-4/6/99), Vladimir Núñez (8/5/99-4/22/01), and Dontrelle Willis (5/9-8/3/07) all had seven-decision home slides. - *Stats LLC*
